'Since 1858 when Eugene Mercier set up Champagne Mercier at the age of twenty Mercier is about bringing a particular style to every bottle. The characteristics of our champagnes are, and always have been, fresh aromas, combined with intense, fruity notes and spontaneity. The assemblage created by our chef de cave is based primarily on Pinot Noir and Pinot Meunier: the Pinot Noir expresses the fruitiness and intensity, while the Pinot Meunier adds white fruit notes, suppleness and a remarkable freshness. Our champagnes stand out for their glorious roundness on the palate due to the high proportion of reserve wines.

White Wine

1. Estate Sauvignon Blanc Siete Soles 2013 £17.95
Central Valley, Chile
Intense, fresh aromas of green fruit, grapefruit, lime, nectarines, peach and acacia flowers. Crisp and lively on the palate with a fresh aftertaste.

2. Kleinkloof Chenin Blanc 2013 £18.50
Paarl, South Africa
Very attractive nose with lots of tropical fruits such as pineapple, guava and citrus fruit. Intense palate following the characteristics found on the nose with a refreshing finish.

3. First Fleet Chardonnay 2012 £19.50
South-Eastern Australia, Australia
A delicious Chardonnay that captures the pioneering spirit of the first voyages to Australia in a crisp, modern style. Red apple and melon fruit fills a palate that is dry yet well rounded, making this a versatile accompaniment to food.

8. Castel Firmian Pinot Grigio 2012 Mezzacorona, £27.00
Trentino, Italy
Very clean, nicely balanced Pinot Grigio, with a gentle floral aroma, good medium weight in the mouth, and a refreshing finish.

10. Dry Riesling Chateau Ste. Michelle 2011 £30.00
Washington State, United States
A dry, crisp, refreshing style of Riesling with beautiful forward fruit flavours – white peach and mandarin – and a clean finish.

4. Vinho Verde Anjos de Portugal, Quinta da Lixa 2012 £22.00
Minho, Portugal
A fine modern Vinho Verde, with aromas of apple and grapefruit alongside herbal notes. The palate is medium-bodied and refreshing, with the classic touch of spritz.

5. Sauvignon Blanc Buitenverwachting 2012 £25.00
Constantia, South Africa
A pale lemon-coloured wine with a bouquet reminiscent of green figs with hints of gooseberries and green peppers. Dry and full-bodied with a long, lingering finish.

6. Viognier Delas Freres 2012 £25.00
Vin de Pays d'Oc, France
Bursting with Viognier character: apricots, peaches and preserved citrus fruit. The palate is both smooth and fresh, with hints of spice.

<i>Subtle nose with white flowers, pears and sweet spices from the oak at the finish. Medium-bodied and nicely concentrated on the palate, with a long, fresh finish.</i> | £26.00 |

<i>Beautiful honeysuckle aromas on the nose and a soft, rounded palate with notes of red</i> | £29.00 |

<i>On the nose there is masses of passion fruit and nectarine, along with herbal nuances. On the palate it is full-bodied for a Sauvignon, with a mid-palate richness and loads of fruit on the finish.</i> | £33.00 |

Piedmont, Italy
<i>Great texture and precision, with distinctive greengage and almond notes on the palate. Fresh and dry, this is particularly characterful Gavi.</i> | £35.00 |

Rias Baixas DO, Spain

<i>Intense, complex aroma with notes of white flowers and flint balanced by a hint of vanilla. Full-bodied and well-structured palate with notes of toast, citrus and mineral. Elegant and persistent in the mouth, this is a wine with a long life ahead of it.</i> | £85.00 |
| 22 | Meursault 2007, Pierre Morey Organic
Burgundy, France
<i>Pierre Morey’s naturally focused, mineral style is a nice counterpoint to the natural richness of the 2006 vintage; this Meursault offers a mixture of exotic floral and stone fruit flavours with a concentrated steely power on the palate.</i> | £95.00 |

Central Valley, Chile
Ripe red fruit aromas with notes of blackberries, blueberries and black pepper. Medium bodied and well balanced.
- 27 Candidato Tinto Tempranillo 2012 £18.50
Vino de la Tierra de Castilla, Spain
Bursting with berry fruits (strawberry, raspberry and blackcurrant), and a creamy note on the nose. Full-bodied and fresh with hints of candy, and a long, complex finish.
- 28 Finca La Colonia Malbec Bodega Norton 2012 £22.00
Argentina
Sweet and spicy aromas, reminiscent of black pepper. Ripe red fruit on the palate, smooth texture and a harmonious finish.
- 29 La Mouline Delieuze, Coteaux du Languedoc 2012 £19.95
Languedoc-Roussillon, France
*70% Syrah, 20% Grenache, 10% Cinsault
Ripe blackberry fruit is infused with the scent of the garrigue – the wild herbs and shrubs of the Languedoc. Smooth and round, yet full of character, this is a terrific expression of the South.*
- 33 Regaleali Nero d'Avola Sicilia IGT Tasca d'Almerita 2011 £27.00
Sicilia IGT, Italy
Notes of cherry, mulberry, black cherry, blueberry, vanilla and sage on the nose. Velvety and balanced in the mouth.
- 36 Valdemar Rioja Tempranillo 2012 £22.00
Spain
Lovely smooth young Rioja, with bright cranberry/cherry fruit, a violet aroma, and some creaminess on the finish.
- 30 NéPriCa (Negroamaro/Primitivo/Cabernet) Tormaresca 2011 £25.00
Puglia IGT, Italy
Red fruits, black cherry and blackcurrant on the nose. On the palate, the spice of the Negroamaro is complemented by the juicy plum jam flavours of Primitivo, resulting in a soft and well-balanced wine.
- 31 Cabernet Sauvignon/Merlot Buitenverwachting 2009 £24.00
Constantia, South Africa
Bright, stylish aromas of cassis, plums and pencil lead give way to a complex, structured palate that marries ripe fruit with mineral nuance, with a well-tuned, fragrant finish.



