Once owned by the Vatican, the stunning 250 acre 12th Century estate of Argiano was bought by the present owners, the Conci family in 1988, who, as only the third owners ever, have restored it back to its original glory. The 13 hectares of vines have been replanted with stock cloned in France to suit the soil type and whilst not wholly organic, there is minimal usage of chemicals. From southerly sloping terrain at an altitude of 1100 feet, the grapes are all hand selected and picked and vinified in a newly built high-tech underground 1200 sq. meter cellar.

Originally a 2500 hectare farming station the Mouat's saw diversification as being crucial and in 1999, a report was commissioned on the suitability for viticulture of a unique 150ha triangular section of argillite river terrace in the western corner of the property. They now have established a 50 hectare vineyard on which they principally grow Pinot Noir and Sauvignon Blanc. Mangaorapa means 'stream with many tributaries' and a feature of the land that makes it unique for viticulture is a deep river terrace filled with argillite soils, sometimes known as Wanstead Gravels from the old river bed.
