Sparkling Wine

- 2. Rose Brut Cleto, Chiarli, NV** **Bottle £25.00**
Emilia Romagna, Italy. Intense and fruity bouquet followed by a well balanced palate of red currant and wild berry fruit notes.
- 3. Grosvenor Cuvee Merret, (Blanc de Blancs) Ridgeview, 2009** **£31.50**
Sussex, England. Very distinct fruit flavours are dominant with citrus / grapefruit characters but also some tropical fruit. Brioche flavours will continue to develop and deepen over the next 2 to 3 years.
- 4. Camel Valley Brut Rose, NV** **£39.95**
Cornwall, England. Award winning sparkling rose with delicious red berry flavours.

Champagne

- 5. Louis Roederer Brut Premier, NV** **Bottle £60.00**
Champagne, France. Superb champagne from one of the oldest champagne houses. Dry, biscuit, toasty flavours.

Champagne Half Bottles

- 6. Ruinart Blanc de Blanc Brut NV** **£37.50**
Champagne, France. Aromatic nose with fresh, clean flavours on the palate.
- 7. Ruinart Rose Brut NV** **£37.50**
Champagne, France. Delightful cherry and ripe summer berries on the palate and intensely aromatic on the nose.

White Wine Light & Crisp

- 1. La Lande Comte Tolosan, 2011** **Bottle £14.50**
Gascony, France. A nose of apples, grapefruit and mown grass. A light, crisp palate with bracing freshness.
- 19. Petit Chenin, Ken Forrester Wines, 2011** **£17.50**
Western Cape, South Africa. Supple and spicy Chenin Blanc with a steely edge.
- 15. Pinot Grigio IGT, Veritiere, 2011** **£14.95**
Veneto, Italy. Light and slightly spicy with flavours of fresh peaches and lemons and a delicate, nutty finish.
- 16. Bacchus, Shawsgate Bacchus, 2010** **£22.50**
Suffolk, England. Elderflower, citrus and honeyed tropical fruits is supported with a well balanced and satisfying palate. Gentle acidity and good fruit flavours, particularly grapefruit. Try it if you like New World Sauvignon Blanc!
- 18. Gruner Veltliner Federspiel Kollmutz, Erich Machherndl, 2011** **£23.50**
Wachau, Austria. Fruity & well balanced with a slightly minty finish.

Fruity & Aromatic

- 14. Sauvignon Reserva, Vina Leyda, 2011** **Bottle £18.95**
Leyda Valley, Chile. Intense and fruity on the nose with citrus aromas of grapefruit and mandarin. Bright on the palate with citrus and apple character.
- 22. Mariona Alicante Blanco, Artiga, 2011** **£17.50**
Alicante, Spain. Intensely perfumed and seductive with a range of exotic aromas and flavours of lychee, jasmine, rosewater and mango.
- 23. Gavi di Gavi, La Minaia, Nicola Bergaglio, 2011** **£23.00**
Piemonte, Italy. Crisp and dry, with hints of ripe pears and a complex array of red and green apple notes; the finish is mouthwateringly refreshing and lengthy.
- 24. Riesling, Trimbach, 2010** **£25.00**
Alsace, France. Elegant and classic with grapefruit and white peach on the nose and a crisp lemony acid backbone leading in to a long finish.
- 27. Chardonnay, Planeta, 2009** **£34.50**
Sicily, Italy. Citrus fruit flavours complemented by chestnut and honey notes with a spicy complexity.

Elegant & Refined

- 17. Costadune Grillo Chardonnay, Mandrarossa, 2011** **Bottle £14.50**
Sicily, Italy. Delicate perfume of tropical fruits and floral notes. Harmonious, fresh and round palate with a long finish of mineral notes.
- 25. Macon Solutre Domaine Pascal & Mireille Renaud 2010 ~ France** **£28.00**
Burgundy, France Dry, buttery flavours, classic white Burgundy
- 13. Chablis Domaine de la Tour 2008** **£33.00**
Burgundy, France Rich, ripe citrus flavours ~ delicious

Red Wine

Medium Bodied & Fruity

- 1. La Lande Pays d'Herault, 2011** **Bottle £14.50**
Languedoc Roussillon, France. A nose of plum jam and raisins. Light and moreish on the palate with excellent balance and ripe, soft tannins. (14%abv)
- 31. Wildflower, J. Lohr, 2011** **£22.50**
California, United States of America. Bright aromas of boysenberry, cherry, raspberry and banana. The fruit complexion on the palate is equally bright, dominated by boysenberry and raspberry.
- 32. Barbera Amonte, Volpi, 2011** **£15.75**
Piemonte, Italy. Deliciously fruity with notes of blueberries, cherries and raspberries. Robust with a persistent finish.

