Jacky Charpentier Réserve Brut Blanc de Noir NV	£14.00
A blend of 80% Pinot Meunier and 20% Pinot Noir producing a smooth champagne with overtones of honey.	
Paul Berthelot Cuvée de Réserve Brut N.V.	£15.00
Ripe fruit and honey slightly mentholated. The palate is well structured with notes of apple, pear and currant with a slight mint and anise.	
Bernard Bremont, Brut Grand Cru NV	£19.50
80% Pinot Noir; beautifully balanced and floral.	
Jacky Charpentier Réserve Rosé N.V.	£16.00
Full-bodied and structured with hints of cherry and cassis.	
Paul Berthelot, 1er Cru Cuvée Rosé N.V.	£19.00
Very elegant nose and fine bubbles. Notes of red fruit jam and blackberry supported by the freshness and vivacity of citrus and grapefruit.	
Laurent Perrier 2002	£16.00
Golden yellow colour. Nose of ripe fruits and honey while on the palate there is a sense of complexity depth of flavour and a youthful freshness.	
Laurent-Perrier, Brut Rosé N.V.	£19.50
Open and fresh with aromas of small red berries. The fruit is dominant in the mouth.	

Wines by the Glass

White wines

Glasses are served by 125ml

Bodega Lurton Reserva Pinot Gris, Valle d'Uco, Argentina 2011

Single vineyard at £8.00

This extremely fresh wine exhibits peach and melon flavours, backed by a hint of butter on the finish. Light and refreshing.

Terres Fumées, Pays d'Oc, Sauvignon Blanc, France 2010

Grower Assemblage at £9.00

The Grenache gives a rich peachiness to the wine and the Sauvignon a vibrant freshness. Lovely with light foods or by itself.

Aussieres, domaine Barons de Rothschild Lafite Languedoc Chardonnay 2010

Grower assemblage at £8.50

Beautiful bright yellow with particularly pronounced hints of green. Clean, fresh nose. Pleasant citrus notes of lime. Also white flowers, very characteristic of Aussières Blanc.

St.Clair Marlborough, Sauvignon Blanc, New Zealand 2010

Grower assemblage at £9.00

Crisp and powerful showing intense flavours of passion fruit and blackcurrant, with underlying gooseberry tones. Well balanced acidity provides a long, lingering finish

Chablis 1er Cru, Vaillons Domaine Fourrey 2010

Single vineyard at 16.50

This 1er Cru Chablis is pale green in colour with lemon-yellow undertones. The palate offers flavour and complexity.

Red wines

Glasses are served by 125ml

"1753" de Château de Campuget, Costières de Nimes, France 2009

Grower Assemblage at £6.00

An intense wine with black cherry aromas combined with a smoke liquorice character and a hint of chocolate.

Domaine les Fontanelles Pays d'Oc Pinot Noir 2010

Grower assemblage at £9.00

This domaine produce some of the finest Pinot Noir grapes which are used to produce this smooth, silky ruby red wine with aromas of black cherries and blackberries.

Piedra Negra Malbec, Lurton Mendoza, Argentina 2006

Single vineyard at £11.00

Intense purple colour. Its fruity nose of ripe black fruits is subtly combined to spiced notes of cinnamon and nutmeg with a hint of dried tobacco.

El Albar Barricas, Vino de la Tierra de Castilla y León, Spain 2008

Single vineyard at £12.50

Made from Tinta de Toro grapes (Tempranillo) this wine is rich and concentrated yet supple and round, with well integrated oak.

Givry 1er Cru "Clos de Bois Chevaux" Domaine Joblot, France 2007

Single vineyard at £15.00

A powerful yet elegant Pinot Noir, matured in new oak.

