Marques de Casa Concha, Chardonnay *Chile*

An intensely concentrated wine, loaded with pear, fig, a hint of hazelnut and a typical Limari zing! 14.5% abv

The Limari Valley in the north of Chile has emerged as one of the finest growing areas for Chardonnay in the world. The most recent vintage of this wine achieved a coveted 90 points in Robert Parker's Wine Advocate.

Chassange Montrachet 1er Cru, Chardonnay *France*

Full-bodied Chardonnay with citrus, apple and toasty flavours. 13.5% abv

One of the most famous vineyards in Burgundy producing great Chardonnay which is copied the world over but never surpassed.

Paco & Lola, Albarino *Spain*

A harmonious nose of green apple and pear, mingling with herbs and floral hints. 13% abv

This Albarino is made from only the finest grapes of the vintage and is perfectly matched to the fish and seafood dishes of its native Northwest Spain.

Cloudy Bay, Sauvignon Blanc *New Zealand*

Aromas of grapefruit, rhubarb and gooseberry. A cult classic from Marlborough, New Zealand. 13.5% abv

Without doubt, this wine has established Cloudy Bay as a world-class winery. Grapes from eight estates provide the fruit for this intensely grassy-gooseberry Sauvignon Blanc.

SELECT REDS

Pauillac, Rothschild, Cabernet Sauvignon *France*

Very ripe fruit flavours, well rounded with velvet tannins. 12.5% abv

This wine is from the winemaking team at Baron Philippe de Rothschild, famous for Château Mouton. This Pauillac is made with wines from the family's three Grand Cru Classes and matured in oak barrels for eight months.

St Julien, Château Talbot 4eme Cru Clesse, Cabernet Sauvignon *France*

Rich, smoky, Christmas cake with complex blackcurrant, leather and spice flavours. 13% abv

Named after John Talbot, the last Governor of Bordeaux during the period of English ownership in the 15th century, this is a Cabernet Sauvignon and Merlot blend with a fantastic reputation.

bottle - 79.95

Volnay, Louis Jadot, Pinot Noir *France*

Flavours of spice, stewed raspberry and strawberry with a smoky, cedar box, fruit cake finish. 13% abv

Volnay is traditionally the most feminine and elegant of the Côte d'Or red wines. Louis Jadot only ever buy grapes, so they can control the whole process.

Barolo lo Zoccolao, Domini Villa Lanata *Italy*

Ripe blackberries, cherries with an underlying smoky earthiness reminiscent of a bonfire on an Autumn day. 13.5% abv

Estates in the area traditionally only use large Slovenian oak barrels to age the wine. This wine, however, spent some time in French oak as well to add a different dimension before ageing in the Slovenian barrels for a further three years.

Brunello di Montalcino, Villa Poggio Salvi, Sangiovese *Italy*

Shows an intense fragrance of red fruits, notes of flowering grapes, cinnamon and tobacco. 13.5% abv

With some vineyards sitting 480 metres above sea level, the Villa Poggio Salvi estate uses this advantage to produce this exceptional and elegant wine.

Torres Mas la Plana, Cabernet Sauvignon *Spain*

Intense aroma, notes of truffle, toast and wild red berries. Great body and breadth on the palate with juicy tannins that are balanced and elegant. 13.5% abv

The 29 hectare Mas la Plana vineyard is one of the finest in the Torres Estate. The best parcels of Cabernet Sauvignon are selected to produce this superb wine.

Le Prieure, Jean-Luc Colombo St Joseph, Syrah *France*

A full-bodied wine with aromas of small ripe black fruits, liquorice and spices. 13% abv

Saint Joseph is one of the best Appellations in the northern Rhone for producing top class, deeply flavoured wine made from Syrah grapes.

Enzo Vincenzo, Amarone *Italy*

Complex and concentrated, dark berried, hearty and rewarding. 15% abv

Carefully chosen bunches are allowed to dry on traditional straw mats for four months. This 'Ferrari of Italian wines' is produced from semi-dried Corvina grapes, resulting in an immense concentration of flavour.

WHITES

Antonio Rubini, Pinot Grigio *Italy*

Ripe apple, apricot and pear on the palate, finishing with a crisp citrus hit. 12% abv

Predominantly from Trentino and Friuli, these grapes are ripened for longer resulting in a deeper and more complex flavour.

Ben & Rudi, Chenin Blanc *South Africa*

Zesty nose, crisp with ripe limes and mild guava flavours, crisp acidities balance the juicy finish. 12.5% abv

The lift and freshness comes from the cool, mountain slopes, the more rounded and creamy element is thanks to fruit from the warmer climate of the Tulbagh valley, produced by the award-winning team at Tulbagh Winery.

La Fonda, Sauvignon Blanc *Chile*

Light, fresh and very well-balanced with aromas of citrus and peach. 13.5% abv

Velero, Airen Chardonnay *Spain*

Light and fresh with apricot and pineapple flavours. 12% abv

From La Mancha, which has the largest area of land under vine in the world.

