### The Champagne Houses

### Andre Jacquart

Andre Jacquart is a small family owned house based in Vertus on the Cote des Blanc where the average age of the vines is 40 years. Use of oak barrels from Puligny, non malolatic, low dosage and the use of predominately chardonnay all contribute to make these crisp, minerally wines an absolute delight.

### **Balfour**

Balfour Brut Rosé is grown on Hush Heath Estate from three classic Champagne varieties: Chardonnay, Pinot Noir and Pinot Meunier. England's most exclusive Pink Fizz reflects a youthful and refreshing style that can rightfully stand on its own against its old world counterparts

### Besserat

Founded in Aÿ in 1843 by Edouard Besserat, the house has created a perfect champagne to partner food. Produced in the cremant style with lower pressure and a low dosage. Its like a fine white burgundy with bubbles. 'Cuvée des moines,' the Cuvée of the monks is created in the honour of the monastic tradition in champagne

### Billecart-Salmon

Founded in 1818 with the marriage of Nicolas Francois Billecart and Elisabeth Salmon, the house remains independent to this day. The style represents elegance and harmony with distinctive finesse.

### **Bollinger**

Madame Lilly Bollinger championed this independent house. Lilly expanded production through the purchase of vineyards, however she is better known for promoting the brand. "I drink it when I am happy and when I am sad. Sometimes I drink it when I'm alone, when I have company I consider it obligatory. I trifle with it when I am hungry and drink it when I am. Otherwise, I never touch it – unless I'm thirsty."

### Bruno Paillard

In a region that hasn't seen a new champagne house in nearly a century, Bruno Paillard created a small but prestigious young Champagne House. The house style is the marriage of elegance and complexity, remarkable purity with a true freshness and silky texture. Bruno Paillard was the first to inform the connoisseur with the date of disgorgement.

### Dom Pérignon

For forty-seven years, Dom Pérignon worked on creating, perfecting and establishing the reputation of what would later be known as the champagne method. This delicate and unique Prestige cuvée expresses the timeless style of Dom Pérignon

### Francois Dilligent

The Moutard-Dilligent family has been making wine in Champagnes Côte de Bar since the 1600's. These champagnes are 100% Pinot Noir and made from old vines with a very low 1% dosage. The wines represent delightful drinking and excellent value for money.

#### Gosset

Established in 1584 in Äy, the house is the oldest in Champagne. Only the first pressings of the grapes are used for the blends of Gosset champagnes. The first fermentation is never followed by malolactic fermentation, which ensures the wines retain their freshness with clear, crisp and long lasting flavour. The champagnes are well worth going out of your way to experience.

### Krug

Since 1843, the Krug family has proudly cultivated the markedly individual character of their exceptional prestige champagne. It is distinctive and easily recognised by taste due to the house's policy of complete barrel fermentation and very extended lees aging. Wines display a raciness resulting from the suppression of the malolactic fermentation, balancing richness and power with finesse.

#### Lanson

One of the oldest champagne houses, Lanson was founded in 1760 by Francois Delamotte, a magistrate from Reims. To guarantee the freshness and optimal development of the wine's flavours, Lanson chooses not to use the malolactic fermentation, the key to the enduring perfection of the House style.

### The Champagne Houses

### Laurent-Perrier

Founded in 1812, Laurent-Perrier has been avant-garde in creating unique and elegant champagnes for nearly two hundred years. We use a high proportion of Chardonnay grapes in the majority of our blends becauseBernard de Nonancourt wanted to create 'vins de plaisir' - wines for drinking pleasure that are delicate yet complex rather than full-bodied or heavy.

### Louis Roederer

Established in 1776, the house is built on precision, patience and attention to detail. A bespoke champagne requested for Tsar Alexander II would become the first cuvée de prestige, and be known as the infamous Cristal. The range of wines is largely sourced from Roederers vineyard. The wines embody a youthful, fresh and fruity style with a delicate yet full bodied vinosity.

### Moët et Chandon

Founded in 1743 by Claude Moët, the house is the undisputed worldwide leader in champagne and holds a royal warrant as supplier of champagne to Queen Elizabeth II. The leading winegrower in the Champagne region, Moët champagnes are well known for their freshness and simplicity. The style is epitomised by fruitiness with an elegant maturity.

