**2 Hour Dog Sledding Adventure (offered Wednesday - Sunday, conditions permitting)**

This introductory dog sledding experience is perfect for those looking to ease their way into the wonderful world of dog sledding. During this 2 hour adventure, guests will spend 30-40 minutes meeting and greeting rescue and second chance sled dogs and preparing their sled(s) which involves harnessing and hitching their team, etc. Once the sled is prepared, guests will embark on a 45-60 minute ride (ride time will vary based on trail conditions). Our mushers will make scenic stops along the ride so guests can soak in the views and have plenty of photo opportunities. At the end of the experience guests can thank their team and “tip” them with cookies (just don’t feed the mushers). The cost of this trip is \$300 per sled. Our traditional sleds have a 340lb weight limit (this typically accommodates 2 people). Participants can add a third guest as long as they remain under the 340lb weight limit for an additional \$45. We can accommodate couples/individuals weighing up to 400lbs by using an extended team, this option costs \$350 per sled. 9:30am, 12:00pm and 3:00pm departure times are available.

**3 Hour Dog Sledding Excursion (offered Wednesday - Sunday, conditions permitting)**

This dog sledding tour - while still perfect for beginners - offers our more adventurous guests increased “ride time” on nearby scenic trails. This adventure is designed to be hands on to the comfort level of the guests. 30-40 minutes will be spent meeting and greeting the rescue and second chance sled dogs that call us home and preparing the sled(s) which involves harnessing and hitching the dogs etc. Once the sled is prepared, guests will hit the trails for approximately 2 hours! There will be plenty of stops so guests can stretch their legs and take advantage of the ample photo opportunities. At the end of the experience guests can thank their team and “tip” them with cookies (just don’t feed the mushers). The cost of this trip is \$400 per sled. Our traditional sleds have a 340lb weight limit (this typically accommodates 2 people). This adventure departs at 9:30am.

**Half Day Clinic (offered Wednesday - Sunday, conditions permitting)**

This hands on experience is for our most adventurous guests looking to channel their inner Jack London. Participants who sign up for this adventure will spend 3-4 hours learning about the modern aspects of dog sledding and gain in-depth knowledge of the gear and dogs. Guests will learn how to operate their own team of sled dogs and then do it! Guests will learn how to give commands and correct situations that may occur on the trail. The cost of this adventure is: \$525 per couple (a minimum of 2 participants are needed). We can accommodate a maximum of 6 guests, groups of 5-6 receive a discount and the cost is \$250 per person. Ages 12 and up are welcome on this trip. Please inquire with us directly if you have a younger participant interested in this experience. This adventure departs at 9:30am.

**Longest Dogsled Ride in New England (offered Wednesday - Sunday, conditions permitting)**

Explore the “Narnia” like beauty of New Hampshire’s Grand North on this full day dog sledding adventure. Guests will spend 30-40 minutes meeting and greeting rescue and second chance sled dogs and preparing their sled(s) which involves harnessing and hitching their team etc. Once the sled is prepared guests will spend nearly a full day on the trail (ride time ranges from 5-6 hours based on trail conditions). Trails are “musher’s choice” to ensure that your full day of dog sledding is exciting and surrounded by the best snow around. Enjoy hot chocolate, give the dogs snacks and explore the the trail less traveled this winter season! This adventure costs \$745 per sled and has 340lb weight limit. This trip departs at 9:30am.