Château La Tour de Pibran Pauillac 2005

Château assemblage at £22.00

This wine offers a very deep purple colour. pure expression of fruit. On the palate the tannins are extremely fleshy, providing an overall balance

Jacky Charpentier Tradition Brut NV

Artisan at £65.00

Beautiful white gold with delicate and elegant bubbles. Well balanced with a beautiful finish

Champagne Paul Berthelot, 1er Cru Cuvée Eminence Brut NV

Artisan at £80.00

Intense and complex nose of fresh pears, apricots and white peaches. The mouth, is dominated by dried fruit, then opens with notes of honey and fruit in syrup.

Pehu Simonet Grand Cru Blanc de Blanc NV

Artisan at £99.00

Finesse and minerality. Aroma of citrus and exotic fruit to share moments full of spirituality.

Champagne Moutard, Arbane 2006

Artisan at £160.00

The wine offers up exotic passion fruit, hard candy and liquorice, showing striking depth, complexity and nuance, Zesty notes add a further layer of complexity on the finish.

Labelled Champagne NV

Laurent-Perrier Brut NV

Négociant/Manipulant at £63.00

A subtle blend of spice, with hints of citrus and warm toasted notes, balance the freshness of the fruit.

Laurent-Perrier, Brut Rosé NV

Négociant/Manipulant at £99.00

Open and fresh with aromas of small red berries. The fruit is dominant in the mouth.

Billecart Salmon Extra Brut NV

Négociant/Manipulant at £94.00

Pale gold enhanced by pure brightness delivering a complex aroma of dried fruit and brioche combined with floral notes and lemon verbena.

Laurent Perrier Grand Siècle

Négociant/Manipulant at £145.00

Intense nose of candied citrus fruits, very mineral and a long refreshing finish.

Labelled Champagne Vintage

Laurent Perrier 2002

Négociant/Manipulant at £80.00

Golden yellow colour. Nose of ripe fruits and honey while on the palate there is a sense of complexity depth of flavour and a youthful freshness.

Billecart Salmon Cuvée Nicolas Francois Billecart 1998

Négociant/Manipulant at £182.00

Pale gold with aromas of white flowers, mixed with subtle notes of brioche. The balance between richness and persistence is the hallmark of this wine.

Pol Roger Cuvée Winston Churchill 1998

Négociant/Manipulant at £385.00

Big, sweeping Sir Winston Churchill endowed with layers of perfumed ripe pears, quince, flowers and spice

White wines

Hugel Classic Pinot Blanc 2007

Single vineyard at £45.00

Pale green colour, fresh bouquet with aromas of spring blossom, fresh almonds and pistachio.

Domaine Barons de Rothschild Legende de Lafite Semillon Sauvignon 2010

Grower assemblage at £55.00

This legend wine is intensely fresh and lively, with enough character and depth to waken the most jaded palate.

Chablis, domaine Fourrey 2009

Single vineyard at £57.00

A contrast of stone and lemon stalk elements on the nose.

Pioneer Marlborough Block 2, Sauvignon Blanc 2010

Single vineyard at £59.00

Sourced from a single vineyard in the lower Wairau valley, this Sauvignon Blanc has a superb concentration of passion fruit and blackcurrant.

Chablis 1er Cru Cotes de Lechet domaine Fourrey 2010

Single vineyard at £89.00

Cream and citrus aromas. Intense, creamy and chalky, so clean, with real typicité. Attractive and impressive.

Highland Estates Camelot Chardonnay 2009

Single vineyard at £98.00

Tropical flavours of pineapple, mango and papaya with a rich and velvet textured finish. Notes of cinnamon, candied lime and crème brûlée

Puligny Montrachet Village domaine R. Monnier 2010 *(Limited release)*

Single vineyard at £118.00

Very good ripeness and a fine, long, elegant finish. A delicious Puligny village.

Châteauneuf du Pape Blanc Domaine de la Solitude 2009

Single vineyard at £99.00

A delightful yellow in colour evolving into light gold. Reminiscent of citrus, apricot, pear and white flowers

Safari, Cantina Bove Abruzzi, Pecorino IGT 2010

Grower assemblage at £48.00

Straw yellow, with vibrant aromas of peaches, citrus fruits and wild sage.