Luigi Leonardo, Chardonnay *Italy*

Light in style with apple character. Finish is fresh, fruitful and lifted. 12% abv

Verdejo VQ, Sauvignon Blanc *Spain*

Aromatic with peachy notes and hints of tropical fruit. Rounded and fruitful with a slight spice to the finish. 11% abv

Based in the heart of Castilla la Mancha (known as the golden triangle of viticulture in the area), the winery has blended their two top white wines to create this fantastic marriage specifically for us.

La Minaia, Gavi de Gavi *Italy*

Steely citrus fruit, green apples. Perfect with seafood. 12.5% abv

Chablis, Brocard, Chardonnay *France*

Dry, elegant, aromatic green apples. Delicate floral notes with citrus weight. 12% abv

Sancerre, Les Collinettes, Sauvignon Blanc *France*

Classic blackcurrant leaf, gooseberry and cut grass aromas with a flinty mineral flavour. 12.5% abv

Denbies Flint Valley *England*

Reichensteiner and Sayval Blanc grapes, delicately oaked; zesty, fresh with citrus notes. 11% abv

Los Vascos, Chardonnay *Chile*

Vibrant and fresh with explosive fruits and notes of hazelnut. 14% abv

Little Yerring, Chardonnay *Australia*

Great intensity, white nectarines, creamy nutty texture. 13% abv

Rothschild, Viognier *France*

Rich vanilla and honey with long, round fruitiness.

Wonderful hints of apricot and peach. 13.5% abv

Mount Cook Lily, Sauvignon Blanc *New Zealand*

Intense and refreshing, gooseberry fruit flavours. 13% abv

From the iconic Marlborough region on New Zealand's South island, this wine uses a blend of grapes from across the region.

Trimbach, Gewurtraminer *France*

Fresh grapey nose, peppery finish, dry but extremely full-bodied. 12% abv

Good weight in the mouth and delicate stone fruit flavours with lychee to finish. 13% abv

Pouilly Fume, Jean-Claude Chatelain, Sauvignon Blanc *France*

Gooseberry and cut grass with a flinty, mineral finish. 12.5% abv

Fontanafredda, Moscato *Italy*

Grapes, spiced pears, honey and ripe peaches. 5.5% abv

Sauternes, les Garonnelles, Semillon *France*

Sweet, rich and full of apricot, peach and honey flavours, but with a crisp finish. 13.5% abv

ROSÉS

VQ, Merlot *Spain*

Ripe, rounded and fruitful, strawberry and cream aromas, plummy palate with a refreshing finish. 12% abv

Argento, Malbec *Argentina*

Seductive aromas of fresh red berries. Soft cherry flavours and a hint of melon with a fruity finish. 13% abv

This wine is made from grapes grown on some of the highest vineyards in the world. The lack of pollution and crystal clear mountain water results in a wine that is ultra pure.

Velero, Tempranillo Grenache *Spain*

A soft and fruity rosé showing notes of strawberry jam. 12% abv
Made in La Mancha in central Spain, the area is famous for the tales of Don Quixote.

Cerasuolo, Montepulciano *Italy*

Medium-bodied with wild cherries, cream and sherbet flavours. 13% abv

Antonio Rubini, Pinot Grigio Rosé *Italy*

The delicate salmon pink colour is produced by using certain Pinot Grigio vines that produce grapes with pink skins.

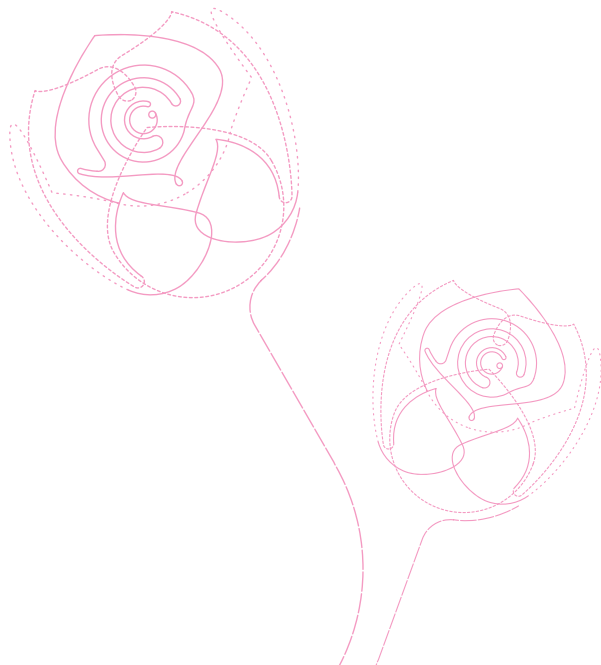

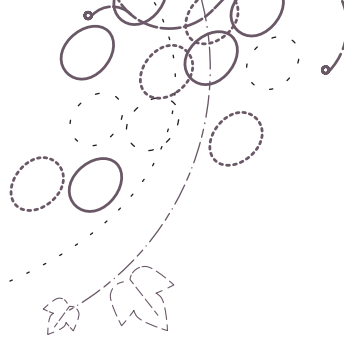
Lychees, violets, crunchy summer fruits. 12% abv

Luigi Leonardo, Sangiovese *Italy*

Seriously good, incredibly easy to drink. Ripe cherries and berries. 13.5% abv

Principal grape variety of Chianti, yet soft, young, cherry fresh and with little tannin produces quite a different style. Wine maker Stefano named these wines after his father and son.

