Enrolment fee (non-refundable), payable once only: £100 per person.

Age requirements and English Language Courses at ETC

- The minimum age for individual students from September to May is 16.
- The minimum age for individual students from June to August is 14.
- The maximum duration a student aged 15 and under may stay with ETC is 27 nights.
- Individual students aged 15 and under in the summer must book a Junior course. (Pages 8 10)
- Individual students aged 16 and 17 in the summer must book a Junior course if they wish to stay in the Junior Residence.
- · Next of kin details must be received for all students aged 17 and under prior to document issue.
- Signed parental permission forms (signed by the parent) must be received for all students aged 17 and under prior to document issue.

All lessons are 45 minutes long. ETC specifies a maximum class size of 14 however where classrooms permit and are suitably equipped, lit, heated and ventilated, we reserve the right to use these rooms to their maximum capacity. No classes will exceed 18 students. Classes may be in the mornings or the afternoons during busy periods.

ETC Host Families

ETC can arrange host family accommodation for you if you would like to stay with a local family. Many students who come to study at ETC choose this option, because living with an English family is a good way to practise your spoken English outside the school and a great way to find out how British people live.

You will have a comfortable, clean room with a desk to study at. Accommodation is half-board during the week (bed, breakfast and evening meal) and full-board at weekends (bed, breakfast, lunch and evening meal).

Residence (over 18's only)

The ETC Student Residence is located right next door to ETC-a very short walk from one building to the next! We have single, twin, triple and quadruple rooms available on a half board basis. Students who stay in the ETC Student Residence benefit from not needing to pay for any transport between their accommodation and the classrooms.

There is a member of staff on duty at all times and rooms are cleaned once a week. We offer wireless Internet in all rooms and there are study areas for those who want peace and quiet to work in.


How to get to ETC

Academic Programme

Included in our Junior Programmes are 20 group lessons (15 hours) of General English per week. Every student is given an initial placement test to guarantee the most suitable course for their level of English. Students are placed in a class with other juniors of a similar English language level.

Lessons are generally run in the mornings, but we cannot guarantee this timetable during busy periods. In the summer months it is likely that afternoon lessons will also be running.

Student Welfare

We provide shared rooms in an ETC host family.

School transport will be included for students aged 14 and under in host families. Students aged 15-17 will be provided with a bus pass.

All our host families are CRB checked and inspected regularly. All students will have a comfortable, clean room with laundry done once per week.

Lunches are provided from Monday to Friday at the ETC café.

Please note that when booking juniors aged 15 and below with host families they may only stay for a maximum of 27 nights.


