Prosecco d'Oro, Casa Defra, Italy (11%)

£26.00

Delightfully soft & creamy sparkler with aromatic apple & pear flavours on the nose followed by a crisp palate of succulent fruits. Gently foamy, just off dry & possessing an enticing, bright finish

Grande Reserve, Pierre Mignon, France (12%)

£45.00

Light pale yellow with a big mousse with a yeasty perfumed apple nose and touches of cream and nougat. Nice palate expression and fresh fruit lift on the finish.

Airen-Sauvignon Blanc, Castillo del Moro, Spain (11.5%)

This is fresh and zesty on the nose with citrus notes and a crisp, grassy palate

Tempranillo-Syrah, Castillo del Moro, Spain (13%)

Smooth with rich, ripe dark fruits & smoky spices and a juicy finish

Sangiovese, Terre Allegre, Italy (12%)

Juicy and ripe red fruit notes from the famous Chianti grape but grown in sun-kissed Puglia

Rosé:

Tempranillo Rosado, Castillo del Moro, Spain (12.5%)

Succulent wild strawberry, raspberry & cranberry fruit - crisp & well-balanced

White

Calusari Pinot Grigio, Umbrele, Romania (12.5%)

£17.00

Deliciously fresh, dry style with crisp apple and pear. Light, juicy palate with vibrant hints of grapefruit and pineapple

Costa Vera Chardonnay, Indomita, Chile (13.5%)

£17.00

Golden, buttery notes and gentle tropical fruit flavours abound in this generous and easy wine

Musacdet de Sevre et Mains sur lie, Chateau Bigotiere, France (12%)

£22.50

Wonderfully vibrant wine full of citrus & mineral notes from the gneiss soil on which the grapes are grown (40 year old vines). Estate is currently run by brothers, Cedric & Christophe Gobin and has been in the same family for four generations. SILVER MEDAL MACON 2011

Rioja Blanco Fermentado en Barrica, Luis Canas, Spain (13.5%)

£25.00

Modern style white Rioja with hints of lime, and a touch of honey and some vanilla from the 3 months in new French and American oak. Lovely creamy texture

Marlborough Sauvignon Blanc, Tinpot Hut, New Zealand (13%)	£31.00
<i>Intense, lifted aromas reminiscent of blackcurrant, lemongrass & thyme with passionfruit notes. A complex palate with classic Blind River Vineyard characters that shine through: blackcurrant bud & sweet green herbs; with underlying ripe fruit & mineral notes. A pleasingly rich & powerful wine with well-balanced acidity & a long lingering finish</i>	
Chablis, Laroche, France (12%)	£35.00
<i>Bright yellow colour. Precise pear & apple fruit dominate the nose, with hints of wet stone & honey behind. The palate is medium to full, with a complex mix of pear, honey & citrus fruit, & excellent balancing acidity that lasts well onto the finish</i>

Monastrell Rosado, Bodegas Castano, Spain (13%)	£20.00
<i>Rich strawberry, cherry and dried herb aromas. Flavours of strawberry, cherry and spice. Creamy mouthfeel and lovely fresh acidity</i>	
Rosato, A Mano, Italy (13.5%)	£22.50
<i>Gently fruity nose, lovely bright, extremely pale pink in colour with a sun-kissed fruity palate. Cherry led fruit with a little bitter twist on the finish</i>	
<u>Red</u>	
Calusari Pinot Noir, Umbrele, Romania (13.5%)	£17.00
<i>Aromas of violets, dried cherries & hints of tobacco. Juicy, light, berry-filled palate with a smooth, velvety finish</i>	
Costa Vera Cabernet Sauvignon, Indomita, Chile (13%)	£17.00
<i>Classic blackcurrant flavours and ripe berry juiciness, coupled with a long length and satin finish</i>	
McLaren Vale Shiraz, 16 Stops, Australia (14%)	£23.50
<i>Youthful and vibrant, with a lovely dark fruit and spiced plum character on the nose. The oak supports the fruit, which is bright and lively yet plush and fleshy on the palate. The tannins are ripe and silky, giving the wine a texture that is unusual at this price</i>	
Pinotage, Fairview, South Africa (14%)	£26.00
<i>Vibrant spicy with smoky dark fruit aromas and flavours. Full-bodied, brambly fruit, savoury, ripe soft tannins and a long smooth finish. Modern, stylish, ripe and very drinkable!</i>	
Rioja Reserva, Bodegas Izadi, Spain (13.5%)	£32.50
<i>This is modern in style and extremely food friendly with lively rich fruit and gentle, spicy oak</i>	
Les Graves de Mahon-Laville, Chateau Laville, France	£35.00
<i>Aged for 3 months in oak. Deep purple colour with concentrated plum and spice from the Merlot, alongside minerality that is typical of this region. A powerful but smooth palate, with the Cabernet Sauvignon adding firm tannins and fine structure to the finish. A real bit of class at this price</i>

Vin Doux, Samos, Greece (15%)	£15.00 (half bottle)
<i>An orange/gold wine with an orange muscat nose and oodles of marmalady fruit. Good finishing acidity and mandarin notes on a long length</i>	
Pink Moscato, Innocent Bystander, Australia (5.5%)	£17.50 (half bottle)
<i>"A pretty, gentle sparkler. Imbued with red fruits, elderflower and a twist of the exotic, this has an enchanting sweetness, which is great both as an aperitif and a dessert wine." Decanter Magazine</i>	
Cadillac, Chateau Fayau, France (13.5%)	£21.00 (half bottle)
<i>Made just across the river from Sauternes, this is a brilliant gold colour with gold straw hue. Aroma of apricot, honey and spice. The palate is quite luscious, with flavours of lemon, honey, honeycomb and spice. Clean finish. Long aftertaste of honey and honeycomb</i>	
Elysium Black Muscat, Quady Winery, California (15%)	£27.50 (half bottle)
<i>Liquid Black Forest Gateaux! Heavenly (that's why it's called Elysium)...</i>
