



The Fowler Center for Outdoor Learning Group Events Pricing Information

Day Groups

Day Groups choose from the package options below and may customize these options with additional activities or our Specialty activities. We require a 10 person minimum charge for all groups. We do not charge chaperones or staff who attend with day groups. School groups and groups with special needs receive a 10% discount from the total cost. Each activity period can accommodate up to 16 participants. For larger groups, we will split into smaller groups and rotate through chosen activities.

3 hour visit: includes Recreation activities, transition time, and orientation to camp

Option A: 2 Recreation activities **\$8 per participant**

Option B: 3 Recreation activities **\$12 per participant**

6 hour visit: includes 4 Recreation activities, transition time, and orientation to camp

Facility Rental

We require a 3 hour minimum rental period. Activities or meals may be added to facility rentals, but for both, please refer to our Overnight Groups pricing. For overnight rentals, there is a 6 person minimum charge.

Main Cabins (sleeps 20, 4 available) **\$11 per hour** (Overnight **\$27/person/night**)

Ranch Cabins (sleeps 10, 2 available) **\$6 per hour** (Overnight **\$27/person/night**)

Activity Building (120 people capacity) **\$27 per hour**

Equestrian Center (arena & observation room) **\$24 per hour**

Observation Room only **\$10 per hour**

Outdoor Structures:

Pavilion (includes small grill) **\$8 per hour**

Chapel (no rain cover) **\$4 per hour**

Waterfront Gazebo **\$5 per hour**

Overnight Groups

Guests who stay overnight at The Fowler Center receive room and board, Recreation programming, and meals for the cost of their visit. One night's stay includes 3 meals, 1 Evening Program, and 2 Recreation activities. Check-in time is 4pm on the day of arrival, and Check-out time is 2pm the day of departure. School groups and groups with disabilities receive a 10% discount from the total cost.

Primitive Camping at the Outpost:

Groups can choose to stay at The Outpost, which includes use of up to 3 platform tents, a water pump, pavilion, fire pit, and port-a-johns. Groups can also bring their own tents and camp out at TFC. Outside of the summer season, port-a-johns are not available; groups may rent a nearby building for bathroom facilities. **\$15/person/night**

Specialty Activities: *Owing to the need for specially trained staff, there is an additional fee determined by group size and length of time needed for participation. Pricing is per person for each individual activity. Pick 3 activities and receive a discount off the total cost.
