 A well-balanced fine dry white wine that is full and round on the palate, with a fruity and flinty bouquet. The epitome of fine Pouilly Fume showing typical blackcurrant and mineral characters.

 Deep golden colour, rich with a pronounced mineral flavour.

 A classic bouquet, fresh with mineral and floral notes. The wine has great finesse and a lingering finish.

 Classic steely Chablis with depth and power through to a long finish sustained by tingly acidity.

 The wine shows lovely buttery integration of fruit with oak and great consistency on the palate through to a wonderfully long and lingering finish.

Germany

Riesling 100%
 Bright straw colour, a delicate nose with hints of spice and pineapple. The palate is packed with tropical fruits. Lovely intensely and rapier-like acidity on the finish. Rich but dry.

Riesling 100%
 A juicy Riesling with tangy acidity and delicate fragrances of white peaches, ripe red apples and white flowers.

Pinot Gris 100%
 Bright stone fruit and juicy pear aromas herald a vibrantly fruity off-dry palate, layered over a rich and supple mouth feel. A firm backbone of acid leads into very long, fruity finish.

Sauvignon Blanc 100%
Full and rich with firm, well-balanced acidity, this wine has powerful passion fruit, blackcurrant and grapefruit. A mineral component adds complexity and depth to a long lingering finish.

South Africa

Chardonnay 100%
A tight mineral wine with classic Hamilton Russell Vineyards length and its complexity. A prominent core of intense pear fruit aromas and flavours is brought beautifully into focus by a tight of natural acidity and a dry minerality. An elegant, yet textured and intense wine with a strong personality of both place and vintage.

Greece

Assyrtiko 100%
Toasty, Smokey and funky on the nose with mineral dusting and brooding intensity. The palate is salty dry with laser-beam precision and a very funky wild ferment layering of complexity with oak wreathed into the mix with sensitivity. The finish is dry, with lasting salty and tangy flavours. Unique and outstanding wine.

Chile

Sauvignon Blanc 100%
Light and delicate in colour, with delicious aromas of melon, apple and grapefruit. Charismatic palate, with passion fruit and mineral characteristics. Perfectly fresh and fruity.
- 34 Riesling Reserva, Carmen - 2009 £22.00
Riesling 100%
Crisp elegant Riesling showing soft citrus characters and a refreshing finish.

Australia

Semillon 65%, Chardonnay 35%
A delicate blend of herbaceous Semillon and exotic tropical Chardonnay fruit characters with subtle oak complexity balanced by a crisp, fresh finish.

Chardonnay 85%, Semillon 15%

- 36 Pinot Gris Rose, Saint Clair - 2011 £24.00
Pinot Gris 85%, Pinot Noir 15%
A fresh and appealing wine with flavours of cherry and redcurrant, underlying strawberries and cream tones. Fresh acidity is balanced by a round yet elegant palate that leads to a lingering finish.

France

- 37 Rose d'Ajou, Domain Des Cedres – 2010 £17.00
Grolleau 90%, Cabernet Franc 10%
Coral pink in colour, this is a fruity wine with hints of black pepper and a balanced sweetness.
- 38 Cotes de Provence Rose, Chateau de l'Aumerade - 2010 £26.00
Cinsault 50%, Grenache 40%, Syrah 10%
Lovely pale pink in colour. The fresh nose is composed of citrus aromas such as orange and grapefruit complemented by a full, spicy and fleshy palate with refreshing acidity.

A smooth, medium-bodied wine with good concentration of cherry fruit, very drinkable in style.
- 40 Indio' Montepulciano d'Abruzzo, Cantina Bove - 2007 £30.00
Montepulciano 90%, Cabernet Sauvignon 10%
Full bodied, smooth and elegant with notes of spice, vanilla, wild berries and prunes on the nose.
- 41 Chianti Classico San Jacopo, Castello Vicchiomaggio - 2010 £33.00
Sangiovese 90%, Canaiolo 5%, Colorino 5%
Ripe and fruity wine with black cherry flavours and a soft touch of tannins. Full of fruit with a hint of spice.
- 42 Capitel San Rocco Rosso Valpolicella Superior 'Ripasso', Tedeschi - 2009 £35.00
Corvina 30%, Corvinone 30%, Rondinella 30%, Local Varieties 10%
The Valpolicella gains body, colour and strength by being fermented with the Amarone and Recioto pressings. Ample in bouquet, its dry flavor is robust and warm with a bitter background and smooth texture.
- 43 Barolo Cerequio, Michele Chiarlo – 2006 £131.00
Nebbiolo 100%
A single vineyard Barolo located on the most prestigious hillside between the villages of La Morra and Barolo. A rich and aristocratic wine which is full and savory with a lingering aftertaste. Very fine.
- 44 Amarone, Roccolo Grassi – 2007 £151.00
Corvina 60%, Rondinella 20%, Corvinone 15%, Croatina 5%
A beautifully balanced wine of great structure which is complex but at the same time soft and velvety. Cherries, prunes, spice and tobacco on the nose. An Amarone of great character.
- 45 Luce, Luce Della Vite – 2008 £176.00
Sangiovese 100%
A deep, almost opaque, ruby red greets the eye. On the nose are clean-edged notes of dark fruit, such as wild blackberry and black cherry. Supple tannins and a supporting vibrant acidity contribute significantly to the wine's overall impressive balance and harmony, perfectly completed by a lengthy, long-lingering finish subtly edged with ripe fruit.
- 46 FSM Merlot, Castello Vicchiomaggio – 2006 £251.00
Merlot 100%
Made in limited quantities only, this rich and concentrated wine impressively combines firmness with roundness. Notes of rich coffee and fruitcake complement the elegant, fine tannins through to a rich and long finish.

