Junior Programme - What's included?

Academic Programme

Our Junior Programmes are designed for students aged 14-17. Included in our Junior Programmes are 20 group lessons (15 hours) of General English per week. Every student is given an initial placement test to guarantee the most suitable course for their level of English. Students are placed in a class with other juniors of a similar English language level.

Lessons are generally run in the mornings, but we cannot guarantee this timetable during busy periods.

Academic and welfare counselling is provided to our students: information, help and advice in personal and academic matters (including arrangement of medical treatment, if needed).

Student Welfare

Each student's welfare is important to us because we want to make sure that your child is able to make the most of their stay with us. A member of our staff is always available on the ETC emergency phone number, both day and night, to assist students with any emergencies that may arise.

Our Junior Programmes have been designed with the student's welfare in mind so you can be assured your child is safe at all times.

Food

All meals are included in the price of the programme. Breakfast and dinner will be supplied by the student's accommodation provider and lunch will be served in the ETC Café. On weekends, packed lunches will be provided for excursions.

If a student requires a special diet (e.g. no wheat, no pork, no dairy etc.), a supplement of £20 is payable per week.

Transport

Door-to-door transport is included in the Junior Programme if the student is staying with a host family. Students will be picked up from their host families and taken to school in the mornings. They will then be taken home after activities.

Airport transfer and door-to-door are compulsory for all students following a Junior Programme. Please note, we have not included airport transfer in our junior prices, as the price depends on the numbers of students travelling, the airport and time of day.

- Lunch hot meals served in ETC Café Monday Friday
- Wireless or wired Internet throughout the school.
- Bournemouth tour and map, welcome pack and identity card (students should supply at least 2 passport photos).
- A phone with an International SIM card to receive calls and £5 credit.

Students arrive on a Sunday and depart on a Saturday.

Host Family

We provide shared rooms in an ETC junior host family:

Door-to-door transportation between host families and ETC will be provided every day for all junior students staying with a host family.

All our host families are CRB checked and inspected regularly. All students will have a comfortable, clean room with laundry done once per week.

Lunches are provided from Monday to Friday at the college café where there will be a choice of hot or cold meals.

ETC Residence

With CCTV and staff available on site 24/7, students are safe and secure in our Residence next to the school.

All rooms are offered as shared rooms with up to 3 other people. The rooms are cleaned and laundry done once weekly. All bedrooms are equipped with the following:
