NOTES ON USING THIS CATALOGUE

Prices: All prices in this catalogue are the estimated current retail replacement values for maps in 'fine' condition i.e. maps that are undamaged and unrestored. This is more valuable than 'very good' or 'good' condition. When prices are not given, this is because maps are so rare that pricing becomes too speculative.

Dates: These often refer to the first date of publication. However, this is not guaranteed. The collector is advised to consult more detailed reference works for further information about individual maps.

Map Makers: These are listed alphabetically. When two names appear together, such as Mercator-Hondius, the first name is the map maker and the second is the publisher. If a map maker is not known, either the publisher's or engraver's name is listed, or it is listed under 'Anon'.

Titles: Titles of maps are listed in alphabetic order, ignoring hyphens, apostrophes. Untitled maps or English translations of foreign scripts are bracketed and listed first. Titles appearing within a map are preferred to titles appearing above or below a map. Titles in more than one language are often printed on the same map. However, sometimes only one of these titles is listed.

Comments: These sometimes appear before or after a title, in brackets, and are taken from the 23 regional illustrated Price Guides published by Map World.

Sizes: These refer to the printed image not the sheet size and are approximate only.

Exclusions: Antique maps that have not been selected for this reference work include diagrammatic route maps, antique maps of parts of counties or parts of cities, reprints of the same map unless of historical interest, maps made in the Far East, maps of proposed developments, globe gores, puzzle maps, Ptolemaic maps printed after the year 1570 and antique maps of such rarity that none are known to exist in private hands. Topographical views of cities are not included unless they give 'birds eye' information about a whole city.
