### 15. Neblina Merlot Rosé £14.80 bottle

Chile, Central Valley

An exciting New World Rosé packed with intense colour and mouthwatering red fruit characters.

### 16. Torre Alta Pinot Grigio Rosé £15.50 bottle

Italy

Elegant notes of acacia flowers on the nose with a soft yet rounded palate.

### 17. Prosecco Corte Alte £17.50 bottle

Italy

Delicate and aromatic with a light body and fine bubbles.

## CHAMPAGNE

### 18. Veuve Joubert Réserve Spéciale £32.50 bottle

France, Champagne

A beautiful pale gold colour with small delicate bubbles this wine shows intense aromas of fresh fruit on the nose and palate.

## WHITE WINE

### 1. Bantry Bay Chenin Blanc £14.80 bottle

South Africa

An aromatic wine with hints of tropical and citrus fruit on the nose and palate.

### 2. Tin Roof Chardonnay £15.20 bottle

Australia, South Eastern

A soft, buttery Chardonnay, with a smooth and rich fruity finish.

Per glass: £4.10 175ml £5.50 250ml

### 3. Pinot Grigio Malandrino £15.50 bottle

Italy, Veneto

This wine displays notes of citrus fruits, white flowers and honey, along with a delicious citrus fresh palate.

### 4. Fernlands Sauvignon Blanc £16.50 bottle

New Zealand, Marlborough

A citrus led palate and a long-lasting and refreshing finish encapsulate the essence of what Marlborough does best.

### 5. Finca Las Moras Viognier £17.95 bottle

Argentina, Tulum Valley

Orange blossom with a hint of pineapple on the nose, full-bodied and refreshing with aromas of ripe apricots and peaches.

### 6. Chablis Jean Bourguignon £19.95 bottle

France

This is a lively and fresh Chablis with clean citrus aromas. Crisp and fruity on the palate with a good steely character.

### 7. Sancerre "Les Baudrières" £22.50 bottle

France, Loire Valley

This Sancerre shows crisp, citrus and gooseberry flavours, balanced by restrained mineral elegance.

## RED WINE

### 8. Neblina Merlot £14.80 bottle

Chile, Central Valley

On the nose rich notes of plum and blackberries lifted by Chocolate and Mocha. Silky yet structured with concentrated fruit flavours.

### 9. Tin Roof Shiraz Cabernet £15.20 bottle

Australia, South Eastern

A soft fruity red with ripe berry fruit and gentle spicy flavours in a mid weighted easy drinking style.

### 10. Rioja, Bodegas de Abalos £15.50 bottle

Spain

From the leading wine region in Spain, this Rioja is violet in colour and soft and fruity in style. Warm, plummy aromas tinged with subtle spice and vanilla.

Per glass: £4.20 175ml £5.60 250ml

### 11. Pinot Noir La Grille £16.50 bottle

France, Loire Valley

A medium-bodied Pinot Noir with soft juicy fruit and lovely crisp finish.

### 12. Otterbrook Mill Shiraz £17.95 bottle

Australia, South Eastern

A lovely, smooth wine showing notes of plum and dark, berry fruits with a delicate yet spicy finish.

### 13. Gestos Malbec Malbec, Finca Flichman, Mendoza £19.50 bottle

Argentina, Mendoza

A stunning Malbec with ripe plum and prune characteristics and intense colour and aromatics.

### 14. Côtes-du-Rhône Belleruche, M.Chapoutier £20.50 bottle

France, Rhône Valley

Aromas of blackberries, cherries, road tar, and earth. Medium-bodied with silky tannins as well as gobs of luscious fruit.
