Day 1:

Upon arrival at Queen Alia International Airport, you will be welcomed by Amira Tour representative and assist you through the customs and immigration procedures. Then you will be transferred (45minutes) to Amman Hotel for overnight.

Day 2:

After the breakfast you will leave the Hotel to visit Amman, Amman is the modem and ancient capital of Jordan, Known in history as Rabat - Amman and in Greco Roman times as Philadelphia. No more than four hours drive from anywhere in the country, Amman is a convenient base for any tour within the Kingdom. Your hosts, the Jordanians, are wonderfully gracious and welcoming and most will surprise you with their excellent English. The city is crowned by the Citadel, a hill with the ruins of the Temple of Hercules, and a museum with artifacts dating back to the earliest settlement in the region some 700,000 years ago. At the foot of the Citadel lie the 5,000 seats Roman Theater.





Then you will be transferred to the north to visit Jarash, the ancient city of Jerash is remarkable for its long chain of human occupation. Here at a well-watered site in the hills of Gilead, remains from Neolithic times have been found, as well as Greek,

Roman, Byzantine, Umayyad and others. Jerash golden age however arrived with Roman rule. Today it is acknowledged as one of the best-preserved province cities of the Roman Empire. Jerash was a member of the Decapolis, a dynamic commercial league of ten Greco-Roman Cities. When Emperor Hadrian visited Jerash in 129 AD, it was already thriving. To honour its guest, the city raised a Triumphal Arch, just one part of massive building programme. Today you can walk beneath the imposing south gate and then make your way up the 'Street of Columns' the Roman Cardo-Running 600 meters north from the Oval Plaza. As you step over the tracks of chariot wheels, still visible stones, imagine prosperous window-shopping beneath a covered sidewalk. 2 hours tour inside this historical site.



Then you will visit Ajloun, Ajloun castle_is located on the site of an old monastery. It was built in 1184 by IZZ Al-Din Osama. a general in the army of Saladin. The castle controlled traffic along the road connecting Damascus and Egypt. The fortress marks the furthest limit of Frankish incursions during the Crusades. The Mamluks added a prominent tower to the castle. It was captured by the Mongols in 1260 and was partially destroyed in the process. After the visit you will be transferred to Petra Hotel for overnight.

Day 3:

After the breakfast you will check out from the hotel to visit Petra (3 hrs: 30 minutes from Amman) for "full day". The ancient city of Petra was built from 800 BC to 100 AD by Nabataeans Arabs. In this era Petra was a fortress, carved out of craggy rocks in an area, which was virtually inaccessible. In the first and second century, after the Romans took over, the city reached the peak of its fame. Petra covers an area of about 100 square km, where over 800 monuments can be found. When shipping



slowly displaced caravan routes, the city's importance gradually dwindled; it fell into disuse and was lost to the world until 1812, when it was re-discovered by the Swiss explorer Johann Ludwig Burckhardt. Nowadays Petra is Jordan's number 1 tourist attraction, known as the "rose-red city half as old as time". The Khazneh (The Treasury) starred in Indiana Jones and the Last Crusaders... After the visit you will be transferred back (3 hrs: 30 minutes) to Amman Hotel for overnight.

Day 4:

After the breakfast you will leave the Hotel to visit Madaba & Mt. Nebo, The trip south of Amman along the 5,000 years old King's Highway is one of the most memorable Journeys in the Holy Land, passing through a string of ancient sites. The first city along the way from the north is Madaba, "The City of Mosaics" which has been intermittently inhabited for nearly 3,500 years. The chief attraction in this city is a wonderfully vivid, six-century Byzantine mosaic map showing Jerusalem and other holy sites, there are also literally hundreds of other mosaics scattered throughout Madaba is churches and homes. Ten minutes to the west is Mount Nebo, the memorial of Moses, and the presumed site of the prophet's death and burial place.



Then we will transfer to the Dead Sea, 45 minutes driving. THE DEAD SEA is 400 meters below sea level; it is the infinite in what it has to offer. Ever since the days of Herod the Great, people have flocked to the Dead Sea in search of its curative secrets.... Due to high annual temperatures, low humidity and high atmospheric pressure, the air is extremely exogenous, and the high content of oxygen and magnesium in the air make breathing a lot easier...
