



Our Island Hopping Excursion will take you on a journey to explore the local lifestyle of the Maldivians. Enjoy the serenity of the surrounding and the warm and friendly faces of the islanders. The tour will take place in South Male' Atoll. First you'll be taken to a sandbank near Bolifushi. The next stop will be at Gulhi, a very old inhabited island known for its fishing.

Please wear sun screen. Please remember reefs are fragile ecosystems. Please do not stand, walk on the corals or reef. Do not try to take any souvenirs from the underwater world. It is not safe to remove corals as it may be even poisonous and may hurt your hands or feet.

Recommended Itinerary

0900 hrs – Departure from Male by safari boat
1000 hrs - Arrival to sandbank
1000 hrs to 1300 hrs - Snorkeling or sun bathing, relaxing
1300 hrs - Depart from sandbank
1330 hrs - Arrival to Gulhi, a local fishing village
1330 hrs to 16 hrs - Walk around the island, explore the simple lifestyle of the islanders
1600hrs - Depart to North Male' Atoll
1700 hrs - Arrival Male'

Includes:

- Private boat hire with crew and fuel
- Existing tourism tax and GST tax
- Meeting & Greet by our representatives
- Snorkeling equipment
- Traditional Maldivian fishing lines



Special information:

No food included. Food can be provided as follow:

- Half Board Supplement – USD 20 per person.
Full Board Supplement – USD 30 per person.
- Clients can bring their own food/picnic onboard at no charge

Alcoholic and non alcoholic beverages available onboard (chargeable)

For safety reasons safari boat do not travel at night time (6pm -> 6am)

The rate is per day per boat only and distance travelled for this rate is either 35km South of Male or 35km North of Male.

Over Night Trips can be arranged for an additional cost – USD 70/boat

Non-guided excursion – Local guide can be arranged for extra USD60
