Now Stan and his producer Raymondo can be heard on Gwent Radio broadcasting every morning at 10 o'clock to the community of Gwent and the world! Stan and Ray host Gwent Radio Morning Show every day between 10 am and 12noon, except Sundays.

David Gallienne first got into radio in May 2013, when he began presenting "The Friday Rock Show" for Jubilee Radio in Guernsey. He also presented the DG at Tea programme for Jubilee and as of 2017 a new programme called Classical Gold.

In addition to this, from June 2014 He presented a Sunday afternoon show on European Rock station ARFM, which he had to give up the following April due to other commitments.

However, "The Friday Rock Show" Syndicated Radio show continued and the show was available in July 2015 on Radio Glamorgan in Cardiff and In November 2015, on Anker Radio in Nuneaton, in January 2016, the show was available on RBFM in Aberystwyth and from September 2016 the show was available on HBS in Glasgow & Paisley.

In June 2017, after 4 years and over 200 episodes, David decided to call time on The Friday Rock Show. The last edition of The Friday Rock Show was broadcast on 30th June 2017.

David continued with DG At Tea and in July 2017 He began producing "Classical Gold".

In January 2018, following lots of requests, David began his new 2 hour rock show, called 'Rock Therapy'.
