Barley wine is a beer style of strong ale originating in England. American strong ale is a broad category to describe ales of 7.0% ABV or higher. Beers in this category may also be classified as double IPAs or old ales. English Strong Ales are strong pale ales above the strength of 5% ABV; they are malty and usually sweet with some fruity esters. In colour they tend to range from medium amber up to a dark red-amber.
