| | Black prune colour, intense fruity fragrance, rich and creamy red with good substance, leaves the palate very satisfied with fuller mouth of fruit | |
| 2 | 2001 Soffio Del Creato | £15.99 |
| | Red granite almost verging into black. Jammy taste of raspberries and cherries with a soft voluminous body, very long in the palate with double action of fruit. Three years in oak, Superb!! | |
| 3 | 2001 Ripasso | £17.99 |
| | Remarkable black cherry colour, exhaulting a bouquet of sweet prune jelly, full bodied with dates and chocolate, remaining on the palate roasted hazelnuts | |
| 4 | 2000 Amarone, Classico "Le Bessole" | £28.99 |
| | Deep pomegranate colour, powerful, intense wine with opulent plum and black cherry aromas plus dried fruit, banana and date on the palate, very approachable with plenty of rich fruit | |
