**Brooklyn Chocolate Stout** 10.0% £7.50 Scrumptiously rich and dark, this is a must-match with our brownie

**Brooklyn EIPA** 6.8% £5.30 The Brooklyn, NYC brewing revival is personified by this cracking IPA

**Brooklyn Lager** 5.2% £4.00 Rich, wonderful traditional lager brewed by the genius that is Garrett Oliver

**Brugs Zot Bruin** 7.5% £5.95 Dark brown, rich, fruity and spicy. A Belgian Abbey classic from Bruges

**Chimay Red** 7.0% £5.25 Unfiltered, unpasteurised, foamy beer which is dark brown and fruity

**Chimay White** 8.0% £5.25 A Belgian Tripel, the lightest, hoppiest and driest of the three Chimay beers **Chimay Blue** 9.0% £12.75 750ML Copper-brown in colour, great depth of fruity, bitter, peppery character

**Great Divide Brewing Co 'Yeti' Imperial Stout** 9.6% £9.75 A quite simply stupendously big stout which is sensational with chocolate



Kwak 8.4% £5.95 A powerful amber famous for a glass which has to be seen to be believed

Lapin Kulta Premium 4.5% £4.75 Finland takes its brewing seriously and this lager is no exception. Serious stuff

Little Creatures Pale Ale 5.2% £4.95 A delightful hop bomb from Australia's finest craft brewery. Very popular

Mexicali 5.0% £4.25 Light lager, but then, in Mexico rich, complex beer is the last thing you want

Mongozo African Fruit Beers 3.6% £4.95 Fruit-packed beers from the Congo, brewed under license in Belgium

**Monteith's Original** 4.0% £4.50 Full and rounded, dominated by hops with notes of caramel and burnt sugars

Monteith's Winter Ale 8.4% £4.75 Massive Antipodean doppelbock. Perfect to warm yourself up on a cold night

**Newcastle Brown Ale** 4.7% £4.95 Needs no introduction, the bottle is familiar to Viz readers the world over

**Odell's 5 Barrell Pale Ale** 5.2% £6.25 Whole hop flowers added during the boil give this beer a fresh, lively aroma

**Odell's** 90 **Shilling** 5.2% £5.95 Brewed in Colorado in a traditional Scottish, malt-heavy style

**Pabst Lone Star 4.7% £3.80** Sometimes a thirst so kitsch erupts that only a Lone Star will quench it

**Palma Cristal** 4.9% £3.95 A beer to be drunk while Marlon fishing in Cuba. Or indeed in the Draft House

**Red Pig** 5.6% £4.95 This ale is very aromatic, intensely floral-hoppy, lightly sweet and malty

Sam Adams Boston Lager 4.9% £3.95 A solid and dependable American craft lager made in the Vienna style

Schneider Aventinus 8.2% £7.75 A darkish doppelbock wheat beer which is a dream match for our Schnitzel

Stone Brewing Co Oaked Arrogant Bastard 7.2% £8.95 This bad boy has come to personify the extreme end of American craft brewing **Stone Brewing Co IPA** 6.9% £6.95 Despite Stone's aggressive, punky rep, this is a gorgeously rich, balanced ale