### Mumm

Georges Hermann Mumm, a descendant of the founders, took over the company in 1853. One of the most easily recognisable houses, thanks to the vivid scarlet sash across it's labels, said to represent the ribbon of legional honneur, France's highest badge of honour. The house style is a balance of finesse and clarity of fruit. One of their most famous champagnes, Mumm de Cramant, is made solely from chardonnay.

### Perrier-Jouët

With a great talent for craftsmanship and artistic flair, Perrier-Jouët is a hidden jewel in champagne. The house bases its style on the exceptional quality of the chardonnay from Cramant, bringing a delicacy to the style. The inspiration behind the remarkable prestige Belle Epoque was the discovery of a beautifully decorated floral glass bottle dating back to 1902. Finesse and elegance is the hallmark of this house.

#### **Pommerv**

The house of Pommery is known to be the 'Brut revolutionary' by creating a lower dosage champagne especially for the British market. The style is characteristically fresh and alive. Pommery is attributed with producing a variety of wines that cater for a diversity of palates. The flagship wine is Cuvée Louise.

### Pol Roger

Founded in Epernay in 1849, the house is one of few Grand Marques remaining in family hands. Sir Winston Churchill is fittingly honoured as the most illustrious devotee by a prestige cuvée composed in his preferred robust and mature style. The launch of the champagne was a grand affair attended by Churchill's daughter, who commented of her father, "I saw him many times the better for it, but never the worst."

#### Ruinari

Ruinart has the accolade of the being the oldest established champagne house. Founded in 1729 by the visionary and entrepreneur Benedictine monk Dom Thierry Ruinart who learned the secret of the 'wine which sparkles' from Dom Perignon .The Ruinart taste is fundamentally due to the predominance of the chardonnay grape variety.

### Veuve Clicquot

In a world where business was still the domain of men, the widow Madame Clicquot took control and contributed to the implementations of revolutionary new practices and also conceived the system of remuage. Such was her presence in the region that during her lifetime she became known as La Grande Dame de la Champagne and today she lives on in a prestige cuvée of the same name.

### Glossary

### Non Vintage

Non vintage (NV) is a blended Champagne created from grapes harvested in a single year blended with the still reserved wine from previous years. In this way, the Champagne house can achieve a constant house style.

### Vintage

Champagne derived from a single year's crop. Producers will reserve the finest fruit for this style of Champagne. Not every year is declared as a vintage year, as vintage Champagne is only made if conditions are good enough.

### Multi - Vintage

In order to maintain a style that combines both complexity and freshness, the Multi-Vintage style combines the outstanding characters of several vintages.

### Prestige cuvée

A cuvée de prestige is Champagne that is considered to be the top of a producers range. Prestige cuvées represent the pinnacle of a Champagne house's achievements.

### Blanc de Blancs

"White of whites" The term used to describe Champagnes made exclusively from Chardonnay grapes. Blanc de Blanc Champagnes are usually light and delicate.

### Blanc de Noirs

The term "white of blacks" is used to describe Champagnes made exclusively from black grapes. Pinot Noir, Pinot Meunier or a blend of the two are the only red grapes permitted in Champagne.

#### Rosé

Rosé Champagne can be produced by either maceration of black grapes during pressing, so that the colour leeches out from the skins or by adding a small amount of red wine to give the wine a rosé tint.

### Brut natural

A very dry style of Champagne in which the sugar content is less than 3 grams per litre. This is a very rare style of Champagne that is not widely available.

#### Brut

The majority of Champagne falls into this category. Brut is a term to describe dry Champagne. Contains less than 12 grams of sugar per litre.

### Extra Dry

A slightly confusing French term to signify that the Champagne is slightly sweeter in style, more middle-of-the-road style, not as Dry as brut.

#### Sec

A term to signify that the Champagne is medium sweet.

#### Demi-Sec

A term to signify that the Champagne is a sweeter style with 30 -50 grams of residual sugar.

#### Cramant

Cramant is a commune located in the Côtes des Blancs sub region of Champagne and the wines are classified as 100% Grand cru.
