**Veuve Clicquot** £60.00

Champagne

Veuve Clicquot ages their non-vintage for almost twice the required time, resulting in a superb marriage of freshness and power, with rich fruit and a mouth-filling mousse.

**Taittinger Rose Reserve** £65.00

Champagne

From Champagne's oldest cellars, this Champagne has peach and acacia notes on the nose, a citrus-fresh yet delicately honeyed palate, and a beautiful, elegant finish.

Spain			
Fresh, floral aromas reminiscent of aromatic herbs such as anise and fennel, the smooth and velvety palate is fruit driven with citrus and tropical flavours.			

<b>Alfredini Garg Pinot Grigio</b>	<b>£4.25</b>	<b>£5.75</b>	<b>£17.00</b>
Italy			
Light in colour, refreshing, and crisp and with aromas of limes, grapefruits and lemons making this well balanced wine very easy to drink.

Australia			
Pale straw yellow with youthful green hues. A nose of citrus fruits and ripe apples, with underlying notes of vanilla. Crisp lemon and lime on the palate, served up with a rounded and buttery feel.			

<b>Vina Carrasco Sauvignon Blanc</b>	<b>£4.50</b>	<b>£5.90</b>	<b>£17.45</b>
Chile			
Thoroughly citrusy on the nose, with fresh lime and lemon forming the aromatic backdrop. More citrus on the palate, accompanied by a riper hint of pineapple, and mouthwatering acidity.			

<b>Baron De Baussac Viognier</b>	<b>£21.50</b>		
South of France			
Fresh and dry with aromas of apricots and white peach, hints of elderflower and fresh pineapple.			

<b>Fernlands Sauvignon</b>	<b>£21.50</b>		
New Zealand			
Very zesty on the palate with lots of lime and a nettly herbaceousness, this is an aromatic and classic New Zealand Sauvignon Blanc with a refreshing dry finish.			

<b>Sancerre Roger Neveu</b>	<b>£26.50</b>		
Loire			
Aromas of ripe rhubarb and gooseberry leap from the pale lemon coloured glass, along with hints of lime, chalk and flint. Mineral texture, high acidity, vibrant green fruits and a long, lingering finish.			

## Sparkling Wine

<b>Prosecco Corte Alta</b>	<b>£4.50</b>	<b>£20.00</b>
Delicate and aromatic with a light body and fine bubbles, this wine carries lots of fresh peach, pear, apricot and apple with a revitalising finish.		

<b>Raboso Rosado Corte Alta</b>	<b>£20.00</b>		
The little-known Raboso grape is essentially the sister grape of the white Prosecco, and is here used to make a similarly delicate sparkling wine. Grapes have been picked from the vineyard areas around the towns of Conegliano and Valdobbiadene.			

## Red Wine

Spain			
Classic Tempranillo notes of dark cherry and blackcurrant are lifted by a hint of dried flowers and spice. Superbly balanced, the fruits of the forest flavours are perfectly complemented by soft tannins.			

<b>Five Foot Track Shiraz</b>	<b>£4.25</b>	<b>£5.75</b>	<b>£17.00</b>
Australia			
A medium weight red, with a pleasing balance between ripe fruit and savoury, earthy notes on the nose. The palate is succulent and mouth-filling, with lashings of red berry and brambles.			

<b>Vina Carrasco Merlot</b>	<b>£4.50</b>	<b>£5.90</b>	<b>£17.45</b>
Chile			
Aromas of ripe plums and strawberries, with faint notes of tomato leaf and sage. The palate has a thick and jammy feel, with soft, mature tannins and a rounded, easy style.			

<b>Flor Del Fuego Cabernet Sauvignon</b>	<b>£4.50</b>	<b>£5.90</b>	<b>£17.45</b>
Chile			
Fruity flavours of plum and blackcurrant, with a cassis-like concentration, lifted by subtle green-pepper-like savoury tinges. Easy-going tannins provide a ripe and friendly mouthfeel.			

<b>Bantry Bay Pinotage</b>	<b>£18.50</b>		
South Africa			
Soft and rounded with notes of bramble fruit on the palate. A smooth mouthfeel and a well balanced hint of spice on the finish.			

<b>Aires Andinos Malbec</b>	<b>£18.50</b>		
Argentina			
Deep ruby coloured with smoky black fruits of cassis, blackberry and spice. The concentration of the wine performs well above its price point with soft tannins and a long finish.			

<b>San Millan Crianza Rioja</b>	<b>£25.00</b>		
Spain			
Red cherry colour of medium intensity with violet hues. Direct and fresh nose. Aromas of ripe red fruits with a subtle floral bouquet and notes of cinnamon and clove. In mouth soft but with body and structure.			

## Rosé Wine

Bright coral in colour, with a delicious sweetness, offset by a tangy acidity. The intense cherry and raspberry fruit burst enthusiastically onto the palate, with a fine natural spritz.
