Ballet Attire for Pre-professional Ballet Division: In keeping with the classical ballet tradition and to achieve a uniformity of appearance within class levels, LDT requires students to comply with the following Dress Code.

- 1) Any style solid black leotard or the Ballet Recital Blue/Purple Leotard with attached skirt, no unattached skirts for Ballet Levels 1-4, Level 5-7 skirts during pre-pointe/pointe class only
- 2) Pink canvas or leather ballet slippers with drawstring bows tucked in, pointe shoes, where applicable which must be properly fitted by Boulder Body Wear 3) Hair must be in a secure bun, away from the neck and face (patron's accounts
- will be charged for a \$10 bun kit if a student comes to class without a bun) 4) Full Footed Tights: Levels 1-4: Ballet Pink, Bloch Endura Adaptatoe con-
- vertible tights with seams

Tap/Jazz: Tap is a dance in which rhythm is sounded out by the clicking taps on the heels and toes of a dancer's shoes. Jazz is any of various dances characterized by the use of improvisation and influenced by rhythms and techniques of jazz music

This prevents damage to LDT's studio flooring from glass, rocks, pebbles, or disease.) Hair must be pulled back from face and neck (No skirts, no shorts, no half shirts, no jazz shoes, and no jazz sneakers will be accepted)

Modern: This free flowing movement utilizes weight shifts and proper alignment while promoting breath during movement.

- 3) No shoes or socks
- 4) Hair pulled back from face and neck
- 5) Loose or tight fitting capris or pants
