Rebellion IPA is our best selling ale, a Gold Medal award winner in SIBA Midlands Beer Competition 2005, this light ad easy drinking ale is always available. At 3.7% ABV, it appeals to a wide range of tastes buds.

Rebellion have a great seasonal range of fine ales around the 4.2% ABV mark. We use our second pump to feature different tastes on a weekly basis, offering a diverse array of flavours, depth and colour. Some of the more popular choices have been **Rebellion Blond**, a clean crisp mix of bitter and larger hops, **Smuggler**, **Zebedee** and **Roasted Nuts**. In addition, there is always a monthly special to tempt you – at the moment we have **I2th Man**, a sweet fresh hoppy ale with a great bitter after taste.

Our third hand pump switches weekly between other local, micro and national breweries, including Chiltern, Ascot, Windsor and Eton, Greenking and Cottage.

We also offer a range of local Lagers from one of only four British Lager producers, 'The Cotswold Brewery'. We are currently stocking their **Summer Lager** (4%), **Premium Lager** (5%) and **Wheat Beer** (4.2%). Liberty Hops are used for the Premium and Sovereign Hops in the Summer Lager from Herefordshire and Worcestershire, and the barley used is a blend from Wiltshire and Berwick-Upon-Tweed. The Wheat for the Wheat Beer is from Wiltshire. With only 4 ingredients and produced under the German principle of lager production, the Cotswold range is a fantastic product to have amongst our range.

We are proud to help in the continuing growth of our local and national beverage producers and will soon be taking on British spirits to complement this theme.

Our Premium brand is **Pilsner Urquell**, a fantastic 4.4% full bodied Czech import from Pilsen. Served at the perfect temperature, in just the right way, you can experience first hand the

time and attention that goes into making every pint of this fine lager. Much the same as Cotswold, Pilsner has only 4 ingredients and is cold stored for six weeks to allow the brew to ferment and create its own CO₂.

For those that prefer the taste of apples, we have sourced a fabulous Somerset cider from Lillies Cider Barn, **Stargazer** (4.5%), is not too sweet or fizzy. This clean, crisp cider has a slight scrumpy after taste that leaves you wanting more.

And of course we stock Guinness (4.1% ABV) – the world's number one stout, well kept and served perfectly.
