

Champagne / Sparkling Wine

Prosecco Corte Alat NV (Italy) Delicate and aromatic with a light body and fine bubbles this carries lots of fresh peach, pear, apricot and apple with a revitalising finish £21.00 (£4.95 125ml)

De Telmont Grande Reserve (France) Medium Bodied, with apple and lemon friut flavours and a classically yeasty style £29.95

Laurent-Perrier Brut (France) A lighter house style, Chardonnay flavours predominate, giving the wine good food compatibility £55.00

Laurent-Perrier Rose (France) This classic rose Champagne has plenty of stylish strawberry fruit, full of vivacity and easy-drinking charm £75.00

Dom Perignon (France) Exceptional depth and rich texture characterise this iconic Champagne from Moet et Chandon £130.00

White Wine

Macabeo, Marques de Calado (Spain) Fresh, floral aromas of anise and fennel, the smoth and velvety is fruit driven with citrus and banana characteristics £14.50 (£4.00 175ml / £5.25 250ml)

Chardonnay, Five Foot Track (Australia) A nose of citrus fruits and ripe apples with underlying notes of vanilla. Crisp lemon and lime on the palate, served up with a rounded and buttery feel £15.95 (£4.25 175ml / £5.50 250ml)

Sauvignon Blanc, Vina Carrasco (Chile) Thoroughly citrussy on the nose, with frsh lime and lemon forming the aromatic backdrop. More citrus on the palate, accompanied by a riper hint of pineapple and mouthwatering acidity £16.50 (£4.50 175ml / £5.80 250ml)

Pinot Grigio, Malanriono (Italy) Hints of pears, stone fruit and lime, as well as the occasional floral note. Fresh and vibrant acidity results in a light, easy drinking wine £16.95 (£4.75 175ml / £6.00 250ml)

Frascati Superiore, Cantina San Marco (Italy) The senct of fresh green apples and ripe white grapes, enhanced with distinctly floral tones. Light in feel, but with good concentration on the palate, and a balance between soft fruit and snappy acidity £18.95 (£5.00 175ml / £6.50 250ml)

Fathoms Sauvignon Blanc (New Zealand) The bouquet sprins from the glass, offering plumes of citrus, green grass and elderflower. The palate is a burst of crisp grapefruit and gooseberry flavours £19.95 (£5.30 175ml / £6.95 250ml)

Macon Villages Blanc "Les Pierres Blanches", Cave de Ludny (France) Citrus and apple aromas with a hint of blossom and faint traces of butter. Apple and citrus also predominate on the palate along with a hint of pear, finishing on a lovely mineral streak £22.95

Chablies, Jacques Descharmes (France) lively and fresh with clean citrus aroma. Crisp, fruity and steely dry on the palate. The finish is long and lean £24.95

Albarino Martin Codax, Rias Baixas (Spain) Offers a delicate yet forceful peachy aroma on the nose and palate and is a great choice if prefer something a little different to Chardonnay £26.00

Sancerre "Les Baudrieres" (France) Fresh citrus and an underlying minerality, following on the nose it is refreshingly crisp with a well balanced finish £26.95

Rose Wine

Marques de Calado Rose (Spain) Strawberry and raspberry flavours are complemented by a creamy texture and crisp, refreshing acidity £15.50 (£4.20 175ml / £5.40 250ml)

Torre Alta Pinot Grigio Rose (Italy) Strawberry and raspberry flavours are complemented by a creamy texture and crisp, refreshing acidity £16.95 (£4.75 175ml / £6.00 250ml)

Château Saint Roch-les-Vignes (France) A delicious rosé showing soft spice and attractive fruit £19.95

Red Wine

Tempranillo, Marques de Calado (Spain) Notes of dark cherry and blackcurrant are lifted by a hint of dried flowers and sweet spice £14.95 (£4.00 175ml / £5.25 250ml)

Vina Carrasco Merlot (Chile) Aromas of ripe plums and strawberries with faint notes of tomato leaf and sage. The palate has a thick and jammy feel with soft, mature tannins and a rounded, easy style £15.50 (£4.20 175ml / £5.40 250ml)

Shiraz, Five Foot Track (Australia) A medium bodied wine with a pleasing balance between ripe fruit and savoury notes on the nose £16.95 (£4.50 175ml / £5.80 250ml)

Rioja Los Bailadores (Spain) Soft and fruity in style. Warm, plummy aromas tinged with subtle and vanilla £16.95 (£4.75 175ml / £6.00 250ml)

Flor del Fuego Cabernet Sauvignon (Chile) Fruity flavours of plum and blackcurrant with a cassis-like concentration, lifted by subtle green-pepper-like savoury tinges £19.95 (£5.30 175ml / £6.95 250ml)

Gestos Malbec Malbec, Finca Flichman, Mendoza (Argentina) A stunning Melbec with ripe plum and prune characterictics and intense colour and aromatics £22.95

Fairleigh Estate Pinor Noir (New Zealand) Aromas of berry fruits, black cherry and hints of sweeet plum lead to a rich body of ripe summer berries, warm fruits and spices with well integrated tannins, elegantly balanced with a long finish £23.95

Vieux Remparts, Lussac St-Emilion (France) This is a rich, full bodied wine showing great concentration of flovour. With juicy black fruit on the nose and palate backed up by a smokey sandalwood character £24.95

Chianti Classico Sanleonino, (Italy) Full of red cherry flavours and violets, with hints of sweet spices and a beautiful long, silky finish £26.95

Chateauneuf-du-pape "Cuvee des Antiques" (France) This wine is dark ruby with a complex nose of spices and hints of pear with a smooth and lingering finish £28.95
