Each wine has a tasting note to give you some information about what you are trying, & our friendly staff are always on hand to answer your questions. All this means you can go mad, have some fun & maybe learn a little too! Grab a card from the bar, top up with any amount (just like an Oyster card!), pick up a glass from the shelves underneath the dispensers & press the appropriate button for your chosen pour size (25ml, 125ml or 175ml).

NATURAL WINE SELECTION

These wines are simply made with as little intervention as possible, with an emphasis on not adding anything (in vineyard or winery) & not taking anything away (through filtration or fining). Some suggest this makes them healthier but the primary aim is to express something that is only of the grape & therefore a wine with a real sense of place. The wines are alive so will show really diverse aromatics & develop dramatically in the glass...
