White Wine

1. La Fete Blanc, Vin de Pays d'Oc, France
With aromas of peach, grapefruit and a hint of peony this wine is wonderfully light and fresh.

2. Ca di Ponti, Sicily
Superb, complex dry white wine from the native Sicilian Catarratto grape. Cold fermented to produce a full and fresh white.

3. Chenin Blanc, South Africa
Crisp appley fruit, on the nose leads on to a fuller off dry palate balanced off with with a persistence finish and a clean acidity.

4. Pinot Grigio Malandrino, Veneto, Italy
Made using 100% Pinot Grigio this wine displays notes of citrus fruits, with a hint of floral aromas.

5. Fernlands Sauvignon Blanc, Marlborough, New Zealand
This vibrant yet perfectly balanced wine boasts a citrus-led palate and a long-lasting and refreshing finish, encapsulating the essence of what Marlborough does best.

6. Gavi La Lancellotta, Italy
La Lancellotta is a great expression of Gavi. A light wine, with steely minerality, apple, peach and apricot flavours and refreshing grapefruit and lime character.

7. Sancerre Roger Neveu, Loire Valley, France
Aromas of ripe rhubarb and gooseberry leap from the pale lemon coloured glass, along with hints of lime, chalk and flint. Mineral texture, high acidity, vibrant green fruits and a long, lingering finish.

8. Chablis, Jean Bourguignon, Burgundy, France
Lively and fresh with clean citrus aromas. Crisp, fruity and steely dry on the palate. The finish is long and lean.

9. Pouilly-Fumé Les Griottes, Loire Valley, France
Rich and smoky on the nose, with subtle limes, white florals and honeysuckle atop a palate of fresh, clean and vibrant acidity, citrus fruit flint, minerality and green peppers. A long and layered finish.

10. Chablis 1er Cru "Vaillon", Vocoiret. Burgundy, France
Aromas of lime, slate, chalk and fresh citrus fruits leap out of the glass atop a concentrated, citrus and pineapple fruit on the palate. Layers of mineral and citrus on the finish with racy acidity.

11. Pouilly Fuissé Terroir de Fuissé, Sélection Christophe Cordier, Burgundy, France
The richness and power in this wine are balanced by tropical pineapple flavours and crisp citrus acidity. A toasty, mineral complexity provide a structured backbone.

12. Chassagne Montrachet, Burgundy
Hand crafted from a 12 hectare estate. Intense structure and profound flavours.

Red Wine

1. La Fête Rouge, Vin de Pays de L'Herault, France
Ruby red colour with a nose of blackberry, redcurrant and a hint of spice. A well balanced, elegant wine.

2. Ca di Ponti , Sicily
A juicy and approachable wine with ripe black cherry and plum fruit flavours offset by tangy acidity and a hint of smokiness.

3. Grifone Montepulciano d'Abruzzo, Italy
Whilst standards in this region can vary, this is a reliable, medium-bodied wine with lots of red cherry fruit and soft supple tannins.

4. Neblina Merlot, Central Valley, Chile
On the nose rich notes of plums and blackberries are lifted by traces of chocolate and mocha. The palate is silky yet structured, with concentrated berry fruit.

5. Bantry Bay Pinotage, South Africa
An up front wine that is soft and rounded with with ripe berry, currant flavours and notes of bramble fruit on the palate; a smooth mouthfeel and well balanced slightly spicy finish round the wine of beautifully.

6. Errazuriz Pinot Noir, Casablanca Valley, Chile
A wonderful mass of red berry and smoky raspberry fruit aromas. Intense flavours of strawberries, violet hints and a savoury character on the palate, with soft tannins, good acidity, and a fresh length.

7. Otterbrook Mill Shiraz, South Eastern Australia
Complex, elegant and pure. A great example of Australian Shiraz with a lovely, smooth palate showing notes of plum and dark berry fruits, all supported by a touch of toasty oak and a delicate spicy finish.

