Crisp & Dry

2010 Solano White, La Mancha, Spain £16.25

Sauvignon Blanc, Macabeo and Palomino, easy-drinking, full of flavour, attractive balance & clean crisp finish

2011 Tempus, Valle Central, Chile £20.75

Well balanced Sauvignon Blanc, showing classic lemon & lime characteristics, fresh, zesty & mouth-watering finish

2010 Pinot Grigio 'Sentito', Veneto, Italy £21.25

Fresh, clean & crisp, refreshing citrus tones, archetypal example of Italy's most famous white grape

2009 Le Bouquet Sauvignon, Domaine Laporte, Loire Valley, France £27.95

Gooseberry nose, ultra-fresh Loire-esque Sauvignon flavours, texture & class of Sancerre, perfect with fish and shellfish

2010 Chablis, Louis Robin, Chablis, France £34.00

Crisp nose of pure apple, grass & lime. Dry with soft acidity. Slightly oily with a good minerality and depth of flavour

Soft & Fruity

2009 Vaquero Unwooded Chardonnay, Monterey, California, USA £21.95

Light, bright example of tropical Chardonnay richness & flavour but made in European style of an unoaked, fruit driven wine

2012 The War Horse, Chenin Blanc, South Africa, Western Cape £23.50

Great floral brightness of the nose suffused with honey, nectarine. On the palate the incisive lemon zest and apple skin tang powers through the broad.

2010 Three Choirs 'Winchcombe Downs', Gloucestershire, England £24.25

Dry, fresh & very aromatic – English wine at its best. Martin Fowke, winemaker at Three Choirs, has done us proud with the 2010 vintage, an exclusive blend of Schonburger & Siegerrebe

2009 Ila du Clos Viognier, Languedoc, France £24.95

A great alternative to Sauvignon & Chardonnay, light, elegant, supple & refreshing, delightful notes of ripened stone fruit

Rose Wine

2010 Three Choirs Premium Selection Rosé, Gloucestershire, England £26.

Light, elegant English rosé made from Pinot Noir grapes. Fresh flavours of strawberry & summer fruits dominate the palate, hints of citrus keep the wine lively and refreshing

Light & Fruity

2010 Solano Tempranillo, La Mancha, Spain £16.

Tempranillo & Garnacha, spectacularly fresh yet warming, round, richly-fruited & superbly smooth

2010 La Tourelle Merlot, Languedoc-Roussillon, France £18.

Classic Languedoc, ripe plums, herby & spicy fruit. Soft, easy wine with a serious side, stunning value for money

Medium Bodied

2010 Leval Pinot Noir, Languedoc-Roussillon, France £23.

Fresh & elegant wine with delicate notes of cherry & strawberry fruits

2010 Lacrimus "5" Rioja, Bodegas Sendero Royal, Rioja, Spain £24.

Bright young Tempranillo has been harmonised beautifully with the older, softly oaked, barrel-aged Rioja, creating a silky, modern, brighter style of Rioja

2008 Château de Gironville, Cru Bourgeois Haut-Médoc, Bordeaux, France £38.

An attractive blend of 45% Merlot, 45% Cabernet Sauvignon and 10% Petit Verdot – This red has charming notes of tobacco leaf, cedar wood, blackcurrants and spice box in its medium bodied, soft friendly personality.

Full & Rich

2010 Maison de la Paix Old Vine Carignan, Pays d'Oc, Languedoc, France £22.

Dark fruit, fine tannins & a good amount of acidity, combine to make a well balanced & great drinking wine

2011 La Chamiza Malbec, Mendoza, Argentina £24.

Black fruit & silky spice give way to black cherries, dark chocolate & even a hint of rhubarb in this classic example

2007 Leylines Shiraz, Songlines Estates, McLaren Vale, Australia £27.

Silky texture, rich, powerful & well balanced. Super-ripe black cherries, blackcurrants & spice, developing complex tobacco tones

Dessert Wines

2007 De Bortoli Botrytis Semillon, South East Australia £22.

An elegant wine displaying citrus, peach and apricot fruit characters, a touch of vanillin oak with a refreshing acidity that gives the palate wonderful length and balances the botrytis sweetness.

2007 Château Grand Piquey, Sauternes, France, Sauternes £29.

This is frightfully good Sauternes and from one of the great vintages for the appellation. Medium sweet but lovely fresh acidity

Champagne & Sparkling Wines

Prosecco Frizzante Colli Trevigiani (NV), Veneto, Italy **£21.**

Packed with its fresh, ripe, apple and delicate melon flavours with a clean, crisp dry finish

Three Choirs Classic Cuvee Brut, Gloucestershire, England **£25.**

Delicious dry & biscuit character with a twist of orchid fruits, rich & rounded, quality you'd expect to find in a fine sparkling wine

Carter's Rose (NV), Colchester, England **£25.**

Delicious demi sec sparkling rosé wine with strawberry aromas

Champagne Gaston Dericbourg 'Cuvée de Réserve' Brut (NV), Epernay, France **£44.**

*Made by Claude Mandois of Champagne Henri Mandois, holder of the Award for the "Best Chardonnay in the World in 2009"
This Champagne is supple enough to be enjoyed on its own, but, has the depth & quality to be enjoyed with light foods*

Taittinger Brut Reserve (NV), Reims, France **£66.**

Soft & creamy with very good acidity & a lovely clean finish. This Champagne is exquisitely balanced and sumptuous with flavours of fresh fruit & honey

Pol Roger White Foil (NV), Epernay, France **£70.**

A blend of Pinot Noir, Chardonnay and Pinot Meunier. On the nose, the champagne is dominated by white flowers, green apple, brio and a trace of minerality. On the palate there are notes of stone fruits, a certain nuttiness and a hint of honey supporting the freshness of acidity

Billecart Salmon Rose (NV), V. Marne, France **£86.**

Featuring production secrets originating from Billecart-Salmon's first generation, this stunning, flagship rose unveils subtle aromas of an elegant bouquet with fine notes of red fruit. A light, elegant palate offering toast and red fruit meets a long fresh finish.
