Day 1 Arrive Hanoi

Dinner

Noi Bai airport welcome upon arrival with transfer to the hotel in Hanoi. Later this evening, we take an hour **Cyclo tour** viewing the charming French colonial architecture of the bustling Old Quarter and attend a performance of the unique **water puppetry**. This will provide the first unforgettable insight into Vietnam.

Day 2 Hanoi

Breakfast - Lunch

A full day exploring the splendid city of Hanoi, starting with a visit to the **Ho Chi Minh Mausoleum**, the impressive house on stilts that was Ho's former residence, and **One Pillar Pagoda**, before taking a walk in the ancient **Temple of Literature**, Vietnam's first university established during the construction of the capital in 1070. In the afternoon, we visit the **Ethnological Museum**, the most interesting museum in Hanoi. On foot we acquaint ourselves with the locals among these intriguing streets. Hanoi is, quite simply, unforgettable.

Day 3 Hanoi - Ha Long

Breakfast - Lunch - Dinner

This morning, we depart for Ha Long Bay. Passing through the rich farmland of the Red River Delta, we enjoy the lush scenery and photo opportunities. We arrive at Ha Long Pier, board a traditional wooden junk and cruise through the spectacular sights of islands rising from the tranquil emerald sea. Enjoy a sumptuous on-board lunch

of special seafood and explore Sung Sot Cave, one of the most beautiful caves in the bay. Witness a splendid sunset. Dinner and overnight on boat.

Day 4 Ha Long - Hanoi

Breakfast - Lunch

Early morning coffee and tea will be served on the sundeck followed by a Tai Chi class. We continue exploring the magnificent Ha Long Bay. Change to a small motor or rowing boat to discover the **Luon Cave** and pass through a pretty entrance which leads to a tranquil round lake, surrounded by luxuriant trees and high stone walls. Upon return to the junk, a sumptuous combining Vietnamese and Western cuisine will be served. After we leave the cruise, we depart for Bac Ninh Province to learn more of Vietnam history and culture. At **Dinh Bang Village**, we travel by horse drawn carriage or ox cart to **Do temple**. This temple was built during the Le Dynasty and has been altered several times since, the major reconstruction taking place under the reign of Le Trung Hung in the 17th century. Then we enjoy a **traditional music show “Quan Ho” or Quan Ho Folk song**. Return to Hanoi and free time.

Day 5 Hanoi - Hue

Breakfast - Lunch

This morning we fly to Hue, one of Vietnam’s most cultural and historical cities, once ruled by the Emperor of the Nguyen dynasty. We take time to visit the **Forbidden Citadel** and cruise on the **Perfume River** to admire **the Old Thien Mu Pagoda**. The remainder of our time we are free to explore the crowded **market of Dong Ba**, where we can bargain for anything from souvenirs and bronze goods, to Hue sesame sweetmeat and conical poem hats.

Day 6 Hue - Da Nang - Hoi An

Breakfast - Lunch

This morning, we continue to discover Hue by visiting the impressive tombs of **King Minh Mang** and **Tu Duc**. We then cross the spectacular **Hai Van Pass** to reach Da Nang city, where we can see the best Cham Museum in Vietnam and take a short break at the Marble Mountain, before continuing to Hoi An, an ancient town of meandering narrow street dating back to the 16th century.

Day 7 Hoi An

Breakfast – Lunch

Nestled a couple of kilometers inland on Thu Bon river, Hoi An is typified by the 16th century Vietnamese, Chinese and Japanese architecture. A full day city tour offers us a chance to see the Japanese Bridge, Phuoc Kien Pagoda, the ancient house Tran Phu and the Hoi An Museum. The afternoon is time to walk in the old town, feel the atmosphere of its original culture, enjoy shopping for tailor clothing, lanterns, shoes and food, or simply relaxing on the beach.

Day 8 Hoi An - Quy Nhon

Breakfast - Lunch

After breakfast we drive along the spectacular coastal road, passing fertile rice fields, and pausing at Sa Huynh beach. We arrive at Quy Nhon for our overnight stop. This part of Vietnam is among the most unspoiled in Asia. The Cham influences on society are obvious and add to the special feel of the place.

Day 9 Quy Nhon - Nha Trang

Breakfast – Lunch

Continuing south on Highway One, We pause at the well-known Cham Thap Nhan tower, built on a hilltop overlooking the town. We then arrive to the magnificent beach town of Nha Trang.

Day 10 Nha Trang

Breakfast - Lunch

We spend an enjoyable day cruising the South China Sea around Nha Trang, visiting the **Tri Nguyen Aquarium** and stopping for a delicious lunch of fresh sea food at a fishing village restaurant. We also take time for a city tour, including one of the Vietnam's most impressive **Cham Towers – Po Nagar** or an opportunity to refresh in one of Nha Trang's famous mud baths. So relaxing and refreshing, and all washed off with warm mineral water afterwards.

Day 11 Nha Trang - Da Lat

Breakfast - Lunch

Departing the coast for the French hill station of **Da Lat**, we pass Cam Ranh Naval base and take a look at another Cham tower, dedicated to King Po Klong Garai. On the way, we explore the **Prenn Falls**, the **“Thousand Flower Valley”**, and some pine forests, enjoy Da Lat's fresh mountain air and admire its typical French villas. We may have an optional round of golf in the afternoon.

