8	Mas des Bressades 2011 Costières de Nîmes, Languedoc Roussillon, France This captivating blend of local grape varieties offers aromas of ripe fruit and summer flowers, satisfying weight on the mid-palate, then a crisp mineral finish.	£24.95
9	Macon-Villages, "Medaille d'Or", Duboeuf 2010 Duboeuf, Burgundy, France A cracking Mâcon from a great vintage, this wine combines crisp apple and citrus fruit with a subtle mealy, savoury note. Excellent concentration and balance mark the quality on the palate.	£26.00
10	Gewurztraminer Côte de Rouffach 2011 Rene Mure, France Controlled yet expressive, this wine offers the characteristic exotic aromas of Gewurztraminer – rose petals, lychee and gingerbread – in an elegant, medium-bodied style. This is a Gewurz made for food!	£29.50
11	Sancerre Le Mont, Foucher Lebrun 2011 Foucher Lebrun, Loire, France Crisp, flavoursome Sancerre which offers floral and boxwood aromas. The palate shows juicy citrus fruit alongside the trademark elegance and minerality.	£32.50
12	Pouilly-Fuissé Clos Reyssié 2010 Georges Duboeuf, Burgundy, France This wine is vibrant and generous with apple and melon fruit, a creamy mid-palate texture, and a poised, mineral finish.	£38.95
13	Chablis 1er Cru Vau Ligneau 2010 Domaine Hamelin, Burgundy, France Delicate, expressive nose with green apple, citrus and lily aromas. Round yet elegant on the palate, with classic minerality and a dry finish.	£39.50

19	Chinon Bon Breton, Foucher Lebrun 2011 Loire, France A pure Cabernet Franc in all its glory: redcurrant fruit and herbal notes, light to medium-bodied, with a refreshing, lip-smacking finish.				£22.50
20	Gran Hacienda Reserva Carmenère 2010 Santa Rita, Rapel Valley, Chile On the palate, this wine has a well-rounded texture and a lingering persistence. 24	Promesa Rioja Crianza 2009 Familia Martinez Bujanda, Spain A classic style of Rioja, with strawberry, blackberry and rhubarb fruit flavours taking on a vanilla and cocoa smoothness during twelve months in oak barrels.	£25.50
25	Malbec Finca Perdriel 2009 Argentina A ripe, succulent wine offering aromas of violets, spice and tobacco. A round, mouthfilling palate, flavours of berry fruit and a persistent finish.	£26.00
26	Château Haut Monplaisir Tradition 2009 Cahors, South west, France Deep plum and berry aromas, with some leafy brightness, and a rich, appetising palate that blends fruit with mineral and tobacco notes.	£27.00

28	Founders Block Shiraz, Katnook Estate 2009 Katnook Estate, South Australia, Australia An aromatic Shiraz bursting with dark cherry and red berry fruit. The palate is ripe and generous, with subtle vanilla and spice notes from the oak.	£29.95
29	Rasteau Côtes-du-Rhône Villages 2009 “ 90 Points Wine Spectator “ Domaine de Beurenard, Rhone Valley, France Red fruits, spice and earthy notes on the nose lead onto a soft, full-bodied palate with notes of stone fruits, cherry, black fruits, spices and pear.	£35.50
30	Château Lalande de Gravet 2008 Saint Emilion Grand Cru, Bordeaux, France This wine delights with flavors of dried berry, cocoa and plum. A soft, supple blend of Merlot, Cabernet Franc and Cabernet Sauvignon.	£44.00
31	Châteauneuf-du-Pape Haute Pierre 2010 Delas Freres, Rhone Valley, France Cherry, raspberry and baked plum mingle with fresh pepper and the herbs of the garrigue. Deft despite its weight, the palate finishes dry and refreshing.	£49.95
