<p>BLACK TEAS</p> <p>£2.10</p>	<p>Willow Tea Room Blend - A select blend of Ceylon & Assam teas served to your personal preference</p> <p>CRM Signature Tea - A specially blended Darjeeling and Ceylon mix for the connoisseurs which celebrates the works of Charles Rennie Mackintosh</p> <p>Assam - From Brahmaputra Valley in Northern India, a full-bodied tea with a rich flavour</p> <p>Ceylon -A strong tea with a clean bright flavour, a crisper character than Assam served on its own or with lemon or milk</p> <p>Darjeeling - The champagne of teas grown in the Himalayan foothills, a superb character, with a smooth flavour</p> <p>Scottish Breakfast - A select blend of black teas specially chosen to infuse with the soft waters of Scotland</p> <p>Earl Grey - A scented blend of Darjeeling and Black China teas. Bergamot oil adds a delicious almost citric flavour</p> <p>Keemun China - A pale and delicate china tea with the aroma and fragrance of orchids. It is slightly sweet and very smooth</p> <p>Kenya - Almost as full bodied as Assam, with a strong rich flavour. It has a bright coppery colour and a noticeably different liquor</p> <p>Lapsang Souchong - A China tea with a distinctly smoky character. It should be savoured lightly brewed and served alone</p> <p>China Rose Petal - A soft and delicate Black China tea, layered with rose petals during the drying process to delicately scent the leaves. Has a smoother taste with less dryness than Jasmine</p>
<p>GREEN TEAS</p> <p>£2.25</p>	<p>The Willow Green Tea - An unfermented leaf tea with a delicate yellow liquor. Light refreshing, with similar properties to Gunpowder Tea. Also aids digestion</p> <p>Gunpowder Green - A refreshing and clean tasting China green tea, its leaves are thought to resemble explosive gunpowder</p> <p>Jasmine Green - A very delicate China tea infused with the fragrance of Jasmine blossom, it simulates the taste buds and aids digestion</p>

<p>RED TEA</p> <p>£2.85</p>	<p>Redbush Rooibos tea is a naturally uncaffeinated tea made from the Rooibos shrub <i>aspalathus linearis</i>, grown only on the North Western Cape of south Africa.</p>

<p>OUR HISTORY</p> 	<p>Charles Rennie Mackintosh created the fabulous interiors at the Willow Tea Rooms in Sauchiehall street in 1903 for his patron, Kate Cranston. The Room de Luxe with its fabulous mirrored friezes, leaded glass doors and silver furniture is still considered to be one of Mackintosh’s jewels in his long and diverse career.</p> <p>After being put to other uses after Kate Cranston gave up her tea room empire in 1928, Anne Mulhern reopened the Room de Luxe in its original setting on 1 December 1983 and the Willow Tea Rooms were reborn. Anne further developed the Sauchiehall Street building by recreating The Gallery, which opened on 14 February 1996. Like the Room de Luxe, the Gallery has been recreated to the original design.</p> <p>In July 1997, the Willow branched out beyond the original Sauchiehall Street site, with the opening of the Willow Tea Rooms at 97 Buchanan Street, immediately next door to Kate Cranston’s original Buchanan Street Tea Rooms, another of the four tea rooms originally owned by Kate Cranston in the early 1900s. Here Anne recreated the White Dining Room and Chinese Room originally designed by Mackintosh for Kate Cranston’s Ingram Street Tea Rooms.</p> <p>Today, the Willow Tea Rooms offers visitors the chance to see the magic of Mackintosh’s designs and sit and experience taking tea in the splendour of a bygone era.</p> <p>Why not take home a souvenir of your visit – our gift shops stock a range of quality products, include many of our own brand products, Mackintosh and Glasgow designs.
