Ripe berry, cherry and chocolate aromas with traces of vanilla and spices on the nose: the palate is rich and full-bodied with a long finish.

Distinctive Pinot Noir flavours abound with raspberry richness and soft, succulent redcurrants.

Made using selected bunches of Corvina and Corvinone grapes. An incredibly rich wine with soft everlasting tannins blending to create a balanced and harmonious velvet finish.

Showing violets, freshness and mineral notes on the nose: the palate is soft, though underneath there is a lean acidity and grippy tannins – appealing old-school Margaux.
- 103 Cote Rotie la Divine Syrah, France 2010** £87.00
Hand-harvested syrah grapes are sourced from low-yielding vines on the steep slopes of the Northern Rhone Valley; after a long 'vating' of about 24 days the wine is aged for 12 months in French oak barrels. Complex, refined aromas of raspberry, violet and spice, the palate is full of blackberry and pepper spice leading to a long finish.
- 104 Château Haut-Bages Liberal, 5ème Cru Classé Pauillac, France 2008** £94.00
Characterised by its powerful structure, which is also fleshy with beautiful ripeness to the fruit: the tannins are integrated and elegant and the wine has a remarkable freshness.
