EDUCATIONAL PROGRAMS

Star Party! Seven Ponds Astronomy Club is visiting us for a night of star-studded fun! We will start with a campfire, hayride, and s'mores followed by an astronomy presentation and star-gazing using our telescope. \$5/participant, all ages welcome. 8-10pm, May 17th

EQUESTRIAN PROGRAMS

Public Riding: we offer various options for public riding, from our 202 acres of trails to our 60x120 foot indoor riding arena.

- \$10 per person per visit
- \$18 (30 min.)-\$30 (1 hr.) per person using our horses (group rates available)
- \$30 monthly riding with your horse

Private Lessons: 8 years old and up. \$95 for four 1-hour private sessions.
