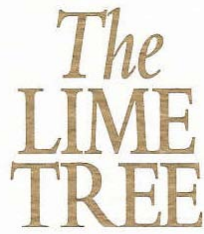
Loire

- Sancerre Domaine Hubert Brochard 2010 £26.00
Produced in the village of Chavignol this is a stunning Sancerre giving bright fruit aromas, balanced by a crisp acidity and a dry minerality in the finish.
- Pouilly Fume, Domaine de Maltaverne 2010 £28.00
A fantastic example of properly made sauvignon. Ripe and concentrated gooseberry fruit with a citrus and tangy herbaceous edge. Very pure and rounded, not unripe or overly grassy, with a crisp mineral dry finish.
- Menetou Salon, Clos des Blanchais, Henri Pelle 2009 £34.00
Henry Pelle keeps his yields very low (50 hl per ha) and some vines are almost 50 years old. This sophisticated Sancerre style wine has structure and finesse and is one of my personal favourites.

Alsace

- Pinot Gris Grand Cru Brand, Cave de Turckheim 2005 £30.00
Tropical fruit aromas mixed with spice and honey. Rich and full bodied with 'sweet' fruit undertones but followed by long acidity, making it taste drier and more elegant.
- Reisling Grand Cru Brand, Cave de Turckheim 2009 £30.00
Elegant pear and citrus fruit on the nose, underpinned by pungent mineral and 'stoney' aromas which broaden and get richer in the mouth. The finish is crisp and 'racy'.
- Gewurztraminer Grand Cru Brand, Cave de Turckheim 2008 £30.00
Powerfull and fragrant aromas of rose petal, lychee and apricot with a hint of sweet spice, rich and pineappley but with fine structure and complexity. Spicy juicy fruit and acidity combine well on the medium dry finish.

French Regional Red Wines

La Sauvageonne Pica Broca AOC Coteaux du Languedoc 2008	£22.00
A medium ruby red; ripe with sweet dark fruits, black olive and liquorice notes. Rich and dense, with great expression of terroir (garrigue and herbs) and a firm tannic structure with spicy layers.	
Chateau La Moutete, Vieilles Vignes, Cotes de Provence 2005	£28.00
A delicious wine made from old vine Grenache, Syrah and Mourvedre. Dense and brooding with earthy richness.	
Domaine Berthoumieu Madiran, Charles de Batz 2007	£30.00
Madiran is Gascogne's greatest red wine, and the passionate Didier Barre creates wine with dense powerful aromas of red, black and candied fruits with chunky yet approachable tannins. The Charles de Batz is oaked in 50% new barriques to impart greater complexity and round out the tannins. This wine has recently won the Decanter 'Red Blend' trophy.	
Bandol Tradition, Domaine Lafran Veyrolles 2006	£36.00
An intense dark brooding wine of damson and cherry fruit with rich woody spice and mixed herbs. Delicious black fruit palate well structured with fine tannins.	
Puech de Glen, La Sauvageonne, AOC Coteaux du Languedoc 2008	£38.00
A huge wine from low yielding Syrah (90%) vines, planted at 400m. Intense, complex, spicy and concentrated, it is distinguished by the quality and elegance of its tannins. It has a mineral character with flavours of leather, mint and flowers abound with a savoury edge.	



Lovely peachy aromas on the nose leading to a full and ripe citrusy white wine. A long and lingering finish with gentle acidity makes it a perfect match with food.	
Chablis Emile Petit 2009	£28.00
Rich honey fruit nose, with mineral overtones, good acidic long finish. From a 'classic' Chablis vintage.	
Bourgogne Blanc, Pierre Boureé 2008	£30.00
This is a powerful vintage for white Burgundy. Glorious fruit balanced with good acidity.	
Saint-Véran, Domaine Clos de Chevigne 2007	£35.00
A serious chardonnay from old vines. Rich, forward fruit, but very focussed,	
Pouilly Fuisse Reserve, Domaine des Maillettes 2008	£40.00
This is a stylish Burgundy from Guy Saumaizes's small estate with rich mealy nougat fruit from fermentation in oak followed by plenty of battonage with spine tingling limey finesse.	

