| 5 | Moko Black Marlborough Sauvignon Blanc, New Zealand, 2011

Lightly dry yet extremely fresh, the balanced and elegant structure makes this an unusually refined and aristocratic wine. | | £21.95 |

| 8 | Sancerre La Clochette, Loire, France, 2011
Unoaked, the palate is rich in fruit flavours and finishes with a balance of texture and refreshing acidity. | | £33.95 |
| 9 | Domaine de la Motte Chablis Premier Cru Vau-Ligneau 'Tastevinage', Burgundy, France, 2009
Typically flinty and grassy edge to still quite primary Chardonnay fruit on the nose, followed by crisp, linear flavours which have real edge and definition. It fills out in mid-palate with a tingling finish. | | £45.95 |
| 10 | Albariño Lagar de Bouza, DO Rias Baixas, Spain, 2010
Albariño has long been likened to Riesling for its lemony, crisp style but this indigenous grape of the region of Galicia has a personality very much of its own. | | £30.95 |
| 11 | Turckheim Reserve Riesling, Alsace, France, 2010
Powerful citrus and floral fruit characters balanced with great minerality and a long crisp finish. | | £28.95 |
| 12 | Turckheim Reserve Gewurtztraminer, Alsace, France, 2011
Pale golden colour with perfumed aromatics of lychees, rose petals and spice. This complex, full bodied wine is loaded with spice and intense fruit on the finish. | | £31.95 |
| 13 | Pierre Bourée Puligny Montrachet, Burgundy, France, 2009
Lovely toasty notes, with aromas of hazelnuts, herbs, butter and spices. The palate has more lovely toasty complexity, fantastic brioche, hazelnuts and cooking apples. | | £90.00 |

- 14 **Rioja Blanco Fermentado en Barrica, Rioja, Spain, 2010** **£26.95**
 A beautifully balanced example of white Rioja that straddles the styles of the old and the new. Vibrant citrusy Viura is blended with the more weighty Malvasia and the brief barrel maturation adds a honeyed roundness to the crisp lemony fruit.
- 15 **Sepp Grüner Veltliner, Kremstal, Austria, 2011** **£25.95**
 The palate has flavours of bright lime, lemon and grapefruit with steely minerality and refreshing acidity. The wine has a surprisingly weighty texture and a mouthwatering finish.
- 16 **Valet-Freres Meursault Premier Cru, Burgundy, France, 2010** **£79.00**
 Rich green-gold colour with a heady, lightly oaky bouquet; the palate is fat and buttery cut through with hazelnut flavours and long mineral balance.
- 17 **Eberle Viognier Paso Robles, California, 2010** **£54.00**
 The Viognier perfumes the nose with aromas of honeysuckle, citrus blossoms and apricots. Its vibrant flavors of ripe pears, peaches, almonds and spice add to the lush mid-palate of this exceptional wine.

- 18 **San Vigilio Pinot Grigio Blush, Venetie, Italy, 2011** **£15.95**
 A quality, summer fruit blush. Dry and fresh. 175ml Glass **£4.35**
- 19 **Chateau Houchart Rosé, "Côtes de Provence, France", 2011** **£19.95**
 The nose is fresh, with strawberries and red berries notes, 175ml Glass **£4.90**
 combined with delicate aromas of yellow peach and grapefruit. Fresh and delicious, with a fine finish, it is well balanced and long in mouth. Easy to drink!
 It suits Asian dishes, along with goats cheese.
- 20 **Domaine Michel Girard Sancerre Rose, Loire, France, 2011** **£38.95**
 Fragrant aromas of grapefruit and citrus with a waft of mineral pungency. Full and round in the mouth with further fruity grapefruit and orange flavours but also almond nuttiness, supported by elegant zingy lees and acidity.