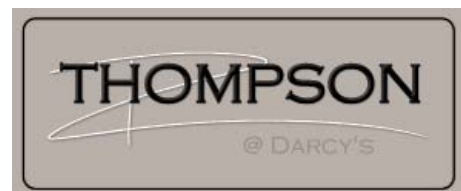

- 32 Côtés-du-Rhône Saint-Esprit Delas 2011 £26.00
Rhône Valley, France
With Syrah to the fore, this is full of berry fruit, violet, liquorice, and spices. It has a generous, rounded palate and a long, elegant finish.
- 34 Lapostolle Canto de Apalta 2010/11 £30.00
Rapel, Chile
*36% Carmenère, 31% Merlot, 18% Cabernet Sauvignon, 15% Syrah
The earlier-drinking little brother of Lapostolle's iconic Clos Apalta, Canto is a deliciously juicy yet immensely refined blend. Luxurious fruit aromas are framed by tobacco and chocolate from the Carmenère, while the palate combines serious depth with a*
- 35 Pinot Noir Coopers Creek 2011 £33.00
Marlborough, New Zealand
Black plums and black cherries on the nose intermingled with subtle French oak and nuances of grilled meat. Rich and firm on the palate with bold, sweet fruit. A core of ripe black cherry lingers on the finish.
- 37 Santa Cristina Chianti Superiore Antinori 2011 £30.00
Tuscany, Italy
A classic Chianti, offering aromas of red berry fruit, with vanilla and floral hints of violets. Flavoursome, medium-bodied palate, fresh in structure and with a delicious balance of fruit and savoury notes.
- 38 Terrazas Reserva Malbec 2009 £34.00
Mendoza, Argentina
Deep crimson with sharp candy red highlights. Upon swirling, jazzy notes of blackberries and sour cherries develop into fine traces of smoke and spices. Bright and generous, a lively mouthful of ripened plums and boysenberry, with chewy tannins and a violet scent building up to a refreshing finish.
- 39 Fleurie La Madone Georges Duboeuf 2011 £33.00
Burgundy, France
This famous Cru lives up to its name with a smooth, elegant and – yes – floral wine of immense charm.
- 40 Allegory Shiraz 2008 £27.00
Western Australia, Australia
This Shiraz offers appealing aromas of black pepper, ripe plum compote, five spice powder and toasty oak. The palate is concentrated and fruit-driven, with chocolate and savoury notes adding complexity.
- 41 Château Côtés du Gros Caillou 2011 £36.00
Saint Emilion, Bordeaux, France
Intense aromas of ripe red fruits mingled with grilled and vanilla notes. Well-balanced structure and a silky mouthfeel make for a delicious yet distinguished claret.

Burgundy, France
<i>Rich, resonant Gevrey, with blackberry, blueberry and violet aromas, a very suave, silky texture, and a long supple finish.</i> | £85.00 |
| 46 | Stag's Leap Wine Cellars Artemis Cabernet Sauvignon 2010
California, United States
<i>A sumptuous wine that expresses beautifully both the Napa Valley and the distinctive Stag's Leap style. Cherry and cassis fruit mix with vanilla and chocolate notes for richness, while sage and smoke notes add some savoury complexity. The palate is long,</i> | £95.00 |

- 23 Côtés de Provence Rosé Carte Noire 2012 £28.00
Les Maitres Vignerons de St Tropez, France
Very refined dry rosé, with an attractive floral aroma, redcurrant fruit, and excellent length in the mouth.
- 24 Gran Hacienda Cabernet Sauvignon Rosé Santa Rita 2012 £22.00
Maipo Valley, Chile
A full-on fruity rosé with a vibrant colour, masses of berry flavour and a dry yet well-rounded palate.
- 25 Sancerre Pinot Rosé Gitton 2012 £45.00
Loire Valley, France
Pale coral in colour, with an intense nose of strawberry and raspberry. The palate is vibrant and well-balanced with spicy red fruits and mineral notes.

Dessert Wine

- 53 Chateau Menota Cuvee du Portail 2009 £28.00
Graves Supérieures, Bordeaux, France Glass: 125 ml £5.00
Classic aromas of marmalade, honey and blossom introduce this delicious wine. The palate is medium-sweet, full of fruit, and yet fresh and tangy, with a whistle-clean finish.
- 54 Maury "Aurelie" Préceptorie de Centernach 2010 £32.00
Languedoc Roussillon, France Glass: 125 ml £8.00
This sweet red wine shows deep, vivid aromas of raspberry, blackberry and figs. The palate is packed full of fruit, and has a rich, mouthfilling structure that at the same time is never cloying. One of the only wines that really works well with chocolate.
- 55 Tokaji Late Harvest Cuvee, Sauska 2003 £45.00
Tokaj, Hungary
This Tokaji sees only a brief period in barrel, allowing the succulent pear, peach and orange fruit characters to take centre stage. The sweetness is perfectly offset by citrus, allowing the wine to progress from a fruit-filled entry to a clean, refreshing finish.
