GREEN TEAS	<b>The Willow Green Tea</b> - An unfermented leaf tea with a delicate yellow liquor. Light refreshing, with similar properties to Gunpowder Tea. Also aids digestion

#### **OUR HISTORY**



Charles Rennie Mackintosh created the fabulous interiors at the Willow Tea Rooms in Sauchiehall street in 1903 for his patron, Kate Cranston. The Room de Luxe with its fabulous mirrored friezes, leaded glass doors and silver furniture is still considered to be one of Mackintosh's jewels in his long and diverse career.

After being put to other uses after Kate Cranston gave up her tea room empire in 1928, Anne Mulhern reopened the Room de Luxe in its original setting on 1 December 1983 and the Willow Tea Rooms were reborn. Anne further developed the Sauchiehall Street building by recreating The Gallery, which opened on 14 February 1996. Like the Room de Luxe, the Gallery has been recreated to the original design.

In July 1997, the Willow branched out beyond the original Sauchiehall Street site, with the opening of the Willow Tea Rooms at 97 Buchanan Street, immediately next door to Kate Cranston's original Buchanan Street Tea Rooms, another of the four tea rooms originally owned by Kate Cranston in the early 1900s. Here Anne recreated the White Dining Room and Chinese Room originally designed by Mackintosh for Kate Cranston's Ingram Street Tea Rooms.

Today, the Willow Tea Rooms offers visitors the chance to see the magic of Mackintosh's designs and sit and experience taking tea in the splendour of a bygone era.