Mourvèdre 20%, Syrah 80%
Spicy berried fruit with typical warm and savoury flavours. Fruity, soft, easy drinking in style.

Gamay 100%
Intense ruby red with a nose of strawberries and morello cherries. Well-structured, balanced and full of fresh fruits.

Merlot 70%, Cabernet Franc 30%
The style is rounded with a hint of jamminess and with full, but soft tannins.
- 49 St. Estephe, Chateau Beau Site – 2006 £49.00
Cabernet Sauvignon 60%, Merlot 30%, Cabernet Franc 7%, Petit Verdot 3%
The majority of Cabernet Sauvignon in the blend yields a wine with ripe blackcurrant fruit, balanced oak and good structure. A supple style for St. Estèphe showing great freshness of flavour.
- 50 Gigondas Les Souteyrades, Domaine St Damien – 2009 £56.00
Grenache 80%, Mourvedre 20%
Exotic and alluring with incense and warm fig cake aromas that then meld into warm bittersweet chocolate, blackberry confiture, and dark coffee aromas. Fine-grained and long on the finish.
- 51 Aloxe Corton, Domaine Nicolas Rossignol – 2009 £60.00
Pinot Noir 100%
Lovely fruit purity and structure with rich, spicy and animal notes and firm but fine tannins.
- 52 Reserve de Leoville Barton, Chateau Loeville Barton – 2007 £67.00
Cabernet Sauvignon 72%, Merlot 20%, Cabernet Franc 8%
Smooth with coffee and cedar notes – a classically styled Bordeaux from this esteemed estate in St Julien

- 53 Pommard 'Les Vignots', Domaine Rene Monnier – 2009 £71.00
Pinot Noir 100%
 A dense Pinot Noir style with nose of violets, pepper and cassia; well-structured with firm tannins.
- 54 Morey St Denis 1er Cru Clos des Oemes, Remoissenet Pere Et Flis – 2000 £83.00
Pinot Noir 100%
 A lot of red fruits with gamey aromas
- 55 Chateauneuf du Pape Alexis Establet, Domaine du Grand Tinel – 2006 £89.00
Black Grenache 90%, Others 10%
 Sweet morello cherries and red berry fruit with good weight and complemented by a spicy, vanillin oak, very smooth and fine.
- 56 5eme Cru Classe Pauillac, Chateau Batailley – 2006 £100.00
Cabernet Sauvignon 70%, Merlot 25%, Cabernet Franc 3%, Petit Verdot 2%
 A rich, cedar nose is followed by a palate of characteristic weight and dense, textured red and black fruit, creamy oak and a very long finish.
- 57 Grands Echezeaux Grand Cru, Remoissenet Pere Et Flis – 2001 £196.00
Pinot Noir 100%
 Very fine pinot nose, some spice on the palate with a complex silky texture, very concentrated and long with a consistent and lovely balanced finish.

Merlot 100%
 Rich and complex flavour with a very long and attractive aftertaste due to its round and full ripe tannins.
- 59 Pinot Noir, Rockburn – 2009 £51.00
Pinot Noir 100%
 Deeply fruited with delicate floral tones enhanced by nuances of liquorice root, and supple, silky tannins leading into a long spicy finish. As always this wine shows classic Rockburn elegance, integrity and balance.

Pinot Noir 100%
 Finely oaked, with aromas and flavours of raspberry, cherry, and plum, with hints of game, develop to a deeper more complex, earthy, mushroom character with bottle age. The Pinot flavoured ripe sweetness is held together by fair tannins and perfect balance.

Malbec 100%
 Concentrated aromas of red fruit, spices and toasted notes from the oak. Rich and complex flavour with a very long and attractive aftertaste due to its round and full ripe tannins.

Malbec 100%
 Deep red colour with a purple hue, bouquet of lavender and strawberries. Lush redcurrant, plum and morello cherry flavours on the palate with hints of chocolate and pepper. Well rounded, soft tannins with a lingering finish.
