## Lebanon

*Lebanon is the oldest site of wine production in the world. The Phoenicians of its coastal strip were instrumental in spreading wine and viticulture throughout the Mediterranean in ancient times. Lebanese winemakers have favoured French grapes, particularly Cabernet Sauvignon, Merlot and Rhone varieties such as Cinsaut, Carignan and Grenache. However Lebanon has a rich heritage of indigenous grapes which are attracting more attention, for instance Musar White is made from a blend of Obaideh and Merwah. The Lebanese claim that Obaideh is an ancestral form of Chardonnay - it's not impossible that it may have contributed genetically via the Gouais blanc of the Balkans. (Wikipedia)*

*All Lebanese wine producers use grapes grown in the Bekaa Valley. With an average altitude of 1000m above sea level, the valley's climate is very suitable to vineyards. Abundant winter rain and much sunshine in the summer help the grapes ripen easily. There are more than a dozen wineries in the Bekaa Valley, producing over six million bottles a year.*
