Bright full yellow in colour, floral on the nose with hints of honey, banana and pineapple, full and round on the palate, complex with fine acidity adding elegance and length.

Impeccable aromatic definition and superb quality of the extract. A luminous gold, its intense bouquet unfolds on the nose with roses, tropical fruit and pineapple, honey, then flood onto the palate to finish long.

Straw yellow in colour, fruity bouquet with overtones of lime leaf, vanilla and apple. The palate is sapid with a good structure and an elegant, persistent finish with flavours of white currant.

Grape Variety: Chardonnay			
Golden-yellow in colour. Some fruit on the nose, emitting crisp minerality with notes of lime. Soft, clean tasting, with perfumes of flowers and vanilla followed by a wonderfully balanced, intense palate with apricot and oak.

Grape Variety: Dolcetto			
Superb deep colour, intensely perfumed with raspberry and violet, concentrated sweet fruit, leading to a firm, ripe, mouthful of soft red fruit flavours.			
Montepulciano D'Abruzzo DOC "ORSETTO ORO" 2009, Casal Thaulero, Abruzzo (13.5%)			£26.50
Grape Variety: Montepulciano			
Deep ruby red in colour with a pleasantly intense bouquet. Dry, harmonious and full-bodied with hints of vanilla and red fruit. A perfect accompaniment to pasta dishes, roasts, grilled meats and cheeses.			
Nero D'Avola Alcamo DOC 2009, Rallo, Sicilia (13.5%)			£26.99
Grape Variety: Nero D'Avola			
Intense garnet red in colour, delicate bouquet with note of berry and scents of black cherries. Elegant, full, ample and absorbing with remarkable persistence. Excellent with red and braised meats.

Dark, ruby red, taking on warmer tones in maturation. Matures into an elegant and complex bouquet with a distinct aroma of violets. Warm, dry, and harmonious, with plummy fruit flavours and distinguished oak overtones.			
Chianti Classico DOCG Affinato In Barrique 2007, S.M. Pile e Lamole, Toscana (13%)			£38.00
Grape Variety: Sangiovese, Cabernet Sauvignon, Merlot			
Ruby red with slight garnet tints. Initial sweet vanilla scents evident on the nose lead to a clean, ethereal finish and highlight the spicy Sangiovese notes. Sweetness of wood on the palate echoes hints of forest fruits in the fragrance.			
Sagrantino Di Montefalco DOCG 2005, Antonelli San Marco, Umbria (14.5%)			£64.99
Grape Variety: Sagrantino			
Produced solely from Sagrantino grapes. Elegant and full bodied, deep ruby red in colour with garnet hues. Rich and powerful nose with ethereal and complex notes. Elegant fruit with blackberry and plums backed up by sweet wood.			
Tulin Barbaresco DOCG 2004, Pelissero, Piemonte (13.5%)			£74.99
Grape Variety: Nebbiolo			
Ruby red colour in the glass; complex, generous aromas of rose, autumn leaves and crisp vanilla. Powerful sinew and concentration as well as marvellous length. Delicious now but also suited to ageing.

Grape Variety: Cannonau and Cabernet Sauvignon Ruby red with garnet red tinges. Ethereal, strong with characteristic herbal flavour. Full bodied, dry, balanced and harmonious with elegant structure.	
Jassarte Rosso Di Toscana IGT 2006, Guado Al Melo, Toscana (13%)	£66.00
Grape Variety: 40 different varieties from the Mediterranean and Caucasus region Purple-flecked, deep ruby red. The nose, multi-layered and elegant, is redolent of spices, redcurrant, blueberry and mint. A crisp, briny note in the mouth closes with a lengthy finish, laden with fragrant dark-fleshed fruit and chocolate.	
Vino Nobile Di Montepulciano DOCG Tenuta Di Lodola Nuova 2008, Ruffino, Toscana (13.5%)	£68.00
Grape Variety: Sangiovese and Canaiolo Deep ruby red in colour with a magnificent bouquet of cherry and hints of sweet oak and tobacco. The wine is tightly structured and shows a balanced, supple finish with soft tannins and rich flavour.	
Barolo Tenuta Parà DOCG 2005, Luigi Oddero, Piemonte (14%)	£72.00
Grape Variety: Nebbiolo Oddero's Barolo shows a developed, complex spicy nose and a multi-layered palate with a long, warm and tannic finish.	
Brunello Di Montalcino Riserva Poggio Al Vento DOCG 1999, Col D'Orcia, Toscana (14%)	£75.00
Grape Variety: Sangiovese Grosso (locally known as Brunello) The wine is intense ruby red. The bouquet is powerful, elegant and harmonious. On the palate, the pronounced, yet ripe tannins combine with complex mature fruit flavours in a memorable long finish.	
Amarone Della Valpolicella DOC 2007, Ca' Rugate, Veneto (14.5%)	£93.00
Grape Variety: Corvina, Rondinella, Corvinone Intense garnet red in colour concentrated aromas of ripe blueberries, blackberries and cherries are enhanced with a hint of spicy oak. The palate is rich, full bodied and complex beautifully balanced and lingering.

Rosamara Chiaretto Del Garda Classico DOC 2010, Costaripa, Lombardia (13%)	£25.50
Grape Variety: Groppello, Marzemino, Sangiovese, and Barbera The wine of one night is a winemaking technique that requires the winemaker to be present for 24 hours and uses core of the berry. The colour is pale light, candy pink on the nose. Inviting, ample with hints of mayflower. Harmonious, fresh, with excellent persistence.

Grape Variety: Pinot Noir, Pinot Meunier and Chardonnay The wine's strength is immediately pleasing to the nose and its complexity explodes on the palate. The initial notes of fruit are followed by discreet aromas of brioche and vanilla. A perfect balance of finesse and forcefulness.
