1 day Phillip Island and wildlife tour

This tour is all about showcasing the magnificent wildlife and scenery of this region of Victoria.

We visit Churchill Island to gain an insight into what life was like living on a farm in the early 1900's. See a range of farm buildings, farm animals and beautiful views across to the mainland.

At the Koala Conservation Centre we wander along an elevated boardwalk and see these amazing furry mammals in their natural habitat and have the opportunity to ask questions of the Rangers who manage the Centre.

We visit Swan Lake wetlands for the opportunity to spot different types of birdlife from the secluded hides on the shoreline. At the Nobbies we amber along the boardwalk and see silver gulls who nest here and views of the ocean across to seal rocks. With the aid of binoculars you may see some of Australia's largest colony of fur seals as they relax on the rugged outcrop.

We'll finish the day after sunset watching the little penguins make their way across the beach heading towards their nesting areas after spending their day hunting in the ocean. We'll have a Park Ranger who will guide us through the penguin colony to the comfort of a Sky Box where you'll have fantastic views across the beach.

The Yarra Valley and Dandenong Ranges have many aspects that make them wonderful places to visit. Many people just visit the wineries but Longhorn YOUnique Tours has designed this special tour to showcase many of the areas highlights.

We start the day at Healesville Wildlife Sanctuary where you will see a range of Australian wildlife including koalas, kangaroos, wombats, emus, dingoes, Tasmanian devils, birds of prey and platypus. We will also arrange a special surprise for you during our visit which ends with the Sprits of the Sky show featuring some of our spectacular native birdlife. You will also visit the Australian Wildlife Health Centre, a working veterinary hospital which treats over 2000 orphaned, ill or injured wildlife every year.

Enjoy lunch at the Sanctuary before we travel through the Dandenong Ranges to take a ride on Puffing Billy, a restored early 20th century steam train which travels though magnificent rainforest.

We then head to Sky High Restaurant and lookout where we enjoy dinner whilst taking in the spectacular views of Melbourne and its surrounding area. On clear days you will see across to Port Phillip Bay and the You Yangs Mountain Range and the western regions heading to Geelong.