Day 12 Da Lat

Breakfast - Lunch

This morning, we take a trip through the countryside to the **Langbian Mountain**, then trek up to the peak of the mountain from which the whole spectacular landscape of the city will be seen. We walk down the mountain and explore the **Lat Village**, one of the ethnic minority villages in the Central Highlands. In the afternoon, we see the **Tuyen Lam Lake** and **Truc Lam Pagoda** (one way by cable cab if preferred and optional). We will continue to **Da Lat Flower Park** and finish the day in the **Valley of Love**.

Day 13 Da Lat - Ho Chi Minh City

Breakfast - Lunch

After a stop at the colorful flower market, we head down to exciting **Ho Chi Minh City** - once called “The Pearl of the East”. Upon arrival, we transfer to the hotel for refreshment. The rest of the day you are free to explore.

Day 14 Ho Chi Minh City - Cu Chi

Breakfast - Lunch

This morning, we tour this bustling city, visiting **Notre Dame Cathedral**, the **Reunification Palace**, the **Post Office** and the **War Remains Museum**. In the afternoon, we drive west to explore the underground tunnels in **Cu Chi** which were used by Vietnamese guerrillas during the war against the US and French forces, then back to Ho Chi Minh City.

Day 15 Ho Chi Minh City - My Tho

Breakfast - Lunch

This day is spent exploring the famous Mekong Delta. Driving south to **MyTho town**, we then take a motor boat on Tien Giang to visit **Thoi Son Island**, enjoying local hospitality as we discover cottage industries, orchard gardens and fresh local fruits. On our return to Ho Chi Minh City, we visit **Ben Thanh**, one of the biggest markets in the city.

Day 16 Depart

Free time until we are transferred to the airport for our onward flight. Tour ends.

This morning we transfer from the Hoi An Ancient Town to Da Nang Airport for flight to **Nha Trang**. The remaining time is free to enjoy swimming at one of Asia's most beautiful beaches.

Day 9 Nha Trang River tour

Breakfast - Lunch

Before boarding the boat for the scenic Cai river tour, we visit **Cham Po Nagar Towers**, a superb example of the architecture of the Cham people. The boat trip up the river takes us past beautiful scenery and the daily life of the Vietnamese people along the river banks.

Day 10 Nha Trang - Ho Chi Minh City

Breakfast - Lunch

We continue exploring the magnificent Ha Long Bay and some of the many caves before our voyage finishes. We depart for Bac Ninh Province to learn more about Vietnam history and culture. We visit the **Do temple**, built during the Le Dynasty, which has been altered several times since. We enjoy a traditional **Quan Ho Folk music show** before transferring directly to the airport for the flight to Da Nang city.

Day 6 Hoi An

Breakfast - Lunch

A full day tour in Hoi An is a chance to see the **Japanese Bridge, Phuoc Kien Pagoda, the ancient house Tran Phu** and the **Hoi An museum**. In the afternoon we walk in the old town, soak up the atmosphere, experience its original culture, shop for tailor-made clothing, lanterns, shoes and food, or simply relax on the beach.

Day 7 Hoi An - Da Nang - Hue

Breakfast - Lunch

This morning we visit Vietnam’s finest **Cham Museum** and the **Marble Mountain**. After crossing the **Hai Van Pass**, we reach Hue, where we can see the Forbidden Citadel and cruise on the **Perfume River** to the **Old Thien Mu Pagoda**. The remainder of our time is free to explore the crowded **market of Dong Ba** where we can bargain for anything from souvenirs and bronze goods, to Hue sesame sweetmeat and conical poem hats.

Day 8 Hue - Ho Chi Minh City

Breakfast - Lunch

This morning, we continue to discover Hue by visiting the impressive **tombs of King Minh Mang** and **Tu Duc**. Transfer to the airport for flight to Ho Chi Minh City, formerly Saigon, where we transfer to the hotel for refreshment.

Day 9 Ho Chi Minh City - Cu Chi

Breakfast - Lunch

Today, we have the opportunity to visit the controversial **War Remnants Museum**, the **Reunification Palace**, **Notre Dame Cathedral**, the **Post office** and **Ben Thanh Market**. In the afternoon we drive to the former guerilla base of the Cu Chi tunnels. Here we will gain an insight of the sacrifices and hardships of the Vietnamese people during the French and American Wars. Return to Ho Chi Minh City.

Day 10 Ho Chi Minh City - Vinh Long

Breakfast - Lunch

In the morning, we depart for Vinh Long Province. On arrival at Cai Be, we start the motorized boat to visit the **Cai Be floating** market and experience how people exchange goods, fruit and many other commodities on their vessels. We keep cruising through small canals to enjoy the charm of the upper Mekong Delta and visit the **An Binh Island** where we will take stop to visit an orchard, bonsai garden and tropical fruit garden. Later on, we will see some handmade family business products such as the coconut candy milk, the crispy rice popcorn. We enjoy folk music before transferred back to Ho Chi Minh city.

Day 11 Depart Ho Chi Minh City

Free time until we are transferred to the airport for our onward flight. Tour ends.
