- 11 ***Sancerre 'Chavignol' 2009*** £33.00
Domaine Serge Laporte, Loire Valley, France
Zesty, fresh and full of gooseberry tinged fruit. From one of the most highly regarded estates in Sancerre.
- 12 ***Chablis, Domaine Bois d'Yver 2009*** £33.00
Chablis, Burgundy, France
Crisp freshness, steely fruit and a generous weight. A true classic.

- 13 ***Riesling, Dr. L 2009*** £26.00
Dr loosen, Mosel-Saar- Ruwer, Germany
Stunning medium dry with ripe, tangy, grapey fruit and good length.
- 14 ***A20 Albarino 2008*** £29.00
Rias Baixas, Spain
Straw coloured with greenish reflections and special intensity on the nose.
- 15 ***Neudorf, Sauvignon Blanc 2008*** £26.00
Nelson, New Zealand
Herbaceous and grassy with a rich tropical colour. Firm and well defined

Richer More Complex Wines

- 16 ***Brown Brothers 'Banksdale' Chardonnay 2006*** £26.00
Milawa, Victoria, Australia
This elegant Chardonnay displays fresh lifted stone fruit aromas – nectarine, peach and fig. Subtle oak sits quietly in the background. Hand crafted by one of Australia's finest wine estates.
- 17 ***Viognier, Domaine St. Hilaire 2009*** £25.00
Montagnac, Languedoc, France
Peach scented Viognier is perfectly pitched here. Skilful winemaking keeps the peach notes true right through the lovely long cool finish.
- 18 ***Tocai Friulano, Bianco Di Custoza 2008*** £33.00
Veneto, Italy
Rich, full bodied with flavours of honeydew melon and other tropical fruits. Five grape varieties, Tocai Friulano, Garganega, Riesling Italico, Chardonnay and Trebbiano Toscano go into the making of this wine.

Fruit Driven Reds

- 31 ***Sangiovese, Brown Brothers 2004*** £34.00
Victoria, Australia
Has a bright cherry colour with medium intensity. Cherry aromas follow through onto the palate with fine tannins and balanced acidity. Another delight from the varietal experts; Brown Brothers, bringing us the grape that is responsibly for Chianti.
- 32 ***Chianti Classico, Villa Cafaggio 2007*** £30.00
Tuscany, Italy
Fine Chianti from an estate with a rising reputation. The wine shows ripe aromas, even a hint of roses. Dark colour, good structure and length. Beneath, there is the promise of more to come.

Big Bold Reds

- 33 ***Châteauneuf Du Pape, Domaine de la Roquette, 2005/06*** £46.00
Southern Rhône, France
Wonderfully ripened; rounded with a gentle blueberry fruitiness, voluptuously textured and very rich with a domination of blackberry fruit.
- 34 ***Cotes du Rhône, 'Visan' 2007/09 Domaine Roche Audran, [Grenache/Syrah/Mourvedre]*** £28.00
Southern Rhône, France
Soft and succulent and intensely fruity. Packed with juicy red berry fruit and fresh black pepper. Undertones of garrigue spices. Great with beef, game and casseroles.
- 35 ***Pinotage, Horse Mountain 2010*** £31.00
Paarl, South Africa
Bright deep, ruby colour with spicy bouquet and flavours. Combines power with elegance, firm fruit in perfect balance with acid and rounded tannins. Great with lamb and game.
- 36 ***Garnacha (Grenache) Evohe 2008, Bodegas Leceranas*** £26.00
Zaragoza, Spain
This open, appealing wine has substantial black summer fruit flavours with ripe, smooth tannins and a subtle yet, sustained finish on the palate. Made from 30 year old vines, this is Garnacha at it's best.
- 37 ***Graham Beck Merlot Coastal 2006*** £25.00
Robertson, South Africa
Fresh red berries, violets and fruit cake spiciness on the nose. Elegant ripe tannins on the finish provide a fantastic backdrop

Beaujolais, France
A classic Fleurie with excellent silky fruit, penetrating concentration and tell tale iris and chocolate nose. | £19.00 |

Victoria, Australia

This wine is an attractive pale straw colour with green hues. Aromas of grapes, musk and a little spice with a creamy mouth feel and clean finish.

D2 ***Elysium Black Muscat, 2009 37.5cl ~ 125ml £7.50*** 1/2 btl £19.00

Quady, California

A rose perfumed wine of a magenta colour. Elysium, which is Greek for heaven, drinking that it feels as if you have fallen into a rose garden and transported to heaven

D3 ***Riesling, Noble Late Harvest, 2009 50cl ~ 125ml £8.00*** 1/2 btl £25.00

Paul Cluver, Grabouw, Elgin, South Africa

A beautiful dessert wine, it is lusciously honeyed and fabulously exotic.

D3 ***Côteaux De Layon, 'Rive Gauche', 2005*** £29.00

This wine has typical rich honeyed fruit sweetness, married to fresh acidity, a textbook sweet Loire Chenin Blanc.