8. Rioja Torre Aldea, Rioja, Spain
A deep, bright red cherry colour with a persistent aroma of ripe fruit and red berries. Long and lingering with great harmony and a pleasant aftertaste.

9. Vieux Remparts, Lussac St-Emilion, St.Emilion, Bordeaux, France
This is a rich, full bodied wine showing great concentration of flavour. With juicy black fruit on the nose and palate backed up by a smoky sandalwood character.

10. Chianti Classico Sanleonino, Tenimenti Angelini, Tuscany, Italy
This is a very traditional style of Chianti. Full of red cherry flavours and violets, with vibrant acidity, hints of sweet spices and a beautiful long, silky finish.

11. Fleurie Flower Label Duboeuf, Beaujolais, France
Classic Fleurie with fresh cherry fruits and a fragrant, floral perfume. Concentrated fruit and light tannic presence are testament to the cru status of this wine. An attractive wine with a silky texture.

12. Amarone della Valpolicella Classico Cantina di Negrar, Italy
Brooding, deep, intense aromas of Christmas cake, chocolate, cinnamon, sweet fruits and spice. The concentrated palate offers a thick texture and soft velvety tannins, very rich fruit characteristics.

13. Barolo "Galarej" Fontanafredda, Piedmont, Italy
This is a robust, full bodied wine packed with structure and fully capable of standing the test of time. The bouquet is clean and intense, with typical Barolo characteristics of wild roses and tar.

14. Cuvée des Antiques CNDP, Rhone Valley, France
This wine is dark ruby with a complex nose of spices and hints of pear. A smooth and lingering finish.

15. Gevrey Chambertin, Jean Bourguignon, Burgundy, France
This wine has powerful aromas of berry, leather and musk which will develop into liquorice and truffles with age. With fresh acidity and super-fine tannins it is balanced and harmonious on the palate.

Rose

1. Pinot Grigio Rosé Breganze, Veneto, Italy
Fresh fruit, such as apricot and peach on the nose; soft floral flavours on the palate and a refreshing, pleasantly smooth finish. Excellent with appetizers, fish dishes, soups and white meat.

2. White Zinfandel, Rose , California
Bursting with fruit and sunshine like liquid strawberry in a glass the fruit bursts onto the nose and straight on to the palate.

Champagne and Sparkling Wine

1. Langlois Cremant de Loire Brut nv, Loire Valley, France
A light, fresh Cremant, perfect as an aperitif.

2. Extra de Codorniu Rosada N/V, Cava, Spain
Delicate pink in colour with gentle aromas of red fruit and citrus. This wine is subtle and refreshing on the palate with a clean finish, a fabulous but affordable tippie.

3. De Telmont NV, Champagne
One of the few remaining, family owned Champagne houses, De Telmont produces this excellent non-vintage in a medium bodied, soft and fruity, classically yeasty style. Fabulous value.

4. Oeil de Perdrix Rosé, Champagne
Meaning 'eye of the partridge', this pale salmon pink rosé Champagne exhibits enticing complexity. Delicate in style, but with a perfect weight of fruit.

5. Veuve Clicquot NV, Champagne
Veuve Clicquot ages their non-vintage for almost twice the required time, resulting in a superb marriage of freshness and power, with rich fruit and a mouth-filling mousse.

6. Bollinger Special Cuvée NV, Champagne
Bollinger is made from first-run juice only, and the majority of vineyards used have Premier and Grand Cru status, resulting in a full-bodied Champagne of great class. Delightful pale gold in colour, the mousse is light and persistent.

7. Taittinger Vintage, Champagne

Magnificent golden yellow colour with a nose that is at first flinty, and followed by aromas of bread and fresh white fruit. The palate is intense, with plum and greengage fruits leading to a long, creamy finish.

8. Nicolas Feuillatte NV Half, Champagne

A light, fresh and fruity Champagne with fine discreet bubbles and subtle overtones of apples, pears and citrus fruits. Has undergone a total of 4 years' ageing prior to release.