25	Trivento Reserva Malbec, Argentina, 2011 Aged in French oak barrels for 6 months and in Bottle for 5 months, this is a bright, attractive red. Plum and raspberry aromas mingle elegantly with vanilla notes from the oak. The palate is well balanced and exhibits sweet, silky tannins.		£22.95
26	De Alto Amo Rioja Reserva, Rioja, Spain, 2007 The palate is soft, velvety, full, well rounded and balance, with a persistent and long fruity after-taste.		£26.95
27	Mr Smith Shiraz, McLaren Vale, South Australia, 2010 A preposterously lush Shiraz from some of the gnarliest vines we have ever seen! This dense, dark, brooding and incredibly impressive wine is bursting with ripe and expressive red and dark fruits, with a finish that lasts forever.		£33.95
28	Sepp Zweigelt, Kremstal, Austria, 2011 Fruity and perfumed nose showing blackberries and red cherries, with lightly smoky, tarry notes. Supple, animated palate with fresh acidity, good concentration of red berry fruit and layers of spice, liquorice, herbs and a streak of minerality.		£25.95
29	Amarone Classico Montresor Brevettata, Veneto, Italy, 2008 Hints of coffee and chocolate on the nose, with plenty of forward sweet blackberry and plum fruit on the palate. This wine has supple tannins and a rich texture, and is excellent with red meats, game or hard cheeses - especially Parmesan.		£69.00
30	Montepulciano d'Abruzzo, Gran Sasso, d'Abruzzo, Italy, 2011 Deep black-red in colour with a youthful dark purple rim. It is ripe and spicy on the nose, with perfumes of red berries and chocolate with a rich, supple tannic structure and a rounded ripe blackberry fruit character.		£23.95
31	La Chapelle Cotes du Rhone Villages, Rhone, France, 2011 Delicious bramble fruit aromas complement the rich fruit flavours which are backed up with a hint of cloves and cinnamon. Luscious, full, rich and easy to drink as tannins are smooth and supple.		£21.95
32	Les Pivoines, Beaujolais Villages, Beaujolais, France, 2011 "Meet the Producer" Exuberant fruity red wine with juicy crushed strawberries and cherry characters. The palate is soft and approachable with vibrant acidity and a mouthwatering bitter cherry finish.		£21.95

- 33 **Fleurie, La Madone, La Reine de L'Arenite, Beaujolais / Maconnais, 2011** **£28.95**
A heady perfume of freshly picked irises and peonies drift above the crushed berry fruit nose. The fleshy, luscious, cherry flavours and hints of rose are typically vivacious, backed up with a touch of spice and good depth.
- 34 **Domaine Chante Cigale Chateauneuf du Pape, Rhone, France, 2009** **£56.95**
Lots of warm black fruit and plum aromas, with cinnamon, spices, pepper and a hint of vanilla. The palate is concentrated with damsons, red fruit, spice and stony minerality with a very elegant and warm finish.
- 35 **Louis Latour Domaine de Valmoissine Pinot Noir, Coteaux du Verdon, France, 2010** **£29.95**
A deep red coloured wine with bold, lively fruit aromas. Medium acidity, supple tannins and round structure all combine deliciously with floral flavours to create a elegant and restrained wine.
- 36 **Château les Giraudels de Milon, St Emilion Grand Cru 2005, Bordeaux, France, 2005** **£57.00**
Intense, young and tightly knit fruit, the palate is almost introverted and washed over with lashings of youthful red fruit.
- 37 **Château La Tour de Mons, Cru Bourgeois, Margaux 2007, Bordeaux, France, 2007** **£66.00**
"Beautifully lifted violets and blackberry fruit. A complex palate with hints of mocha, wood smoke, blackcurrent leaf and seductive tannins. It has a silky mouthfeel, leading to firm chocolate tannins. 2007 Margaux is great for drinking from 2011 onwards!"
- 38 **Poggio Al Tesoro 'Sondraia' Bolgheri Superiore - Super Tuscan DOC, Bolgheri, Italy, 2009** **£75.00**
Plush, warm and full, with velvety, ripe tannins giving structure to the ripe, plummy fruit on the palate with touch of rosemary and eucalyptus on the finish.
