**Villa dei Fiori, Montepulciano d’Abruzzo - Abruzzo, Italy** £25.00  
Ripe, rounded, slightly rustic Italian with spicy black olives and cherry.

**Wandering Bear, Merlot - California, USA** £22.10  
This wine is sumptuous, lush and full of plum, cherry and vanilla.

**Loredona, Monterey County, Pinot Noir - California, USA** £36.70  
Delectable flavours of strawberry and rhubarb with notes of vanilla evolve on the palate culminating in a long finish.

**“Les Sablons” Côtes du Ventoux, Terra Ventoux - Rhône, France** £26.70  
Christmassy sweet spices and baked fruits with ripe tannins and a long finish.

## Medium Bodied Rounded Reds

**Chilcas, Carmenere Seleccionados - Central Valley, Chile** £22.10  
Attractive nose reveals fruit aromas such as strawberry, raspberry and black plum.

**Château Vieux Labarthe, St-Émilion - Bordeaux, France** £33.30  
Ripe blackberry, damson and black cherry fruit with sweet, juicy tannins.

**Riva Leone, Barbera - Piemonte, Italy** £22.90  
Dark berry fruits with a core of fine tannins and the typical Barbera acidity.

**Solarena Barrel Aged Tempranillo - Carinena, Spain** £25.80  
Enticing bramble fruit gives way to rounded, velvety, vanilla flavours.

**St Hallett, Shiraz / Grenache - Barossa Valley, Australia** £30.80  
New World vibrant array of red berry fruits and spice.

**La Serre, Cabernet Sauvignon - VdP d’Oc, France** £20.80  
Rich nose of red fruits with spicy notes and soft tannins.

**Stone Barn, Cabernet Sauvignon - California, USA** £28.30  
Flavours of black cherry and plum lead into a smooth finish.

Masses of blackberry, plum and damson fruit alongside hints of cinnamon and vanilla.

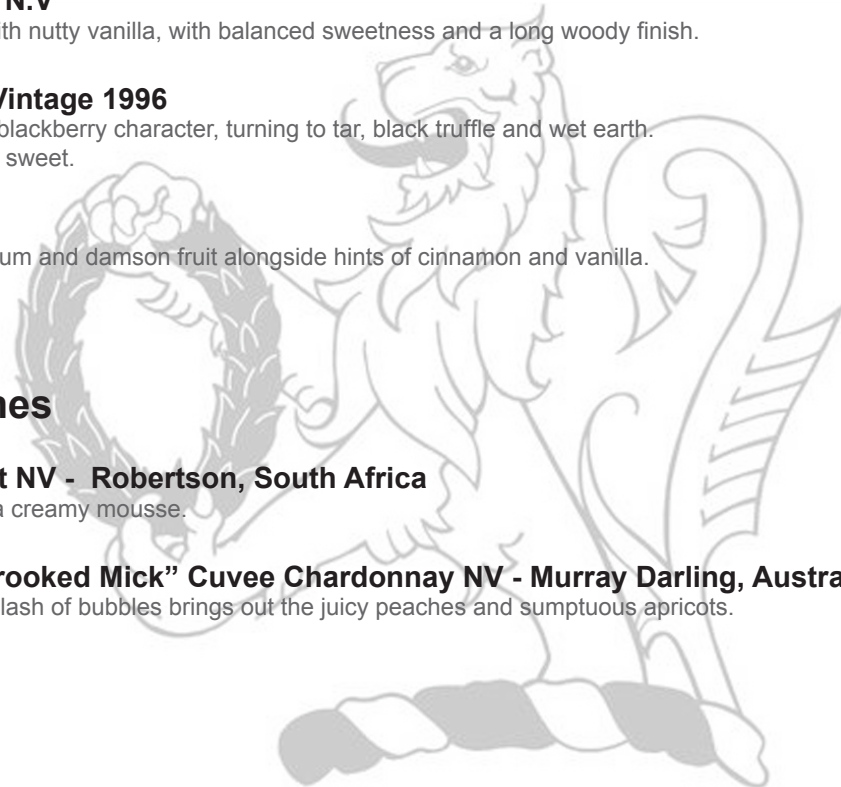