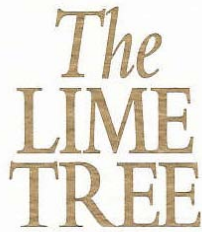

Pernand Verglesses, Vallet Freres 2007	£45.00
The village of Pernand is a bit of a secret nestling just over the hill of Corton that produces wine similar in style to Charlemagne but luckily not in price! This example from Bernard Vallet has richness with a toasty nutty nose.	
Meursault, Vallet Freres 2009	£55.00
A rich green gold colour and a heady, lightly oaked, but seductive nutty bouquet. The palate is pretty fat and buttery but cut with toasty hazelnut flavours and a long mineral balance. A very attractive, well made Mersault from a respected producer.	
Chassagne Montrachet, 1er Cru Champs Gains, Marc Colin 2001	£60.00
The vineyards unique soil structure produces wines with great minerality and the 2001 vintage has matured to perfection. Rich and round with excellent balance and great length	
Puligny Montrachet, 1er Cru, Champs Canet, Etienne Sauzet 2005	£90.00
The vineyard of Champs Canet produces full flavoured wines with great depth of character and a real purity of fruit. Excellent and controlled use of oak barrels adds further complexity and structure. One of the best vintages for a decade.	
Bourgogne Criots-Bâtard-Montrachet Grand Cru, Blain Gagnard, 2000	£90.00
This superb Criots is medium to full bodied, impeccably balanced and extremely long in the finish. A complex, gorgeously focused, impeccably weighty wine with layers of toasty minerals.

Bourgogne Rouge, Pierre Bouree Fils 2008	£26.00
Light delicate garnet colour with smoky, strawberry fruit on the nose, mouthwatering acidity balances the moderate tannins and elegant red fruit. A wine with poise and typicity.	
Bourgogne Pinot Noir, Ramonet, 2006	£35.00
Although Domaine Ramonet is famous for its white wines, his reds are also outstanding. Being based in the village of Chassagne Montrachet, the Bourgogne Rouge he makes is balanced, fruity and structured, with delightful red fruits in the finish. For an entry level Burgundy, this red is exceptional and has the benefit of some bottle aging	
Gevrey-Chambertin, Vallet Frere, Clos de la Justice 2005	£45.00
This superb wine comes from a walled vineyard, situated exactly in the village of Gevrey and is owned solely by Vallet Freres. A structured, light-weight but complex wine, produced using ultra-traditional methods.	
Volnay, Domaine Carre Courbin 1er Cru Taillepieds 1996	£55.00
an elegant wine with a fine, pretty nose of soft red fruits and a drawn out flavour across the palate. Extremely Volnay in character	
Auxey Duresses 1er cru Comte Armand 1999	£55.00
Auxey Duresses is rather a backwater village in the hills behind Mersault, but don't let its unfamiliarity put you off. Comte Armand wines are sensational, marked with a purity and amazing intensity of fruit. Big, well structured and just beginning to show its class.	
Chambolle Musigny, Domaine Jean Jaques Confuron, 1999	£65.00
The village of Chambolle Musigny has a fantastic terroir which produces wines with both elegance and power. The vintage of 1999 was outstanding for red wines and this is now mature and perfect to drink	
Beaune, 'Les Blanches Fleurs', Domaine Tollot-Beaut, 1998	£70.00
Tollot Beaut is a family owned domaine based in Chorey Les Beaune and has been producing wine since 1880. Traditional vinification methods give wines with great colour and fruit quality as well as delightful aromas and length.	
Morey Saint-Denis, 1er Cru 'clos de la Bussiere', Domaine Roumier, 2000	£80.00
Christophe Roumier will surely rank amongst the best wine makers in Burgundy and his wines are highly sort after every year. 'Clos de la Bussiere' is a Monapole owned entirely by the Domaine and produces very structured wines with great fruit and mineral qualities which will be a delight to drink now.	
Clos De Vougeot Grand Cru Domaine Drouhin Laroze 1992	£90.00
A vintage for the Burgundy lovers. Very pure with lovely pinot notes. This is a light wine that has retained its softness and suppleness.

