California, United States of America. Bright aromas of boysenberry, cherry, raspberry and banana. The fruit complexion on the palate is equally bright, dominated by boysenberry and raspberry.

32. Barbera Amonte, Volpi, 2011

Piemonte, Italy. Deliciously fruity with notes of blueberries, cherries and rapsberries. Robust with a persitent finish.

38. Douro Red, Quinta do Crasto, 2010 £21.00 Douro, Portugal. Rich and spicy with ripe tannins and a long, smooth, velvety finish.

40. Basket Pressed Cabernets, Skillogalee, 2007 £27.50 South Australia. Full and soft with sweet, leafy fruit flavours, rich vanillin oak and firm, drying tannins on a lingering finish.

41. Chianti Classico Dentro, Cecchi, 2010 £22.50 Tuscany, Italy. Full and rich, characterised by hints of violets balanced with great structure allied to fine fruit.

42. Botrytised Viognier, Trinity Hill, £9.00 £25.50 2010 (37.5cl)

Hawkes Bay, New Zealand. Aromas reminiscent of honey and crystallized apricots. The botrytis has a big effect, with floral hints and jasmine. It is very luscious and concentrated, with strong flavours of dried fruits, especially apricots.

43. Liqueur Muscat, Skillogalee, NV (75cl) £8.50 £45.00 South Australia. This shows nutty, raisin and apricot flavours, and is full and sweet enough to match well with the sweetest desserts (even chocolate!).

44. Cabernet Franc Icewine, Peller, £17.95 £53.00 2010 (37.5cl)

Ontario, Canada. A rich mouth-feel with wonderful fruit flavours of red berries and rhubarb. Red currants, spice and pomegranate on a long lingering finish.

45. Late Harvest Sauvignon Blanc, £6.50 £17.95 Concha Y Toro 2008 (37.5cl)

Maule Valley, Chile. Light and aromatic with lovely acidity. Delicious floral, honey flavours.
