Clothing/Gear: The pattern at the ranch is very informal - jeans, slacks, and long-sleeved shirts for riding. Planning to fish? Keep in mind our creek is deep, so bring your gear. A jacket will come in handy for early mornings or in the evening. For riding, western boots are best, but tennis shoes are OK. Serious hikers should come prepared with sturdy hiking shoes. Don't forget your swimsuit! Evening wear is the same - very casual! Bring a portable alarm clock & flashlight!

Fall Colors: The shimmering cottonwoods of mellow yellow invite you to drive up Coffee Creek Road. The Dogwoods reddish pink with its crown of thorns dance like fairies between the big leaf maples that form a tunnel of bright yellow in front of the ranch. The holly turns burnt orange hiding amongst the tall conifers every shade of green. The mountains are a blaze of color against the sky blue of heaven. A must see!

Pet Policy: Pets must be kept on a leash when with you on ranch property. We have several cabins that our reserved for our loyal companions. We have special dog enclosures next to your cabin for their stay. No dogs allowed on the rides. See all rules on the website.

Weather: April/May: Warm days average 70 degrees, cool nights; June: Average 80 degrees, cool nights; July/August: Average 90 degrees, nights refreshing but not cold; Sept/Oct: Warm days, chilly at night; Nov: check www.wunderground.com

A week is 6 nights and 7 days, if you desire to stay longer, call for exact rates. DAILY RATES ARE HIGHER THAN **WEEKLY RATES**. Daily check-in and check-out is determined by the first meal. (Example: Dinner first day would end with lunch last day. Check out 4 p.m.) If you have a **handicap**, let us know at the time of your reservation, so the best cabin for you can be selected. DEPOSIT, CANCELLATION, & REFUND POLICY
