Lessons

You must be at least 17 years of age. If you are registered disabled you must be 16 years old and in receipt of Mobility Allowance. You must hold a current full or provisional licence; if you have a photo card you have to have the counterpart. If you do not have a current full or provisional license you can obtain one from www.dvla.gov.uk or by completing the D1 form from your local post office. You must be able to read a car number plate from 20.5 metres (67 feet – about 5 car lengths); if you need glasses or contact lenses to read the number plate that is fine but you must wear them at all times when driving. Comfortable clothes and sensible footwear are required (Sorry no working cover-alls, no work boots or stiletto heels).

Theory Test

There are companies that will charge you extra for doing your theory test as well as an intensive course. This may not be suitable for you because you may only get 20 hours driving and if lucky 9 hours theory. Preparation for your theory test is part of the intensive course I offer. The books you need are the DSA *Driving Essential Skills* as well as the *Highway Code* and a PC DVD-Rom called *The Complete Learner Driver Kit* by Focus.

Manual Intensive Courses

The type of intensive course will depend on your experience as a driver. If a total beginner, try our Introductory Lesson (2 hours during which you will learn the controls of the car as well as drive the vehicle). This assessment is needed to identify the length of intensive course required, i.e. 3-day, 5-day, 8-day, 10-day. The number of hours per day you will need depends on the number of lessons required to reach above test standard. A total beginner would probably require a number of lessons as a guideline; this would be double their age. But the more hours you put in the greater chance of you passing first time. Intensive courses are normally four hours or six hours per day, for instance split into sessions of two hours with a half hour break in between. Each intensive course will be tailored to the individual's needs. You should only book a driving test with the agreement of the instructor, to avoid clashing with other pupils' tests. Towards the end of your intensive course, if you have completed the theory test, consult your instructor. Remember you must have passed the theory test before booking a practical driving test and can, if you wish, take the intensive driving course before the theory test and then book the practical test.

I can also put you in touch with a company that can fast track a test for you if you need it urgently or a test is too far ahead. Below are the details of each course available depending on which one of them you require.

Beginner course 45 hours

Beginner course is aimed at students with no previous experience. Students might have never driven before and will need to be taught all their driving skills. Course is an 45 Hours spread over 10 or 14 days, but can be taken over a longer period of time(4 - 6 hrs/day. Includes 1 x 15min break & 30min Lunch) on a one 2 one instructor to student. With the practical driving test arranged as the final 3 hours of the course. Please note test fees are not included in the course fees 45 hours 1:1 course

Students course 40 hours

Students are close to the start of their driving career. They may have already started learning and have around 5 hours practice with a driving instructor or family member driving in a car park practicing steering, clutch control when moving away, braking and stopping. Some gear changing may also have been tried on a road with little traffic. Course is an 40 Hours spread over 10 or 14 days, but can be taken over a longer period of time (4 - 6 hrs/day. Includes 1 x 15min break & 30min Lunch) on a one 2 one instructor to student. With the practical driving test arranged as the final 3 hours of the course. Please note test fees may not included in the course fees 40 hour 1:1 course

Novice student 35 hours

Novice student would have around 5-10 hours of previous tuition with a driving instructor. Novice student will be practising car control, clutch steering, and moving off and stopping smoothly on hills, angle starts, the MSM routine would be known and used. Practice on entering and exiting junctions roundabouts with light traffic. Novice course is of a 35 hour spread over 8 or 10 days, but can be taken over a longer period of time (4 - 6 hrs/day. Includes 1 x 15min break & 30min Lunch) on a one 2 one instructor to student. With the practical driving test arranged as the final 3 hours of the course. Please note test fees may not included in the course fees.

Novice 35 hour 1:1 course

Intermediate course 30 hours

Intermediate course student will have around 10-15 hours of tuition with a driving instructor. Intermediate students will now have fair to good car control being able to move off at junctions with confidence. Roundabouts are now becoming easier, and driving would be in light and starting with medium traffic. The driving test manoeuvers would have been started and being practiced. Students should now have an understanding of most traffic signs and road markings and be able to identify them. Intermediate courses are 30 hour spread over 8 or 10 days, but can be taken over a longer period of time (4 - 6 hrs/day. Includes 1 x 15min break & 30min Lunch) on a one 2 one instructor to student. With the practical driving test arranged as the final 3 hours of the course. Please note test fees may not included in the course fees.

Intermediate 30 hr 1:1 course

Experienced course 25 hours

Experienced course will suit students with around 20 hours previous driving tuition with a driving instructor. Experienced students will by now have driven in medium traffic and some driving in traffic situations that need good decisions. Students will have good car control manoeuvres have been practiced a few times and are becoming easier. Traffic lights road marking and signs would have been practiced and a fair understanding of their usage and how they work would be known.Experienced course is a 25 hour 5 day course but can be taken over a longer period of

time(4 -5 hrs/day. Includes 1 x 15min break & 30min Lunch) on a one 2 one instructor to student. With the practical driving test arranged as the final 3 hours of the course. Please note test fees may not included in the course fees. Experienced 25 hr 1:1 course

Advanced students 20 hours

Advanced students will have had previous tuition with a driving instructor of about 25 hours. Advanced courses will suit those students who have good car control and have been happy driving in medium traffic.Manoeuvres would have been practised to a fair standard. Traffic signs, lights and road markings will be understood on what they mean to the driver. Forward planning on who has priority with independent decision making improving. Advanced student course is a 5 day 20 hour duration course,but can be taken over a longer period of time(4 hrs/day. Includes break 30min Lunch) on a one 2 one instructor to student. With the practical driving test arranged as the final 3 hours of the course. Please note test fees may not included in the course fees. Advanced 20 hr 1:1 course

Failed Test 10 hours

The DSA practical driving test for some can be daunting. For those who have failed their driving test there is the failed driving test candidate course. The failed driving test candidate would have taken a previous driving test within the last 2 months. The Tests

The Theory Test

The theory test must be taken and passed before you can book a Practical Driving Test. It is a multiple choice computer based test. You will be given 50 questions of which you must answer 43 correctly to pass.

The Hazard Perception Test

This is a series of video clips showing various driving situations, you are required to recognize and react to hazards as they develop. There are 14 clips with 15 hazards i.e. one clip has 2 hazards. There are a number of good training aids available in the form of DVD or CD.

The Practical Driving Test

The Driving Test will begin with an eyesight check and then vehicle safety questions('show me, tell me'). After this you will begin your Drive which will include one Manoeuvre and Independent driving You will pass your Driving Test if you can show the examiner the following skills:

drive safely,complete the set exercises,know the Highway Code and can demonstrate this through your driving

You can make up to 15 driving faults and still pass the driving test. However, if you commit one serious or dangerous fault you will fail the driving test.

The Practical Driving Test Day

This is a standard three hour booking, depending where the test centre is located, including a pre-test lesson.A Two weeks notice is required for a test. We reserve the right to refuse use of the car for a test where the instructor does not consider the candidate has reached a sufficiently high standard.