Rich & Full Bodied

- 29. Hugo Casanova Antano Carmenere 2010** **Bottle £20.00**
Maule Valley, Chile. Delicious, rich, dark fruit with a minty finish
- 37. Malbec, Sol, Bodegas Santa Ana, 2011** **£15.95**
Mendoza, Argentina. Medium bodied and dry with soft, ripe blackcurrant flavours and balancing structure, finishing rounded and juicy.
- 38. Douro Red, Quinta do Crasto, 2010** **£21.00**
Douro, Portugal. Rich and spicy with ripe tannins and a long, smooth, velvety finish.
- 40. Basket Pressed Cabernets, Skilloalee, 2007** **£27.50**
South Australia. Full and soft with sweet, leafy fruit flavours, rich vanillin oak and firm, drying tannins on a lingering finish.
- 41. Chianti Classico Dentro, Cecchi, 2010** **£22.50**
Tuscany, Italy. Full and rich, characterised by hints of violets balanced with great structure allied to fine fruit.

Elegant & Refined

- 34. Côtes du Rhône, Domaine de la Mirandole, 2010** **Bottle £18.50**
Rhone, France. Perfumed, fruity nose of violet and raspberry. The palate is balanced by juicy damson and raspberry fruit, smooth tannins and a spicy finish.
- 20. Carlos Serres Rioja Crianza 2008 ~ Spain** **£25.00**
Elegant fruit with a lovely oak finish
- 26. Mud House Pinot Noir 2009** **£28.00**
Central Otago, New Zealand. Superb, elegant wine with ripe cherry flavours and a silky mouth feel
- 36. Stickleback Red, Heartland, 2009** **£18.95**
South Australia. A beautifully fragrant wine with black fruit characters of cherry, sweet plums and blackcurrant. Cabernet/Shiraz blend

Rosé Wine

- 10. Camel Valley Rose 2010** **Bottle £25.95**
Cornwall, England. Easy drinking with juicy summer fruit flavours.
- 11. Pinot Grigio Blush IGT Veneto, Il Sospiro, 2011** **£17.50**
Veneto, Italy. An aromatic nose of freshly crushed cranberries and mineral elements. The palate is light, dry and crisp, with a delicious balance between zingy citrus and fruity red berry flavours.
- 12. Xanadu Exmoor Drive Rose, 2010** **£17.50**
Margaret River, Australia. A vibrant and fruity rose with fantastic red berry aromas.
- 21. Rose d'Anjou La Jaglerie 2010 ~ France** **£20.00**
Medium dry, light and fruity

Dessert Wine

- 42. Botrytised Viognier, Trinity Hill, 2010 (37.5cl)** **125ml Bottle £9.00 £25.50**
Hawkes Bay, New Zealand. Aromas reminiscent of honey and crystallized apricots. The botrytis has a big effect, with floral hints and jasmine. It is very luscious and concentrated, with strong flavours of dried fruits, especially apricots.
- 43. Liqueur Muscat, Skilloalee, NV (75cl)** **£8.50 £45.00**
South Australia. This shows nutty, raisin and apricot flavours, and is full and sweet enough to match well with the sweetest desserts (even chocolate!).
- 44. Cabernet Franc Icewine, Peller, 2010 (37.5cl)** **£17.95 £53.00**
Ontario, Canada. A rich mouth-feel with wonderful fruit flavours of red berries and rhubarb. Red currants, spice and pomegranate on a long lingering finish.
- 45. Late Harvest Sauvignon Blanc, Concha Y Toro 2008 (37.5cl)** **£6.50 £17.95**
Maule Valley, Chile. Light and aromatic with lovely acidity. Delicious floral, honey flavours.