Chateau du Grande Pierre, 1er Cote de Blaye 2006	£20.00
Intense colour with a crimson edge, the aromas are full and ripe with damsons and liquorice combining with notes of Virginia tobacco on the palate. It has a superb entry with masses of chewy fruit, great balance and youthful tannic grip to finish.	
Chateau Doyac, Haut Medoc 2008	£25.00
This well made wine from the northern limit of the Haut Medoc displays everything that is good about modern-day Bordeaux wine making. Accessible, well defined fruit, restrained use of new oak (25%) and a generous rounded finish.	
Chateau La Pointe, Pomerol, 2000	£50.00
Beautiful nose of tobacco and black fruit with hints of cassis, raspberry and liquorice. Round, juicy and creamy in the mouth with firm tannins.	
Chateau La Tour Haut-Brion, cru classe de Graves, 2000	£75.00
Very ripe dark berry fruit that combine concentration and power without the heaviness and excellent balance with impressive mouth feel and moderate tannins	
Chateau Clinet Pomerol 1996	£95.00
Seductively rich, full and expressive. Plummy ripe fruit with blackcurrant overtones and a hint of mint to freshen it up. The wine's concentration and its backbone of minerality help to keep all these sophisticated flavours in check.

Probably the richest, heaviest and most serious of the Cru Beaujolais. Quite Burgundian in character with the ability to age.
- Fleurie " Clos de la Roilette" Domaine Coudert 2009 £24.00
The best known wine of the area, this wine is elegant and persistent with a lovely raspberry and blackberry fruit character. "Flowery, flowing, flirtatious - the most Beaujolais of Beaujolais". Oz Clarke

Rhone

- Cote du Rhone, Chateau St Roch, 2008 £18.00
A delicious, well structured syrah/grenache blend made by the well respected Brunel family from Chateau de la Gardin. Generous ripe fruit with a sophisticated, expansive palate
- Vignes d'Alexandre, Vin de Pays de Mediterranee, France 2009 £22.00
This wine from quite an unknown appellation is made by a renown Chateauneuf Du Pape producer and as such punches well above its weight. Fantastic with beef.
- Croze Hermitage, Cave de Tain, Les Hauts du Fief 2007 £30.00
A typically powerful wine from the Cotes du Rhone, but with a touch of spice, succulent tannins and a great finish.
- Chateauneuf Du Pape, Domaine Chante Cigale 2007 £40.00
This Chateauneuf has previously won the Decanter 'Rhone Varietal' trophy and has impressed Robert Parker "The wine has great fruit, full body, tremendous density and a layered, full-bodied palate with a hint of truffle emerging".
- Chateauneuf Du Pape, Chateau De La Gardine 1998 £55.00
An impressive wine with enorous layers of fine fruit with a complex tanin/acidity balance. Multi layered with the ability to last 10-15 years.

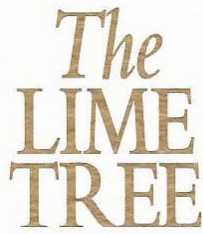

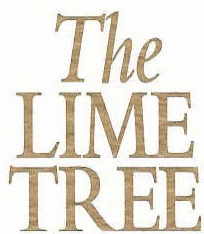
Pinot Grigio, Terrazze della Luna 2009	£20.00
Declared as a single estate vineyard for the first time, and offers a lot more than the usual Pinot Grigio. Luscious concentrated fruit with mineral overtones and a long herbaceous finish.	
Monte Schiavo, Pallo di San Floriano, Italy 2007/8	£22.00
A straw coloured Verdicchio with immediate and fresh aromas of lime and grapefruit, followed up by more developed ripe fruit characters. Complex and creamy palate with notes of almond and a rich persistent finish.	
Soave Pra Classico Superiore 2009	£24.00
Bright, zingy lemony nose, very fresh citrus fruits when young, becoming richer and spicier with peach fruit balancing the dry bite with bottle age. Incredibly long finish - simply outstanding.	
Gewurztraminer Elena Walch Alto Adige 2007	£27.00
A fresh and fragrant wine with elegant fruit flavours and gentle spice. Not as pungent as other gewurztraminers but more precise and elegant, which is the signature of Elena Walch wines.	
Pinot Bianco 'kastelaz' Elena Walch Alto Adige 2009	£30.00
A single vineyard, high altitude wine from the most northern extremities of Italy. Elena Walch is a well respected producer, and this full bodied, richly textured wine is typical of her very precise wine making style.

