## Get your tastebuds tingling with some Rothschild opulence...

When you hear the name Rothschild, you might think of vaults stacked with gold, famous art collections, magnificent country estates and a collection of 10,000 fleas that Charles Rothschild donated to the Natural History Museum...

All good stuff of course. But we think the Rothschild's greatest achievement has to be their rather glorious wine.

It all started way back in 1853, in the Bordeaux parish of Pauillac, France. Baron Nathaniel de Rothschild bought the vineyard Château Brane-Mouton. Renamed *Château Mouton Rothschild*, they started producing one of the world's greatest clarets, which bears the same name.

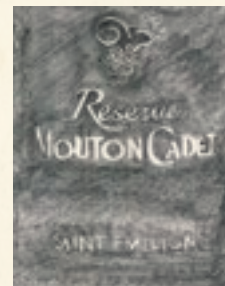
In 1868, Baron James de Rothschild bought the neighbouring Château Lafite. He was quite a talented chap, too. *Lafite Rothschild* is one of the world's most expensive red wines. If you wanted to buy a case of the 2000 vintage, you had to dig deep and sip slowly - cases fetched over £10,000.

Not content with conquering the old world, the Rothschild's skills now spill out into new world wine estates - Opus One in Napa, California, Escudo Rojo, Mapu and Los Vascos in Chile and Amancaya in Argentina.



## Our indulgent selection:

St. Emilion Reserve, Baron Philippe de Rothschild 13%



Saint-Emilion is an important wine district in Bordeaux and produces some of the most expensive wines in the world.

The wines are predominantly made from Merlot and Cabernet Franc - so they're more approachable at an early age and have a smoother profile than the more tannic Cabernet Sauvignon-based wines.

### ● Châteauneuf-du-Pape, Closerie de Vaudieu 14.5%



Châteauneuf-du-Pape is made in the Southern Rhône region of France. Part of what makes this wine so distinctive are small drift boulders from the ancient river-bed - the rocks reflect heat back into the vines at night, increasing grape ripeness and reducing the acidity.

#### Country of origin

France

#### Tasting notes

Lively berry-fruit aromas, liquorice and black pepper and full of juicy fruit. Iconic.

### ○ Barolo lo Zoccolaio, Domini Villa Lanata 13.5%



The Nebbiolo grapes in this wine are grown in the Zoccolaio vineyard, found in the village of Barolo. This wine sees some time in small French oak barrels to add a different dimension, before being aged in the traditional large Slovenian oak barrels for 3 years.

#### Country of origin

Italy

#### Tasting notes

Complex and smooth, with flavours of ripe blackberries and cherries and an underlying smoky, earthiness.

### ● Gevrey Chambertin, Louis Jadot 13.5%



Gevrey Chambertin is a small village in northern Burgundy. Their wine has a particular intensity of colour and rich, deep flavours that have earned them the title 'King of Burgundy'. This wine is made from 100% Pinot Noir grapes and sees some time in French oak barrels.

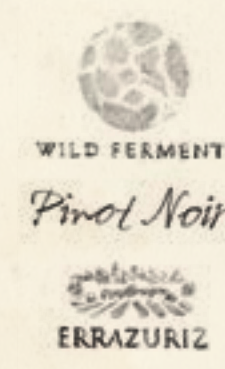

Medium bodied with stewed raspberry and strawberry flavours.

### ● Pinot Noir, Errazuriz Wild Ferment 13.5%



This wine has been fermented in the traditional way, using natural wild grape yeast - which, although tricky, gives plenty of interesting flavours. It's matured in French oak barrels for nine months.

#### Country of origin

Chile

#### Tasting notes

Raspberry, cherry and strawberry flavours mingle with black pepper and cinnamon spice with a soft finish.

### ● Brunello di Montalcino, Villa Poggio Salvi 13.5%



The hand-picked grapes in this wine are Brunello (roughly translated as 'small dark one'), a superior clone of Sangiovese grapes. The wine is aged for 30 months in large Slovenian oak barrels for smoothness and elegance.

Intense fragrance of red fruits, hints of cinnamon and tobacco, with well-rounded tannins on the long finish.

### ○ Sancerre, Les Collinettes 12.5%



Sancerre is one of the Loire Valley's most easterly appellations (a legally defined area, like Champagne). It's also one of the most prestigious. Sancerre is famous for the crisp style and minerality of its Sauvignon Blanc. This particular wine is made by top wine producer, Joseph Mellot.

#### Country of origin

France

#### Tasting notes

Classic blackcurrant leaves and gooseberry character from the famous Loire Valley.

### ○ Pouilly-Fume 12.5%



Pronounced 'Poo-ee Foo-may', this wine comes from vineyards near Pouilly sur Loire. The predominantly limestone soils gives the wines a 'smoky' (or 'fume' in French), character. Made from 100% Sauvignon Blanc grapes, this wine comes from a single vineyard, owned by Jean-Claude Chatelain.

#### Country of origin

France

#### Tasting notes

Fresh, rich and full of typically Sauvignon character. Gooseberry, cut grass and with a flinty, minerally finish.

### ○ Cloudy Bay, Sauvignon Blanc 13.5%



New Zealand's Cloudy Bay is taking the old-world by storm. The South Island's Marlborough region (home of Cloudy Bay winery) is said to produce the world's best Sauvignon Blanc. Grapes from eight estates create wonderfully unique aromas and flavours.

New Zealand

#### Tasting notes

Aromas of grapefruit, rhubarb and gooseberry. A cult classic from Marlborough, New Zealand.

### ● Chassagne-Montrachet, Premier Cru Morgeot 13.5%



This wine comes from the small but famous wine making village of Chassagne-Montrachet. The vineyard (owned by the Duke of Magenta and managed by Louis Jadot) is within the Premier Cru area of Morgeot. After growing in the walled vineyard, the 100% Chardonnay grapes are fermented and aged in French oak barrels.

#### Country of origin

#### Tasting notes

A full-bodied Chardonnay with citrus, apple and toast flavours and a finish that goes on and on.

### ● Chablis, Bouchard 12%



This traditionally-made Chablis owes its character to the chalky soils of one of France's most famous wine regions, Burgundy. The grapevines around Chablis are almost all Chardonnay, making a dry white wine renowned for the purity of its aroma and taste.
