- Louis Roederer Brut Premier NV**
Family-owned quality champagne house - fresh, creamy, fruity & structured
- Laurent-Perrier Cuvée Rosé Brut NV**
Special rosé for a special occasion

White

- Chenin Blanc**, Freedom Cross, Western Cape
Dry & zesty New World chenin blanc
- Semillon Sauvignon**, Vicuña, Central Valley
Deliciously crisp & refreshing blend of grapes traditionally used in white Bordeaux
- Vermentino**, Vignes de l'Eglise
Increasingly fashionable variety from Northern Italy & Southern France - aromatic, fresh & racy
- Garganega**, Torre del Falasco
Easier to drink than to say - the grape variety used for Soave. Soft, rounded, a lovely glass
- Chardonnay**, Comtesse de Marion
Well-made unoaked chardonnay from a family estate using all its own fruit, grown without pesticides or chemical fertilizers
- Verdejo**, Castillo de Tomas
Fresh, zingy, pin-sharp Summer white - good with fish, salads or just sunshine
- Pinot Grigio delle Venezie**, Cortegiara
From the famous Italian winery, Allegrini. Light, refreshing & citrusy
- Picpoul de Pinet 2011**, Domaine des Lauriers
Characterful local grape from the Languedoc - imagine yourself floating down the Canal du Midi on a barge with a well-chilled glass of this. Nice!
- Fiano Greco 2011**, A Mano, Puglia
Wonderful aromatic nose, surprisingly dry on the palate. Perfect sipping for Summer
- Sauvignon Blanc 2011**, Tummil Flat, Marlborough
Classic Marlborough Sauvignon - fresh, crisp, nettles & gooseberries
- Costières de Nîmes 2010**, La Tour de Beraud
Southern Rhône blend of Grenache Blanc, Roussanne & Marsanne, made with a lot of heart by Francois Collard on a small family property near Nîmes - refreshing, elegant & mineral
- Albariño 2009**, Pazo San Mauro, Rias Baixas
Distinctive wine from Spain's Atlantic Coast - dry, with a tang of the sea. Great with fish ♥
- Gavi di Gavi 2011**, Lugarara, La Giustiniana
Gavi di Gavi - so good they named it twice! Concentration & richness make it super food wine
- Chablis St Martin 2010**, Domaine Laroche
Extremely drinkable Chablis made from premium fruit, less austere than some
- Pouilly-Fumé 2010**, Domaine des Fines Caillottes, Jean Pabiot
Excellent fruit, classic flinty sauvignon from a Loire estate with 5 generations' experience

- Tempranillo**, Castiluzar, Navarra

- Grenache-Carignan**, Monrouby, Pays d'Oc
Vibrant, medium-bodied wine - plenty of depth, red fruit flavours & the structure to marry well with anything off the char-grill
- Shiraz di Sicilia**, Villa Francesca
Good full-bodied full-flavoured Shiraz from Sicily
- Negroamaro di Puglia**, Cantine San Marzano
Deeply fruity, but not overly heavy - a grape well worth exploring

Old-established family estate making classic Cabernet - good blackcurrant flavours & length
- Pinot Noir 2010**, Maiden Flight Reserva, Casablanca
Made in a purpose-built winery solely for Pinot Noir, this is incredibly good for the price
- Côte de Brouilly 2009**, Les Volcaniques, J Charlet
Superb Beaujolais, light, juicy & delicious
- Palazzo della Torre, 2009**, Allegrini, Veneto
Delicious, fruity, very drinkable wine from a top maker - a baby Amarone ♥
- Zinfandel 2009**, Seghesio, Sonoma County
Sonoma Valley is more rootsy than neighbouring Napa and attracts interesting winemakers like the Italian-American Seghesios who specialise in mouth-watering, food-friendly wines
- Nebbiolo 2009**, Massolino, Langhe
The Massolino family makes gold medal-winning Barolo, the king of Italian wines. This raspberry & rose scented Nebbiolo is a tempting introduction to their excellent range
- Givry 1er Cru 2009**, Clos Jus, Mouton
Refined & delicious Pinot Noir. Good value Burgundy need not be an oxymoron.

Dessert

- Moscatel Oro Floralis**, Torres
Heavenly rich, sweet Muscat with a caramel finish - good with pud or blue cheese
- Monbazillac 2009**, Chateau le Fagé
Light & delicate. Well-balanced acidity. A great all-rounder.
