While there are many countries that produce rum, the majority occurs in and around the Caribbean and along the Demerara River in South America."

Different grains are used for different varieties, including barley, malted barley, rye, malted rye, wheat, and maize (corn). Whisky is aged in wooden casks, made generally of white oak. It is a strictly regulated spirit worldwide with many competing denominations of origin and many classes and types. The typical unifying characteristics of the different classes and types are the fermentation of grains, distillation, and aging in wood."

Isle of Skye, Scotch single malt

A rich dried-fruit sweetness with clouds of smoke and strong barley-malt flavours, warming and intense. At the back of the mouth is an explosion of pepper.

Glenmorangie 10yr

Highlands, Scotch single malt

A subtle smokiness contributing to the fresh and aromatic flavour. The nuttiness and a hint of toffee-sweetness make it complex and approachable.

Balvenie Double wood 12yr

Brandy

"Brandy (from brandywine, derived from Dutch brandewijn—"burnt wine") is a spirit produced by distilling wine. Brandy generally contains 35%–60% alcohol by volume and is typically taken as an after-dinner drink. Some brandies are aged in wooden casks, while some are simply coloured with caramel colouring to imitate the effect of such aging (and some brandies are produced using a combination of both aging and colouring). Brandy is also produced from fermented fruits other than grapes, but these products are typically called eaux-de-vie."

Paradis Imperial is a blend of rare 19th and 20th century cognacs inspired by the cognac that the company created in 1818 for Tsar Alexander I as a present from his mother. It is a lighter style of cognac but is still extremely complex

Remy Martin Louis XIII

A blend of only Grande Champagne eaux-de-vie aged between 40 and 100 years. An old style cognac that packs a huge punch on the nose and most defiantly on the pallet

Hennessy Paradis Extra

"Tequila is a distilled alcoholic beverage made primarily in the area surrounding Tequila, a town in the western Mexican state of Jalisco, 65 km from Guadalajara. It is made from the blue agave tequilana weber plant (also called Maguey by the local people), part of the maguey family, which is native to Mexico. Most common tequilas are 38% to 40% alcohol (76 to 80 proof)."

Jose Ceurvo Reserva De la Familia

The taste of ordinary gin is very dry, and as such it is frequently mixed with other beverages. It should not be confused with sloe gin, a sweet liqueur traditionally made from sloes infused in gin."

"Vodka is typically a colorless liquor, usually distilled from fermented grain (a type of potatoes) but also from other raw materials. The word is a diminutive of the Slavic word "voda" for "water." Except for various types of flavourings, vodka consists of water and alcohol (ethanol). Vodka usually has an alcohol content ranging from 35% to 70% by volume."

Sherry is a fortified wine made from white grapes that are grown near the town of Jerez (Jerez de la Frontera), Spain. The word "sherry" is an anglicisation of Xerez (Jerez). In Spanish law, all wine labeled as "sherry" must legally come from the Sherry Triangle, which is an area in the province of Cádiz between Jerez de la Frontera, Sanlúcar de Barrameda, and El Puerto de Santa María.

A cream sherry. Golden dark. Full bodied with a long finish. Reminders of well-ripened fruit and fine wood. Beautifully sweet great with goats cheese or even over ice cream. The estimated period of ageing is 8 years.

Port

Port is produced from grapes grown and processed in the demarcated Douro region.[5] The wine produced is then fortified by the addition of a neutral grape spirit known as aguardente in order to stop the fermentation, leaving residual sugar in the wine, and to boost the alcohol content. The fortification spirit is sometimes referred to as brandy but it bears little resemblance to commercial brandies. The wine is then stored and aged, often in barrels stored in a cave (pronounced "ka-ve" and meaning "cellar" in Portuguese) as is the case in Vila Nova de Gaia, before being bottled.
