

Founded in 1933, this is one of the region's oldest Estates. Superstar winemaker, Gordon Russell, crafts elegant wines and, with his reds, believes in blending varietals á la Bordeaux.

257. MERLOT-CABERNET SAUVIGNON-MALBEC 27.50 GIMLETT GRAVELS "BLACKLABEL" 2009. Lush, ripe berry fruits. The fulsome, chocolaty Merlot blends beautifully with the fragrant Cabernet; and then there is the touch of Malbec for robustness. A terrific example of Kiwi red wine making at its finest. This beauty will be available by the glass on the Exotica board from time to time ... so you can sample it and judge whether my prose is too purple! 14%ABV

258. MUSSEL BAY SAUVIGNON BLANC 2011 23.50 A plethora of tropical fruits with a delightful crisp and light finish. An easygoing, fragrant style which the Aussies would love to emulate. 13%ABV

259. <u>SAINT CLAIR SAUVIGNON BLANC 2010</u> 41.50 "THE PIONEER BLOCK", Dillon's Point, Lower Wairau Valley. Superstar Winemaker Matt Thomson describes his classic as 'an intense concentration of blackcurrant, passionfruit and citrus with a mineral note that gives the palate an intensity which lasts and lasts'. *Cuisine Magazine* gives this a 5* rating. Reminiscent of the haloyon days of 'Cloudy Bay, before they expanded and became supermarket suppliers! 13.5% ABV

TINDALL ESTATE MARLBOROUGH

A Marlborough rarity – a family-owned single vineyard winery processing fruit from only their own vines. The Sowman family first planted grapes in the Wairau Valley in 1995, so the vines are mature now. They prune ruthlessly for low yields and then allow the grapes to hang a little longer than most "to ensure long, slow ripening which gives delicious flavour profiles. We are not fans of the overtly aggressive Sauvignon Blanc style", says *Terry Sowman*. "We are proud to put our face behind the label. Small family producers such as us must survive to ensure the passion and romance associated with wine."

- 294. FRANKLIN TATE ESTATE SHIRAZ 2010 27.50 One of the MARGARET RIVER's newer wineries, created by industry veteran Tate, with some of the finest mature vineyard sites in the region. This beauty is 36% Shiraz with some Viognier to contribute a little lightness of being. Lovely ipe fruit ferment4ed in French and American oak. A softer style than most Oz Shiraz with fresh, vibrant cherry fruits and an extroverted spice, and oak on the finish. 13.5% ABV
- 295. BOER & BRIT 'THE FIELD MAR.SHALL' 2009 29.50 WESTERN CAPE. Made by two guys who met at oenological school. Stefan Gerber (the Boer) and Andrew Milner. Over 100 years' ago their grandparents were bitter rivals now they are in partnership making outstanding wines. 55% Tinta Amerele, 40% Carignan, plus Shiraz. Layer upon layer of ripe plums, pomegranates and cloves with plenty of spice. Vash says, "Not a breakfast wine out perfect with one of our steaks!" 14.5% ABV
