	Muscadet Côtes de Grandlieu sur Lie, Domaine des Herbauges, France '10/11£29.95 Full, rich style with amazing personality and length.
	Sauvignon de Touraine Le Courlis, Clos du Porteau, Loire, France '10/11£30.95 Citrus zest and gooseberry with balanced minerality and good length.
	Picpoul de Pinet, Domaine Roquemolière, Languedoc Roussillon, France '10£31.45 Crisp, light and aromatic.
	Chenin, Pecan Stream, Stellenbosch, South Africa '10/11£32.95 A tasty ripe fruit of melon and guava from Kevin Arnold one of South Africa's leading winemakers.
	Petit Chablis, Olivier Tricon, Burgundy, France '10/11£35.95 Bright, elegant with traditional crisp minerality and refreshing citrus-like acidity.
	Douro Crasto, Douro, Portugal '09/10£37.95 Crunchy green apple, camomile and lemons on the nose followed by fresh and crisp palate.
	Chablis, Domaine de Vauroux, Burgundy, France '09/10£39.95 Pure fruit flavours of white peaches and pears and a classic, steely, dry finish.
	Gavi di Gavi, La Minaia, Nicola Bergaglio, Piemonte, Italy '10/11£41.95 Crisp and dry, with hints of ripe pears and a complex array of red and green apple notes.
	Gewurztraminer Reserve, Trimbach, Alsace, France '05£42.95 The nose shows complex development as the primary lychee fruit segues into beeswax and camomile. In the palate there are lush lemons and mouthfilling grapiness, tropical fruit and a hint of smoke.
	Isabel Sauvignon, Isabel Estate, Marlborough, New Zealand '10/11£44.95 One of Marlborough's finest. Lovely floral notes with a delicious fresh minerality on the palate.
	Pouilly Fumé, Château Favray, Loire, France '10/11£45.95 Round, lush wine with depth of fruit, fantastic concentration and superb balance.
	Sancerre Blanc, Domaine du Carrou, Dominique Roger, Loire, France '10/11£48.45 A grassy nose with hints of gooseberries; well balanced palate with a good concentration of fruit and racy acidity.
	Gimblett Gravels Chardonnay, Trinity Hill, Hawkes Bay, New Zealand '08/09£49.95 Figs and grapefruit with mealy, biscuity barrel ferment and integrated oak characters adding complexity. The texture is silky and concentrated, with a long lasting finish.

	Shiraz Reserve, Tooma River, South Eastern Australia '11 £4.50
	Biferno Rosso Riserva DOC, Camillo De Ellis, Molise, Italy '07/08 £5.00£6.50£24.45 The bouquet is complex and intense with hints of blackberry jam. On the palate the wine is velvety and harmonious with pleasant, firm tannins.
	Malbec Eco Organic, Bodegas Santa Ana, Mendoza, Argentina '10/11£28.95 Sweet aromas of blackberries and plums. Velvety texture accompanied by soft tannins and a long length.
	Merlot Cabernet, Château La Freynelle, Bordeaux, France '09/10£29.95 A well balanced red offering ripe, spicy fruit and savoury characters with a long, elegant finish.
	Montepulciano d'Abruzzo, Organic, Colline Teramane, Abruzzo, Italy '09/10£32.45 An intense bouquet of fresh red fruit and strawberries; on the palate it is a medium bodied wine, with an intense lingering finish.
	Douro, Quinta do Crasto, Douro, Portugal '09/10£33.45 Rich and spicy with ripe tannins and a long, smooth, velvety finish.
	Cahors Cuvee Prestige Château Croze de Pys, Cahors, France '05£33.95 Mature black cherry nose, rich with a hint of dark chocolate and rounded finish.
	Syrah Reserva, Vina Falernia, Elqui Valley, Chile '07£34.95 Very bright colour; elegant nose with black pepper and floral notes. Medium-full bodied with very soft tannins and good balance. Great length and fruity after taste.
	Ebano 6, Ribera Del Duero, Duero Valley, Spain '09£37.95 Medium to full bodied with a powerful structure given by warm, ripe tannins.
	Pinot Noir Select Reserve, Familia Schroeder, Patagonia '08/09£39.45 Superb concentration of ripe strawberry fruit, rich and full of Pinot character.
	Bourgogne Pinot Noir, Château de la Charrière, Burgundy, France '08/09£40.95 Light but flavoursome with red fruits such as strawberries, raspberries and cherries.
	Château des Gravieres, Graves, France '06£44.95 A fine Graves with a sumptuous rich fruit exhibiting a savoury round character.
	Fleurie, Domaine Roche – Guillon, Beaujolais, France '09£44.95 A serious example with richness and depth of fruit that belies its Gamey origins, served chilled on request.
	Château La Tuilerie des Combes, Lussac St. Emilion, Bordeaux, France '08/09£46.95 A dense palate of black cherries and chocolate with notes of liquorice and eucalyptus finishing dry and clean.
	Isabel Pinot Noir, Isabel Estate, Marlborough, New Zealand '08/09£53.95 Voluptuous and alluring with classic notes of ripe plums strawberry and spice, simply gorgeous.

Vermentino di Gallura Branu DOCG, Vigne Surrau, Sardinia, Italy '09/10..... £50.95 Starbright pale lemon yellow with an intensely floral nose of Mediterranean scrub herbs.

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Pouilly Fuissé, Domaine Saumaize-Michelin, Burgundy, France '09/10....... £54.95 Succulent, ripe nose of creamy vanilla and pineapples. Rounded and generous palate, offering ripe grapefruits and lemon rind and soft finish.

Cometa, Planeta, Fiano Sicily, Italy '09£55.95 Intense and full of character, with integrated aromatic notes of citrus and tropical fruit, white peach, pink grapefruit and wisteria. On the palate it has plenty of character with elegantly mineral elements.

Pouilly Loche 'Monopole', Domaine Clos de Rocs, France '05......£58.95 Fine Burgundian nose, ripe fruit, elegant mineral notes on the finish.


Meursault Domaine Jean-Philippe Fichet, Burgundy, France '08/09....£79.95 Beautifully crafted a balance of fruit with acidity and that classic stoney mineral edge.

Riesling Cuvée Frédéric Emile, Trimbach, Alsace, France '05.....£84.95 Very attractive already, quite powerful nose. Full bodied wine with intensity, depth and beautiful mineral flavour. Rich, ripe acidity in the palate. Great personality and finesse.

Chablis Grand Cru Les Clos, Domaine Louis Michel, France '09.....£98.00 White pepper and nutmeg complete the predominantly mineral character. This wine may appear austere and virile but is expressive in the mouth and designed to age for many years, excellent with salmon, lobster or shellfish.