Red wines

Aussieres, domaine Barons de Rothschild Lafite Languedoc Syrah Mourvedre 2010

Grower assemblage at £45.00

The Mourvèdre enhances the Syrah with its powerful tannins and density and more local flavours are obtained with Cabernet Sauvignon. Very good balance.

Wente Sandstone Arroyo Valley Merlot 2006

Single vineyard at £46.00

Smooth and full-bodied with flavours of blackberry, spice, liquorice and tobacco.

Château Fleur de Lisse, St Emilion 2006

Château assemblage at £57.00

A well structured St Emilion with a pleasant fruit bouquet.

Karam Winery Syrah de Nicolas 2008

Single vineyard at £69.00

Supreme syrah that has been handpicked and vinified with proud ancestral skills. Deep ruby red with notes of ripe fruits, liquorice and vanilla. Beautiful structure.

Legende de Lafite Medoc 2008

Château assemblage at £75.00

Légende Médoc is made with all the care and attention that goes into the making of a Grand Cru. A robust intense and aromatic wine with notes of candied fruit, ripe silky tannins and an excellent fruity and spicy finish.

Rothschild Collection Pauillac 2004

Château assemblage at £94.00

The wine has a dense and bright colour with a violet tint and a rich, elegant nose that opens on attractive toast and vanilla aromas accompanied by fresher notes of cherry, blackcurrant and blackberry. Fine balance

Château Clocher Rouget de Pomerol 2007

Château assemblage at £98.00

Black raspberry, coffee, dark cherry and earthy notes make up the perfume. Medium bodied, soft and round in texture, with a sweet, red and black plum filled finish.

Château La Tour de Pibran Pauillac 2005

Château assemblage at £130.00

This wine offers a very deep purple colour. pure expression of fruit. On the palate the tannins are extremely fleshy

Barolo "Single Vineyard Galinotto" Mauro Molino 2006

Single vineyard at £138.00

Made from a single vineyard, very small production and therefore much bigger wine with structure and tannins combined with an amazing complexity.

Blason de l'Évangile Pomerol 2005

Château assemblage at £160.00

Intense, deep colour: direct, open, fruity nose, with a fine expression of terroir for this 100% Merlot wine. In the mouth, it is big, full-bodied and heady with fresh notes of dark fruit. The finish is long

Château Peby Faugeres St Emilion Grand Cru 2002

Château assemblage at £355.00

Peby Faugeres boasts a flamboyant perfume of espresso roast, melted chocolate, camphor, blackberries, creme de cassis liqueur, and a hint of sweet toasty oak. Full-bodied, concentrated.

Gaja, Barbaresco 2000

Single vineyard at £490.00

Intense aromas of ripe plums, violets and berries lead to a full-bodied palate with chewy tannins

Château la Fleur de Petrus Pomerol 1998 *(Source Origin Château)*

Château assemblage at £1200.00

Has a high-toned nose, with violet, floral, berry and toasted oak character and is full in body, with an incredible backbone of superpolished tannins. A caressing, totally satisfying finis

Dessert wines

Vendimia Tardia Riesling, Miguel Torres, Chile 2007 (375ml)

Single vineyard at £42.00

Dense and intriguing on the palate with a myriad of flavours reminiscent of honey, flowers and spices

Muscadel 1908 Reserve Old Vines, Rietvallei estate, Robertson, South Africa 2008 (375ml) *(Source Origin Property)*

Single vineyard at £69.00

Red Muscadel vines in South Africa. Reddish in colour, with the tantalising Muscat aroma of flowers, orange peel, raisins and spices. These continue on the palate to a sublimely delicate lingering finish.

Johanneshof Reinisch Eiswein Merlot 2009

Single vineyard at £80.00

A pure and super clean nose with plum jam, small red fruits and hints of oriental spices give way to a round, sweet and velvety palate of considerable length.

Château Coutet, Sauternes – Barsac 2001 (50cl)

Single vineyard at £79.00

Light at first, opening to a rich fruitiness, with the fruit peel botrytis underneath plums and honey, in a nice finish, too.