Valpolicella Classico 'Ripasso', Montresor, Veneto 2008	£28.00
Often described as 'baby Amarone' due to the ripasso method used which gives an extra degree of intensity and quality that the basic Valpolicella lacks.	
Chianti Classico Riserva, La Pagliaia 2006/7	£30.00
A very traditional Chianti; smokey, herby and rich tinged with oaky undertones.	
Nebbiolo d'Alba, Poderi Colla Piemonte 2007	£32.00
This offers the perfect introduction to the Nebbiolo grape. Accessible rich red fruit, generous elements from the 2007 vintage and a finely tuned tannin grip.	
Amarone della Valpolicella, Luigi Righetti 2007	£35.00
This is a deep, ruby red and full bodied wine with a complex nose dominated by dried fruits. Big rich flavours on the palate with a big, smooth finish.	
Valmaggioro, Sandrone Nebbiolo D'Alba Piedmont 2000	£40.00
Sandrone wines have a more modern, international style to them. A rich, ripe, seamless palate with lovely intensity and a savoury edge. Very smooth and integrated.	
Chianti Classico Riserva, Poggio Rosso "San Felice" 2001	£45.00
The estate's flagship wine and 'Three Glasses Award Winner' "One of the best, and certainly best value wines that Tuscany has to offer" (Nick Belfrage).	
Barolo Bussia, Poderi Colla 2006	£58.00
Tarry, Autumnal forest notes, lifted scents of rose and violet plus some serious structure to hang it all on. Forward, open and accessible whilst still offering a full Barolo experience. An outstanding vintage, voted the best of the decade	
Barbaresco, Staderi ' La Spinetta' 1997	£98.00
Dark and deeply expressive with a huge palate of dark roasted fruit, tar, spices, liquorice and a lingering note of menthol. Potent and intense in flavour but very textured and caressing as well

Impressively dense and richly flavoured with vibrant plum and black cherry fruit.

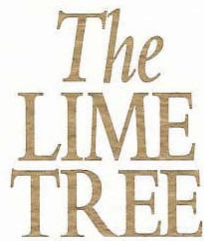
Rioja Sierra Cantabria Crianza 2006/7 £27.00
After 14 months in oak this wine has developed a garnet red colour with orange overtones. Well-balanced tannins with sweet vanilla palate.

Rioja Reserva, Bodegas Riojanas 2004 £30.00
Intense cherry red colour with a tawney rim. Aromas of sweet, ripe red fruit and well integrated oak. Big chunky tannins and tasty black fruit characters on the palate.

Cervoles Negre, Costers del Segre, 2006 £40.00
Initial aromas of ripe plum fruit and jam leads to crushed stone and chocolate notes. On the palate the wine has a deliciously savoury, herbal character - ripe and voluptuous. Tannins are silky smooth and beautifully integrated.

Numanthia, Toro Bodegas Eguren 2000 £50.00
Robert Parker has recently given this wine some seriously high marks, so if you rate his judgement, this is your chance to compare opinions. A powerful, intense wine with a pronounced touch of new oak.

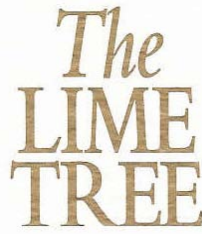

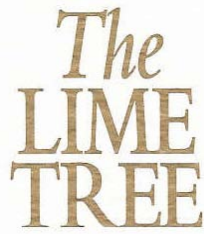
