Day 1. Hometown to Cooma

Dinner

We depart our pre arranged pick up point and begin our trek up into the magnificent **Snowy Mountains Region of New South Wales**. We make our way down into Canberra where we visit **The National Museum of Australia** is situated on the shores of Lake Burley Griffin and uses state-of-the-art technology to explore Australia's past, present and future along with its many cultures. We can use this venue to purchase lunch before making our way to Cooma where we check into our motel before dinner.

Day 2. Monaro Country

Breakfast, Lunch & Dinner

A leisurely start to a wonderful day, we are met by our expert guide who will show us spectacular views of the Snowy Mountains as we travel across the rich Monaro to the eastern edge of **Eucumbene Dam**, a favourite spot for trout fishermen, then travel through farming properties before arriving at the huge rock and earth wall of the **Eucumbene Dam**. At the time of its construction it was the largest in the Southern Hemisphere. It's a delightful spot to enjoy a cuppa from the coach. We then pass under and over the great wall before traveling south following the main range to the beautiful little village of **Kalkite** which is situated on the very eastern side of **Lake Jindabyne** and features spectacular views across to the **Jindabyne Pumping Station**. We arrive at the **Snowy River Winery Cellar Door and Restaurant** for **tasting and lunch**. All varieties are unique cold climate grapes which feature long slow ripening for extra flavour. Next we travel to the tiny village of **Dalgety**. Nearly a hundred years ago it was one of the leading contenders as a site for the National Capital! Across the road we view the famous Snowy River, which is once again flowing. Our guide will show you a ver unique and historic Church, rarely visited by the general public. Late in the day we call at the **Thredbo Valley Wild Brumby Schnapps Distillery Cellar Door** where a full range of schnapps is kept on ice ready for you to take a tasting tour. It's a great way to choose the right schnapps to buy for oneself or as a present. Continuing our journey we travel to Cooma via Jindabyne arriving back at the motel.

Day 3. Cooma Town**Breakfast & Dinner**

This morning we enjoy a treat as we board the **Cooma / Monaro Train** for an enjoyable **40km return rail journey** from **Cooma to Chakola** on the banks of the Numeralla River. On our return we enjoy morning tea before touring the **Snowy Hydro-Electric Information Centre** in Cooma for an overview of this Australian landmark infrastructure project. This Centre focuses on the Scheme's power stations, dams, water resources and energy market. We then enjoy some free time in Cooma to purchase lunch. After lunch our guide gives us a **great introduction to Cooma**, capital of the Snowy's as we take in **The Mosaic Time Walk in Centennial Park, The International Avenue of Flags, 'Man from Snowy River' statue, visit to Cooma Gaol** and also the magnificent views from **Mt Gladstone Lookout**. Later in the afternoon we travel back to our motel to rest before our Christmas In July dinner and opening of presents.