Velero, Tempranillo Cabernet *Spain*

Cabernet Sauvignon. Cherry red colour. Smooth with hints of blackcurrant and plum. 12.5% abv

Tempranillo is the red grape of Spain. It contributes to the most expensive wines from Rioja and Ribero del Duero, blended here with Cabernet Sauvignon.

Santa Rosato, Merlot *Chile*

Ripe and plush in its fruit, lots of berry and plum character, ripe and rounded, finishing smooth and well-balanced. 13.5% abv

Ben & Rudi, Cabernet Shiraz *South Africa*

Inviting dark fruited aromas, warm spice and blackberry ripeness in the mouth with an underlying South African roasted earthiness. 14% abv

These two classic varieties ripen effortlessly in the warm valley floor, with powerful results.

Hawk Crest, Merlot *USA*

Plum and vanilla flavours coat the mouth and dance along the palate through a lingering finish. 13.5% abv

Rich red fruits in the mouth and a soft silky finish. 12.5% abv

The charming 18th-century Château, surrounded by some 22 hectares of prime vineyards and enjoying the best sites in Fleurie is owned and run by the Loron family.

Leza Garcia, Rioja *Spain*

Tempranillo. Luscious raspberry and dark cherry aromas, toasted vanilla and liquorice joins the fruit in the mouth. Ripe, generous and rewarding. 13% abv

Seductive and soft, brilliant ruby red with mature fruitiness. 14% abv

Aromas of bramble, blackcurrant, spice and mint with flavours of red fruit and ripe berry. A distinct mocha oak character. 14.5% abv

Casa Juanita, Malbec *Argentina*

Hefty and deep fruited with a great warm structure. 13.5% abv

Born in France but put on the map by Argentina, Malbec thrives here, with grapes grown at the foot of the Andes.

14 Hands, Merlot *USA*

This approachable and easy drinking red wine offers generous aromas of berries, cherries and currants. A plush framework of soft tannins supports the red and dark fruit flavours that leisurely give way to subtle notes of baking spice and mocha on the finish.

Montepulciano, d'Abruzzo DOC Riserva *Italy*

Concentrated, rich, full-bodied wine with exceptional length. 13.5% abv

A little-known variety that produces wine of phenomenal character, this fantastic wine was introduced to the UK by us.

Delicious round texture with hints of vanilla and chocolate. 14% abv

SPARKLING

Château de Sours Reserve, Rosé *France*

Fresh delicate red berry bouquet. Trillions of tiny bubbles dance onto the palate. Dry and crisp with crushed raspberry. Great finesse, depth and length. 12% abv

Château de Sours have been producing extraordinarily good wine for over 200 years. This is the only sparkling rosé in Bordeaux to be produced using the traditional method, which gives it such amazing depth and flavour yet retains that all important elegance and tiny bubbles.

Prosecco della Venezia *Italy*

All the charm and sophistication of Champagne, yet softer and more fruity. 11% abv

Displaying all the qualities one would expect from a wine holding DOC status, this is a most fashionable fizz. Sister wine to the über-popular Perla Rosa.

Moët & Chandon, Champagne *France*

A perfect blend of Chardonnay, Pinot Noir and Pinot Meunier creating a balanced and harmonious palate. 12% abv

Cono Sur, Bio Bio Valley, Brut *Chile*

Delightfully fresh and easy to drink, this great sparkler shows delicate aromas of citrus and white flowers. 12.5% abv

Produced in Bio Bio in the far south of Chile this is one of the country's most successful sparkling wines. Cono Sur (Southern Cone) is the Chilean description of the continent of South America, due to its conical shape.

Perla Rosa *Italy*

Fresh strawberry, cherry and floral notes. Dry, crisp and fresh, with an abundance of tiny bubbles dancing on the palate. 11% abv

Lively and generous with radiant colour and intense fruitiness. 12% abv

A delicate and complex Cava with attractive red fruit and floral aromas, creamy texture and toasty notes. 12% abv

Ridgeview, Victoria Cuvée Rosé *England*

Delicate salmon pink in colour. Honey, red berries and toast on the palate. 12.5% abv

Ridgeview is a family company dedicated to producing the highest quality sparkling wine from classic varieties and traditional methods, situated in the English South Downs. Named in honour of Englishman Christopher Merret who in 1662 was the first person to record the process of making traditional method sparkling wines, 30 years before the technique was documented in Champagne.
