Champagne of the Month



Champagne Gosset is the oldest wine house in Champagne established in Ay in 1584. Gosset champagnes are 'recently disgorged' and the house avoids malolactic fermentation on the antique bottles cuvées. This preserves acidity which in turn keeps the wine fresh for much longer. The house style is creamy and dry, but not acidic, with a long elegant finish. All cuvées are aged in bottle much longer than is legally required but above all, the Gosset champagnes are wines which drink beautifully on their own or with a wide range of classic and modern dishes.

Champagne Gosset – once discovered, never forgotten.

The Champagne Houses

Besserat

Founded in Aÿ in 1843 by Edouard Besserat, the house has created a perfect champagne to partner food. Produced in the Cremant style with lower pressure and a low dosage. Its like a fine white burgundy with bubbles. 'Cuvée des Moines', the Cuvée of the monks is created in honour of the monastic tradition in champagne.

Billecart - Salmon

Founded in 1818 with the marriage of Nicolas François Billecart and Elisabeth Salmon, the house remains independent to this day. The style represents elegance and harmony with distinctive finesse.

Bollinger

The history of Bollinger, founded in 1829 in the village of Aÿ in Champagne, is the history of members of a family who have dedicated their lives to their passion and specialist knowledge. The highly respected "Aunt Lily", who presided over the house from 1941, implemented strict regulations to guarantee the quality of the wines, the so called "The Charter of Ethics and Quality".

Bruno Paillard

In a region that hasn't seen a new champagne house in nearly a century, Bruno Paillard created a small but prestigious young Champagne House. The house style is the marriage of elegance and complexity, remarkable purity with a true freshness and silky texture. Bruno Paillard was the first to inform the connoisseur with the date of disgorgement.

Canard-Duchêne

Canard- Duchêne is located in Ludes, in the Montagne de Reims since 1868. Its owners, Victor Canard and Léonie Duchêne both granted the right by the Russian Imperial Family to adopt its coat of arms as the family emblem. These authentic, original Champagnes combine fruit, intensity and complexity.

Dom Pérignon

For forty-seven years, Dom Pérignon worked on creating, perfecting and establishing the reputation of what would later be known as the Champagne method. This delicate and unique Prestige cuvée expresses the timeless style of Dom Pérignon.

Duval-Leroy

Family business established in 1855, one of the few houses to remain independent and is also one of the largest land owners in Champagne. Duval Leroy champion sustainability with organic cuvee's and light weight bottles.

Francois Diligent

The Moutard-Diligent family has been making wine in Champagnes Côte de Bar since the 1600's. These Champagnes are made from old vines with a very low 1% dosage. The wines represent delightful drinking and excellent value for money.

Gosset

Established in 1584 in Ay, the house is the oldest in Champagne. Only the first pressings of the grapes, the cuvées, are used for the blends of Gosset champagnes. The first fermentation is never followed by malolactic fermentation, which ensures the wines retain their freshness with clear, crisp and long lasting flavour.

Krug

Since 1843, the Krug's family has proudly cultivated the markedly individual character of their exceptional prestige Champagne. It is distinctive and easily recognised by taste due to the house's policy of complete barrel fermentation and very extended lees ageing. Wines display a raciness resulting from the suppression of the malolactic fermentation, balancing richness and power with finesse.

Lanson

Lanson was founded in 1760 by Francois Delamotte, a magistrate from Reims. To guarantee the freshness and optimal development of the wines flavours, Lanson chooses not to use the malolactic fermentation, the key to the enduring perfection of the House style.

Laurent-Perrier

Founded in 1812, Larent-Perrier has been avant-garde in creating unique and elegant champagnes for nearly two hundreds years. We use a high proportion of Chardonnay grapes in the majority of our blends because Bernard de Nonancourt wanted to create 'vins de plaisir' – wine for drinking pleasure- that are delicate yet complex rather than full-bodied or heavy.

Louis Roederer

Established in 1776, the house is built on precision, patience and attention to detail. A bespoke champagne requested for Tsar Alexander II would become the first cuvee de prestige, and be known as the infamous Cristal. The range of wines is largely sourced from Roederers vineyard. The wine embody a youthful, fresh and fruity style with a delicate yet full bodied vinosity.

Moët et Chandon

Founded in 1743 by Claude Moët, the house is the undisputed worldwide leader in champagne and holds a royal warrant as supplier of champagne to Queen Elizabeth II. The leading winegrower in the Champagne region, Moët champagnes are well known for their freshness and simplicity. The style is epitomised by fruitiness with an elegant maturity.

Mumm

Georges Hermann Mumm, a descendant of the founders, took over the company in 1853. One of the most easily recognisable houses, thanks to the vivid scarlet sash across it's labels, said to represent the ribbon of legional honneur, France's highest badge of honour. The house style is a balance of finess and clarity of fruit. One of their most famous champagnes, Mumm de Cramant is made solely of Chardonnay.

Perrier-Jouët

With a great talent for craftsmanship and artistic flair, Perrier-Jouët is a hidden jewel in champagne, a House style with its base on the exceptional quality of the Chardonnay from Cramant.



The Champagne Houses

Pommery


The house of Pommery is known to be the “Brut revolutionary” by creating a lower dosage champagne especially for the British market. The style is characteristically fresh and alive. Pommery is attributed with producing a variety of wines that cater for a diversity of palates. The flagship wine is Cuvée Louise.

Taittinger

Founded in 1734, Taittinger is known to be the third oldest house. Elegant with a creamy richness defines the house style.


Veuve Clicquot

In a world where business was still the domain of men, the widow Madame Clicquot took control and contributed to the implementations of revolutionary new practices and also conceived the system of remuage. Such was her presence in the region that during her lifetime she became known as La Grande Dame de la Champagne and today she lives on in a prestige cuvée of the same name.

- 2002* Star vintage for most grand marques
- 2003* Very challenging vintage however the best quality houses produced some good wines
- 2004* Good year promising wines of great structure and elegance
- 2005* Soft fruit, rich and approachable, promising
- 2006* Wines are showing clean aromas, rich fruit and promise finesse and balance
